Information on Course Overrides: All requests for course overrides must be submitted by March 7th, 2024 using [this course override form](#). No requests for an override will be accepted after this date. Override meetings will be held March 8th to 20th, 2024

Information on the Pathways Program: [The Pathways program](#) is designed to provide educational opportunities for students experiencing academic, behavioral, and/or life challenges in the mainstream setting; but also for students who are seeking academic opportunities different from their current experience. Pathways enrolls approximately 30 students at the high school level with the intent of creating a small supportive learning community. Students are encouraged to explore their academic interests. Pathways is a "School-within-a-School" model which capitalizes on the resources available at YHS. A team of core and special education teachers, social workers, school counselors, and an administrator staff the program. This team meets regularly to discuss the holistic needs of the students and develop new programs that will enhance student learning and personal growth. **Interested in Pathways?** Please complete and submit [this application](#)!

Please review teacher recommendations and begin considering elective courses for next year. The Program of Studies, posted on the school website, provides explanations of all courses. If you disagree with a teacher's course recommendation, first discuss with the current teacher. If needed, there is a course override process that can be discussed with your School Counselor. All course selections must be completed by Friday, March 19th. On February 11th the portal opens for families and students to view teacher recommendations and discuss courses for next year. On February 25th course selection meetings for the 2021/2022 school year begin with School Counselors. On March 5th any Course Override Form requests are Due by 2 pm. March 17th is the deadline for Course Override meeting need to have occurred. March 19th the course selection process is complete.
