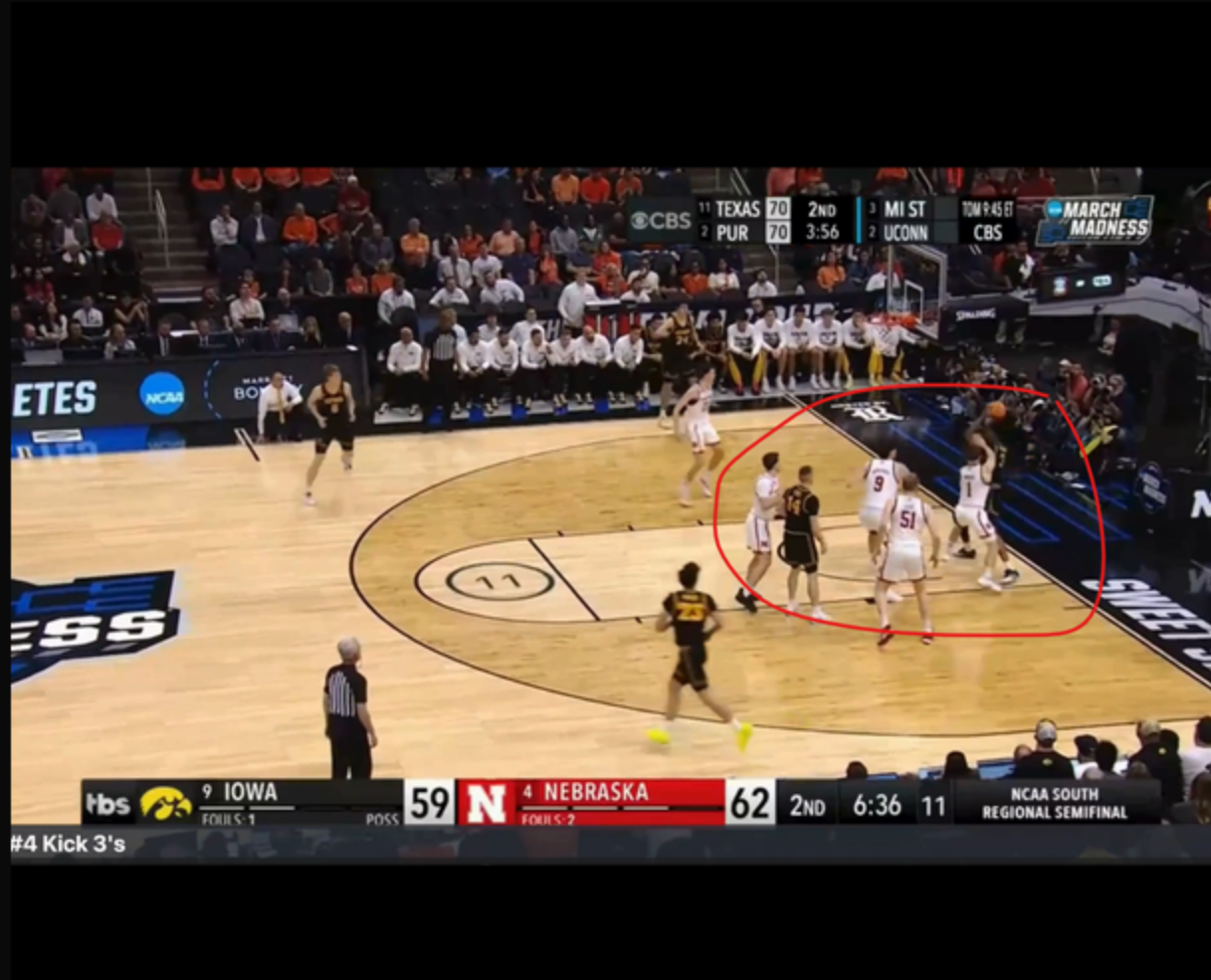

THE ADVANTAGE DNA™

- 1 4 sets the ball screen for 1.
- 2 4 clears away to open the middle.
- 3 1 turns the corner and drives into the paint.
- 4 5 slides behind the defense along the baseline.
- 5 Nebraska collapses multiple defenders to the rim.
- 6 1 dumps the ball to 5 behind the help.
- 7 On the catch, 2 lifts to create space for 1's relocation.
- 8 4 lifts into the passer's vision for the next kick-out read.

ADVANTAGE FRAME — 6:36 2ND HALF



THE DRIVE DRAWS THE DEFENSE TO THE RIM. THE BASELINE SLIDE OPENS THE NEXT READ.

ACTION BREAKDOWN

1. BALL SCREEN + CLEAR



4 screens for 1 and then clears away. The emptying action gives 1 a clean middle lane to attack.

2. DRIVE + BASELINE SLIDE



1 drives the paint while 5 slides behind the defense. As Nebraska collapses, 1 dumps the ball to 5 at the rim.

3. LIFT BEHIND THE CATCH



On 5's catch, 2 lifts to create room for 1's relocation and 4 lifts into the passer's line of sight for the next read.

PAUSE HERE

Nebraska has five defenders packed around the paint because 1 has forced the ball all the way to the rim. That collapse is the advantage. 5 slides behind the defense instead of standing in the crowd, giving 1 a dump-off target. Once 5 catches, Iowa immediately lifts and relocates around the play so the next kick-out is available if the defense stays collapsed.

COACHING INSIGHTS

WHY IT WORKS

The clear-out gives 1 a true downhill lane. When Nebraska collapses to stop the drive, 5's baseline slide creates a target behind the help.

DEFENSIVE REACTION

Nebraska sends multiple bodies to the rim. That protects the paint initially, but it leaves defenders staring at the ball and vulnerable behind the play.

OFFENSIVE READ

If the low help steps up, hit the baseline slide. If the defense stays collapsed on the catch, read the lift and relocation for the kick-out three.

COACHING POINT

Teach the baseline player to move behind the defense, not into it. The slide should arrive as the driver forces the final help defender to commit.

STEAL THIS IDEA

When the driver gets all the way to the rim, the off-ball players cannot stay frozen. Slide behind the final help defender, then lift and relocate around the catch. The rim touch creates the collapse; the movement behind it creates the next scoring window.

DNA TAKEAWAY

DRIVE THE DEFENSE TO THE RIM.
SLIDE BEHIND THE HELP.
LIFT FOR THE NEXT KICK-OUT.
