

How to Use Plex.tv Link Code

You know that frustrating moment when you want to watch Netflix on your TV, but you have to type your password using the remote? Yeah, forget all that. The **plex.tv link code** basically says "screw typing passwords on TV remotes."

Open Plex, see a little code, type it into **plex.tv/link** on your phone. Boom. Your TV now gets you.
