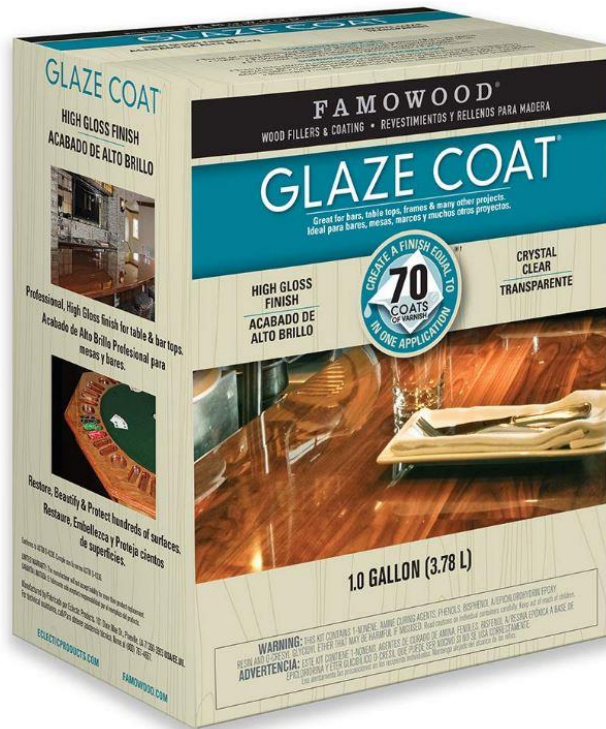

The instructions for applying the clear coat are simple to follow. You just need to have all of the tools needed when you begin to get started without a hitch.

Famowood Glaze Coat Instructions

The purpose of Glaze Coat is to protect your furniture with a high gloss finish. This will ensure that it lasts a long time. One application of clear coat is advertised to equal 70 coats of varner. It is great for picture frames, tables, bars, etc. Here are simple instructions to getting started:

Before getting started it is recommended that you have all of the necessary tools required for getting the job done correctly. Here is a list of tool you need handy:

- Standard level
- Measuring cups
- Drop cloth
- Mixing stick
- Plastic putty knife
- Disposable brush
- Painters tape
- Heating device (blow dryer, butane torch, or lighter)
- For personal safety these are recommended
- Latex gloves
- Protective glasses

The next step is to prep your furniture which entails making sure it's on a level surface. This will ensure the [Famowood Glaze Coat](#) application when applied will evenly distribute across your project. To make sure there is no major mess or accidental spills you should use painter's tape for the ends of the project and a plastic drop cloth underneath your project to catch runoff.

Time To Measure

After properly prepping your furniture the next step is to pour resin into your measuring cups. You will need to put an equal amount of hardener into a separate cup then pour the hardener into the resin.

Mixing

After pouring the hardener into the resin mix both ingredients for approximately 6 minutes. After 6 minutes pour the mixture into a clean measuring cup making sure nothing is left on the bottom. Then mix for an additional 6 minutes.

Pour Onto Project

Apply or pour the finalized mixture onto the center or middle of your project surface area. The Glaze Coat will begin to automatically spread on its own across the project. With a plastic putty knife begin spreading the clear coat across the project.

If at anytime you begin to see bubbles appear use your heating device to heat 8 inches above the surface and the bubbles will disappear.

Cover Project Area

When finished tent the project surface to protect it from any unwanted dust. Wait 24 hours allowing for the finish to dry and you should have a brand new piece of furniture that is protected with a nice clear finish.
