

## How to read the Work Programme: practical recommendations

- Don't try to read the Work Programme from cover to cover...
- Firstly, look through the content!
- Find you key words and research orientation be flexible
- Go to specific topic(s) and read description carefully (2-3 page)
- Don't try to "distort" the topic description for your "wishes / needs"
- If still interested in topic, go back to the Destination description to learn more about the EC's high-level expectations



### **Topic of interest**



#### **Project Idea**

- Leading role in consortium building and proposal preparation
- Experience and efforts needed
- Many interested to join... but mostly small / peripheral actors
- Difficult to reach "big players"
- No pain, no gain!



#### Relevant competence

- We can do "something" invite us to your project!
- Works better "general competence"
   vs. "focused competence"
- Works even better unique competence or previous relevant experience
- High competition at EU level



## Why you need clear project idea description?

- To refine your idea (aim, motivation, outcomes, impact, partners, etc.)
- To discuss your idea with colleagues, potential partners, NCPs, consultants...
- To inform a wide audience about your intention to prepare proposal









## Why you need efficient competence(s) description?

- To tell about yourself and available competence(s)
- To convince potential coordinator to select you from all others willing to participate
- To receive invitation to consortium
- To take good place in the project








#### **Bilateral meetings**

- 1. Two-way street
- 2. Browse participants & send meeting requests in advance
- 3. Check your meeting requests & accept/decline them ASAP
- 4. Be flexible and open for other time slots/communication instruments



## Participant profile / cooperation offers: practical aspects

- 1. Use plain English
- 2. Be specific, informative and concise
- 3. Give link(s) to extra information
- 4. Create as many cooperation offers as needed -> specific works better than general!
- 5. Pay attention to offer title -> short, straightforward, where possible include topic identifier

### Bilateral meetings scheduling and participating: practical aspects

- 1. Quantity doesn't mean quality -> browse participants & select potential partners (similar vs complimentary profiles)
- 2. Send personalised requests while booking meetings -> explain your intentions
- 3. Be prepared:
  - Learn about your counterpart -> how to make him/her interested in cooperation
  - Prepare you pitch presentation -> adapt your pitch to your counterpart's interests
- 4. Be flexible during the meeting -> listen to your counterpart, not only talk about your interests
- 5. Take notes -> they will be definitely useful if you plan several meetings
- 6. Send follow-up email ASAP -> make the email personalised using your notes!
- 7. Meeting hasn't happened -> don't worry, send a message to plan alternative meeting in Zoom, Teams, etc.
