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



# WORLD ARCHITECTURE FESTIVAL 2019 SHORTLIST HERALDS A SUSTAINABLE FUTURE

**WORLD ARCHITECTURE FESTIVAL 2019** 

Architects grapple with some of the world's most pressing challenges in the twelfth edition of the World Architecture Festival, the world's biggest architectural awards programme, which has announces its shortlist.

Following the establishment of 'Architects Declare' a collective of some of the most renowned practices who have come together to announce a state of climate emergency, this year's World Architecture Festival shortlisted entries include designs that demonstrate how buildings can play a major role in a more sustainable future.

Amongst the shortlist is an eco-airport in Singapore designed by Safdie architects centred around a 15,000m<sup>2</sup> state-of-the-art, indoor public garden, which features a 40-metre indoor waterfall falling through the centre of a doughnut-shaped glass roof, alongside 3,000 trees and 100,000 shrubs from around the globe. Dortheavej

Residence by BIG-Bjarke Ingels Group flies the flag for both affordable and sustainable modular housing in Copenhagen, shining a light on this nascent mode of construction which has the potential to offer much to the housing crisis. Whilst one of last year's winners, Studio Gang, tackles environmental concerns at a volumetric level through its 'Solstice on the Park' project – a 26-storey residential tower in the USA optimised for environmental performance through angled window panels which are slanted inwards at 72 degrees—the precise angle at which the sun hits the Chicago skyline at the height of the summer solstice. In the culture category, Helsinki Central Library Oodi by ALA Architects, heralds a new era of library design where traditional functions meet modern technology, to create an almost zero-energy building with panoramic views.

The 'Future Project: Experimental' and 'Future Project: Infrastructure' categories also launched some exciting and innovative entries, including the proposal for a waterfront park in NYC, transforming oil tanks into community gardens, by STUDIO V Architecture, and the proposal for man-made, mid-bay barrier islands to act as a surge protection system for the Port of Houston, by Rogers Partners Architects + Urban Designers.

Major world architects shortlisted include Zaha Hadid Architects, Heatherwick Studio, Bjarke Ingels Group, Rafael Vinoly Architects, Rogers Stirk Harbour + Partners, Grimshaw and White Arkitekter. Many smaller practices will also take part to pitch against the big names. This year's 534-strong shortlist, ranges from private residential, to education, infrastructure, healthcare, hospitality, cultural/civic, interior and landscape projects across 70 countries.

WAF will reconvene in Amsterdam, The Netherlands, from 4-6 December this year. This is the second time the event has been hosted in the Dutch capital, following previous editions in Barcelona, Singapore and Berlin.

The architects and designers behind each shortlisted project will compete for category prizes at WAF from 4-6 December. Presentations of the shortlisted designs will be made to more than 100 international juries in front of festival delegates. Category winners then compete against each other on the final day of the festival, to compete for the ultimate accolades of World Building of the Year, Future Project of the Year, Interior of the Year and Landscape of the Year.

WAF programme director Paul Finch commented: "We have been inspired by the levels of innovation in this year's entries, that show the incredible range of ways in which architects are responding to the global climate and biodiversity emergencies we face.


"WAF has attracted more than 1,000 entries, for the second year in a row, from 70 countries, and we look forward to more than 500 live presentations at the Festival in Amsterdam, showcasing these exemplar projects from around the world."

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

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# HELIFIX NON-DISRUPTIVE MASONRY REPAIRS RESTORE WELSH PERIOD COTTAGE

Helifix engineers have designed sympathetic non-disruptive repairs for a Grade II listed period cottage in South Wales which was suffering from a number of defects, including outward movement of the gable end wall, internal cracking along the ceiling lines and cracking



over the front door entrance. The Helifix product range and associated Repair Details provided lateral restraint and restored structural integrity to the damaged masonry leaving the cottage's original aesthetics and materials intact.

Deep masonry beams were created across the full width of the gable wall by bonding pairs of stainless steel HeliBars into slots cut above and below the first and second floor joists. These stabilised and reinforced the masonry and addressed the cracking over the front door. SockFix stainless steel anchors were then inserted into clearance holes drilled within the Helibeam zone, through the rubble-filled wall and the first two parallel floor joists. The concealed repairs were completed quickly and caused minimal disturbance to the property fabric, the inhabitants or neighbouring properties.

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"Our DML is something of a fan favourite; used as a general purpose reinforcement mesh, helping prevent cracking occur, when different materials meet."



The masterplan will deliver around 2100 new homes consisting of social, affordable and private housing. These are being constructed in twenty-three blocks, varying in height from three to twenty-three storeys – along with an imposing tower building of twenty-eight storeys. Also planned are new public parks, a primary school, community centre and commercial space for small cafes or shops.





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# WAUGH THISTLETON ARCHITECTS REDUCES ENERGY CONSUMPTION OF EAST LONDON OFFICE BUILDING BY HALF

WAUGH THISTLETON ARCHITECTS

The Green House is a state-of-the-art office building in East London designed by Waugh Thistleton Architects that takes advantage of an existing concrete frame structure and juxtaposes it with timber CLT extensions, exemplifying modern methods of construction and sustainable design. Owned and managed by The Ethical Property Company, both the client and architect have pushed the boundaries of sustainable office design creating a biophilic development that improves energy efficiency in construction and in use by 50%\*.

This sustainable 6-storey commercial property in Bethnal Green is a retrofit of a disused and derelict 1960s office block with a modern and flexible workspace for up to fifty social change organisations. The existing concrete frame was maintained to minimise waste, pollution and reduce carbon emissions that occur through demolition. A new 6 storey rear extension and atrium was added to the back to create 7050m² of office space. Further office space with stunning views over the city is located in a new single-storey rooftop extension. The additions are built from prefabricated CLT and glulam reducing the building's carbon footprint to a fraction of a conventional new building.



A new dynamic glazed wall was added to the west façade facing Cambridge Heath Road, providing passive regulation of noise, heat, sunlight and ventilation. The windows are set back from the façade to provide solar shading and acoustic protection. PV panels on the roof offset energy consumption and wildflower green roofs are located at second and sixth floors levels to encourage biodiversity. A large south-facing communal terrace on the fourth floor provides outdoor space for informal meetings and relaxation and there are over 80 bicycle parking spaces.

Inside, a full height atrium opens up the lobby space at ground floor and provides natural light and sky views from each floor's circulation space, while acting as a place for impromptu conversation. The central exposed CLT cantilevered staircase is the pivotal connection between the existing concrete building and the timber extension. This innovative design was made possible using resin bonded steel rods placed within the treads, with the half landings suspended from steel tension system. Open plan kitchens encourage active collaboration. Use of recycled carpet tiles, low energy lighting and water saving technologies contribute to reduction in VOCs, electricity and water consumption.



# COULD CPD HELP CONSTRUCTION WORKERS POST-BREXIT?

With Brexit remaining at a standstill after Theresa May's crushing defeat, the future of the construction industry is also very much up in the air. The UK has relied heavily on the proficiency of overseas workers to plug the skills gap in this sector which continues to be inundated with residential and infrastructural projects. The UK population is anticipated to expand by 3.6 million (5.5%) over the next decade and the construction workforce will continue to experience an increased demand for their expertise.

The Landscape For Construction Workers

Figures from the Office for National Statistics (ONS) also highlight that the construction industry is struggling to attract young UK-born workerswhich is resulting in an ageing industry. In 2011, it was estimated that one in every five UK-born construction workers were aged over 55, meaning that by 2021, those individuals will be on the cusp of retirement age.

This has highlighted a significant recruitment and training deficiency as well as a lack of investment that has been rooted in the industry, even before the fractious divide of the referendum. While the government attempts to provide the public with answers, they have failed to guarantee the construction sector that they will have access to the EU talent pool that has served our island nation for centuries. It is therefore paramount that homegrown companies provide reassurance and necessary financial support to existing EU workers as this time of great uncertainty.

Whatever the impact of Brexit (when and if it is eventually delivered), it is imperative that these workforce shortfalls are anchored and re-evaluated so that this skills void can be bridged over the longer-term. James Bryce, head of strategic workforce planning at Arcadis has affirmed that greater action needs to be taken in researching modern methods of construction and diverting its profits into training and development. This would undoubtedly help relieve some of the concern in relation to the recruitment of the 400,000 plus workers that the industry requires each year to deliver on the UK's housing and infrastructure needs.

How To Help The Construction Industry Post-Brexit

It is critical that native organisations and professionals engage in different training methods to keep up to date with the innovative changes and cutting-edge technology now commonplace for the likes of builders, masons and plumbers.

An effective solution for this fast-moving environment could be a strategic focus on Continuous Professional Development (CPD). This would consist of creating a diverse workforce by delivering substantial backing for this trusted self-driven style of learning. Professionals create a portfolio documenting their progress and constantly review the skills, experience and knowledge that they have learned both during and outside of working hours.

Evidence of CPD is an attractive proposition for potential employers as they are taking on a reputable and motivated individual which gives them the opportunity to position themselves as experts in their field.

This accredited learning in construction acts as testament for a worker's commitment to the industry along with their ambition. 

It's true what they say, most options do expire worthless. But does that mean that buying them is a "mug's game"?

The systematic, risk premium harvesting, carry earning and yield hunting crowd would certainly answer with a resounding "YES" to that question.

#### A DIFFERENT PERSPECTIVE ON BUYING OPTIONS

Imran Lakha at Options Insight, with around 20 years of frontoffice options trading experience, has a slightly different perspective. If you understand how option premium behaves and the main factors that effect the pricing of these quite simple and commoditised products, then you can harness the power of optionality to benefit immensely when you tactically and selectively buy options.

There is little doubt that since the 2008 financial crisis, global central banks have effectively declared war on volatility and will do "whatever it takes" to backstop financial asset prices at the first signs of trouble. US equities just made new all-time highs this month and we are still fully expecting a 25 basis point rate cut from the Federal Reserve at the end-July meeting. There used to be a time that rate cuts were reserved for crisis prevention, how that has changed. The powers that be are not even pretending anymore that asset price inflation is not top of the policy agenda. Rather than accepting the reality that these asset inflating policies are doing nothing more than increasing inequality between the rich and poor, they continue to cling on to the hope that the wealth effect will generate some kind of self-sustaining economic growth.

#### HOW THE PREMIUM OF AN OPTION WILL EVOLVE THROUGH TIME


So in this volatility supressed world, how can buying options ever make sense? The key to answering this question lies in knowing how the premium of an option will evolve through time and different levels of price in the underlying asset. Granted that if you buy a call option because you are bullish on a stock and the stock drops like a stone and never looks back, you are most likely going to lose your premium and there isn't much you can do about it. Likewise, if you buy a put option on the Nasdaq after the market has had a 5% correction and the volatility index (VIX) has risen from 12 to 25, the odds are you won't see that premium again.

#### **HOLDING AN OPTION TO MATURITY**

Buying an option and holding it to maturity means that you have to get the direction of the market right, and it has to stay there for long enough that your option expires in the money. All whilst, the time decay keeps eating away at your gains, leaving you exposed to the risk that your market view might have been correct but you still lost money. The way to buy options profitably is to think like a sniper, get in and get out quickly. Options give you leverage. You can spend a small amount of premium for a potentially massive return if you catch a big move and cash in on that move by selling the option out to realise your gains.

#### A POWERFUL WAY TO TRADE RISK

If done correctly, buying options can be an incredibly efficient and powerful way to trade risk, generating alpha through superior risk adjusted returns. Apart from tactically buying options to gain leverage to a breakout in the price of a stock, a



common use of options is for hedging. Many established money managers use put options to hedge their portfolios from macro shocks , enabling them to stay fully invested in the market but have confidence that their drawdowns will be limited if the market were to correct sharply lower. The most successful of these investors also know that once their puts have done their job in the event of a market crash, then they should monetise them by either selling them or rolling them in some way either to lower strikes or longer maturities.

#### UNDERSTANDING THE AVERAGE DURATION OF VOLATILITY SPIKES

Like with all forms of trading, you have to evolve with the market, and options buyers have had to understand that the average duration of volatility spikes is becoming smaller and smaller. Therefore, the window of opportunity to monetise hedges has also become narrower, meaning only the quickest and most prepared investors will actually be able to profit from owning these types of positions. The fact that it has become so challenging to convert a long option position into profit has led to some investors abandoning using them and also many long volatility funds closing down due to consistently poor performance. This in turn has reduced the demand for options and meant the price for implied volatility has continues to drift even lower, presenting greater opportunity for those who dare to step up to the plate and spend premium.

I think most people would agree that it's good to have options in life. In the uncertain world we are in today, I suggest that there may even be a time and a place for them in your investment portfolio.

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



Doors. They open, they close - what else is there to say? Most of the time, we don't even think about how they move. The options seem limited and obvious. Push or pull, everything happening in a defined arc, swing out, swing in.

The only time we are likely to think about how our doors open and close is when the standard options are either impractical or undesirable. What happens, for example, when you have cupboard and cabinet doors in tight spaces and they cannot open fully because other objects block the way?


# 'ALUPROF GIVES LIGHT TO HAYWARD GALLERY'


Since opening in Summer 1968, the Hayward Gallery has earned its title as one of the worlds leading contemporary art galleries. Closed in September 2015 and open again in January 2018, the Gallery underwent an extensive two year refurbishment programme. In May 2019 the refurbishment won the prestigious RIBA London Award Awards and RIBA the National Award 2019.

The main focus of the refurbishment was the replacement of sixty-six glass pyramid rooflights which were re-engineered to let controlled natural lighting into the upper galleries for the first time. The refurbishment was made possible by a grant from Arts Council England, the Heritage Lottery Fund, trusts and foundations, and Southbank Centre friends supporting the 'Let The Light In fundraising campaign.'


For the new pyramid construction the architects chose to use aluminium profiles from Aluprof's MB-SR50 Curtain Wall system. The four sided pyramids are glazed on two sides with laminated low-iron glass and to maintain weathering the square base of the pyramid rooflight, utilised an additional 5° slopped, low-iron, double glazed unit. The two glazed sides of the pyramid offer sun shading to the lower, 5° sloped glazing whilst still allowing a view of the sky from below through the two open sides of the pyramid.

The sixty-six new pyramid rooflights replace the original, problematic, heavily leaded, single glazed Georgian glass units. Early in the buildings life these dysfunctional original units had been blocked out, now, with the support of Aluprof, the building retains not only its original design intent but offers high levels of thermal efficiency thanks to the introduction of double glazing and high performance thermal breaks in the frames design.









With the careful selection of glass, the change in available light, as the sun is obscured by clouds, is minimised, thereby offering a more constant light level in the gallery space below. Reinstating a now controllable blackout blind below the rooflight offers further flexibility for the use of the gallery space below.

Architects on the project are Feilden Clegg Bradley Studios and the redevelopment of the gallery is just part of a wider £35 million upgrade of the Southbank Centre in time for its 50th anniversary. Of heavy 'Brutalist Architecture' design, popular back in the 1960's, the architect has sympathetically updated the gallery meeting today's display requirements, but maintaining the original design intent of the period.



# CENTRAL DUBLIN RENOVATION **DELIVERS LIGHT-FILLED OFFICE SPACE**

SCOTCH HOUSE

Careful coordination and collaboration has transformed a brick and concrete 1970s office block in the heart of Dublin into a bright and light-filled space fit for modern businesses.

Owner MF Properties, part of Irish developer Castlepark, approached Dublin-based architectural practice Lafferty in 2013 with a brief to completely refurbish and extend the property to create premium office accommodation available to let.

This was the first time a private sector client had approached Lafferty with a clear BIM aspiration for the project. The client had already procured a point cloud survey of the existing property and prepared an IFC 3D model of the building.

Following a protracted planning and appeals process, planning permission was granted in 2016 and MF Properties gave Lafferty the go-ahead in March 2017. The building is expected to be completed in early 2019.

#### **ADDING HEIGHT AND LIGHT**

Comprising six storeys and a basement level, the original building was a concrete structure with brick façades. The project involved an extensive overhaul including the replacement of two of the façades, substituting the brick with an elegant Portland stone, enhanced with powder-coated aluminium floor-to-ceiling glazing.

The two upper floors provide penthouse accommodation with full-height, double-glazed façades, offering uninterrupted views of the river Liffey and surrounding area. External roof terraces at the penthouse levels offer attractive landscaped outside space.

According to Ronan Carroll, associate director at Lafferty, the floor-to-ceiling heights within the building were a complex challenge. As the original building was constructed with concrete, there was little opportunity to change the heights. This was of particular concern to the client, who was keen that the new space should feel both light and open.

After several investigations, Lafferty's solution was to route the ventilation and services through the recessed profiles on the underside of the existing concrete slabs, instead of via the ceiling void, saving valuable height along the way.

"ARCHICAD has been invaluable for this project," explains Ronan. "The ability to view the building from all angles and to understand its complexity and geometry – I can't imagine how we'd have done this using old school 2D."

#### **COMPLEX PROJECT REQUIRES TEMPORARY STEEL FRAME**

As part of the renovation, Lafferty worked with the structural engineer and steel subcontractor to construct a replacement structural frame on the two principal facades of the building. This required the construction of an additional temporary steel frame to hold up the floors until the new structural frames were put in place

The structural and services engineers produced their model using Revit and this, was transferred to Lafferty's ARCHICAD model via IFC.

In this way, the team was able to coordinate the models and check for any coordination issues early on and throughout the project. During construction the steel fabrication model was provided for approval in a 3D format which greatly assisted the approval process."

In addition, Lafferty used ARCHICAD's renovation filters extensively throughout the project, which made it much easier to immediately see the impact of alterations to the design.

#### **BIM COORDINATION AND COLLABORATION**

Lafferty employed an external BIM consultant for the project, who undertook the clash detection between the structural, architectural and services models using Solibri. Lafferty worked on the detailed design stage until the end of July 2017. IFCs extracted from the structural and mechanical and engineering models were imported into ARCHICAD and overlaid.





Every Friday the different parties shared their respective models via IFC and every fortnight Lafferty hosted a formal BIM coordination workshop with the BIM consultant. In between, the teams shared information via screengrabs and email.

#### **CLOSE COLLABORATION WITH THE BUILDING CONTRACTOR**

Lafferty has also been heavily involved throughout the construction phase due to the complex nature of the project.

Ronan says: "There were no straight lines in the existing building, so it's been a constant work in progress – we've continued to regularly update the BIM model and worked closely with the main contractor, Flynn Management, at every stage throughout the build."

Ronan says: "Although this project wasn't tendered as a BIM project, we have in fact followed the BIM process informally at every stage throughout. This has proved very useful in enabling us to deliver such a complex renovation."

Collaboration, communication and coordination have been the critical factors throughout this challenging renovation. The end result will be an elegant building that both respects and enhances its prominent location in the historic Liffey Quays area of Dublin.

## **SUNSQUARE ROOFLIGHTS GET TOP GRADES**

#### FROM ESTEEMED OXFORD COLLEGE

St John's College, a prestigious constituent college of the University of Oxford, has transformed a unique area of disused garden space into a brightly-lit semi-subterranean building by featuring a range of made-to-measure skylights from flat-roof skylight specialist, Sunsquare.

The installation was part of a redevelopment of the college's grounds located within the Grade II listed gardens, which saw dilapidated greenhouses and storage sheds transformed into a functional new 60 sqm building – a space for gardening staff to use as an office and break room, as well as a greenhouse area for growing college plants.


Oxford-based architects Jessop and Cook were set the task of designing a building that would sit in a small horseshoe-shaped space, set within three listed walls inside the college's tranquil gardens. Not only did it need to be completely unobtrusive – remaining unnoticed by passers-by – it also had to be aesthetically pleasing for any buildings that overlook it. This includes on-site student accommodation and the new St. John's College library study centre, which completed in 2019. Because the area was completely enclosed by neighbouring walls, bringing in natural light was another core part of the design.

Martin Shaw, Associate at Jessop and Cook Architects, explains: "The brief from the St. John's works team was to create a much-needed space for the college's gardeners to use, but there were several question marks around the viability of the site. The former greenhouse and storage space was very small and almost completely enclosed, so we ran the risk that any new facilities would feel cramped and poorly lit

"To combat this, we needed to find a skylight large enough to cover the majority of the roof space – opening it up and allowing in plenty of natural light, whilst also fitting with the building's design and creating the right growing conditions for the greenhouse area. We were already familiar with the Sunsquare range, and we opted for a purpose-designed part-fixed, part-opening rooflight because it matched perfectly with the building's low pitch, but still ticked our boxes when it came to thermal performance, safety and functionality. It was efficient enough to keep the gardeners warm in the winter, with an opening mechanism to provide much-needed ventilation in the summer."

Jessop and Cook's drawings for the upgraded gardeners' area featured a new entrance at one end, with toilets, a shower, a breakroom and an office inside, as well as a central greenhouse section. They also included plans to excavate and lower the ground level by 800mm, to create a comfortable floor to ceiling height internally (but not enough to be seen over the college's external wall). Here the team specified a 2620mm x 4250mm Sunsquare part-fixed, part-opening rooflight,





positioned above the greenhouse area to provide the majority of the building's natural light. Jessop and Cook also opted for two smaller 1400mm x 2000mm Sunsquare Aero Vent skylights over the breakroom.

Each Aero Vent was fitted with an easy-to-control electric opening and closing mechanism, for immediate and convenient access to fresh air.

Martin Shaw continues: "One of the main challenges we faced was that the new facilities had to be completely unobtrusive and invisible from outside the garden walls. The brief was to ensure the building was completely hidden from views of the listed garden! As flat-roof skylight specialists, we believed Sunsquare had the experience to create a skylight with a pitch low enough that it would match the pitch of the roof with a minimal upstand, allowing the building to remain unseen from outside the grounds and eliminating the risk of water pooling. This, combined with the option to customise each rooflight to meet the space's exact needs, made Sunsquare the most suitable choice."

Mark Lambert, Sales Director at Sunsquare, comments: "We're very proud to have been involved in such a forward-thinking project – working closely with architects Jessop and Cook to create custom-made flat-roof skylights that help get the best out of St. John's College's new space. 

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#### WARMER AND QUIETER OFFICES

#### FOR THE MASTER AND STAFF

74 Trumpington Street has been upgraded with curved on plan and standard secondary glazing to create quieter and warmer office environments, in line with the College's overall sustainability plan. In an effort to keep attracting the best scholarly minds and providing the best environments to nurture their excellence, a vision for enhanced learning spaces on the South Side of Mill Lane has been created. One of which is the Grade II Listed Kenmare House designed and built by James Essex c.1760, a prolific constructor in Cambridge, with many of his buildings now making up the University's Estate.

Pleasance Hookham and Nix put the architectural plans together of how the buildings would be reconfigured, to house the Master, Finance, Human Resources and International Programmes Teams and Fellows accommodation. Due to its Listing, the original single pane windows had to be retained, so a solution to combat the noise ingress and thermal inefficiencies had to be sought. Selectaglaze was contacted early in the design process, which made the incorporation of the secondary glazing far more efficient.

Over 60 units were installed throughout the buildings. On the front elevation, where noise ingress was a larger concern, the secondary glazing was installed with a larger cavity, to create the sound insulation. On the rear of the building the glazing was mainly for thermal and one intricately etched large window overlooking a flat roof, had a large Secured by Design unit installed for added security.



Having a unit sited internally on a kitchen wall or a plant room makes for convenience for the end-user and for the installer or contractor in terms of installation, maintenance or servicing.

However, external models of hot water heating units have become increasingly popular. We are seeing more and more units sold as installers seem to be favouring external siting for a variety of reasons.

Firstly, having a gas fired unit internally has its own restrictions – lack of internal space, flueing restrictions and impediments, exact siting for installer convenience, inspections etc. On external units a whole stack of advantages come into play - starting with the fact

that it is a gas fired appliance and it is outside habitable space; and with no need for a flue there's greater flexibility on exactly where you place the unit; it is easier to service and maintain; all units have robust casings and comprehensive weather controls, for example a Rinnai external appliance is frost protected down to minus 25°C.

All these factors add up to possible economies for the end user and ease of installation for the installer.

# BIG FOOT SYSTEMS SUPPLIES SUPPORT FOR ACOUSTIC SCREENING - HATTON WALL, LONDON

Big Foot Systems has supplied custom support for acoustic screening on the rooftop of a development of luxury flats, offices and retail outlets at Hatton Wall in Holborn, London. The acoustic screening surrounds a group of condensers and plant on a PVC membrane and green roof which effectively blocks plant noise from the surrounding private homes.

Big Foot's technical team designed a system which would support the heavy acoustic screening using supports which were designed to ensure the pressure exerted by their feet did not exceed the limit of the lightweight roof. Calculations established the size of frame required and the number and size of foot bases in contact with the roof needed to ensure the cumulative weight was dispersed evenly over the roof area and was within workable loads of the roof build up. Dynamic forces were also taken into account as the structure had to withstand the high winds created due to funnelling by the surrounding buildings. The framework installed was therefore wider than the screens they supported, affording a greater degree of protection against 'tipping'. Big Foot's customised system proved the ideal solution, offering project specific non-penetrative support.

"The normal ways of fixing screens to our supports had to be modified to allow the panels to fit. Normally, we would hang panels from our posts or A-frames but the weight and space meant that this wouldn't have worked" explained Ashley Simmans, Big Foot Systems Site Engineer. "We designed and tested a new set of bracketry alongside contractor Bespoke



Acoustic Solutions to allow the panels to sit on top of our supports which worked well. Installation was completed within a matter of days."

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
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

With designers ever conscious of how their projects will appear on Instagram, a host of jaw-dropping interiors that push the design boundaries define the twelfth edition of INSIDE, the World Festival of Interiors. Whether it's a novelty cat café in Guangzhou, China, or a global heritage brand such as Fortnum and Mason inside London's Royal Exchange, across the board we're seeing design with a capital D.

INSIDE is the sister festival of the World Architecture Festival and celebrates the world's finest examples of interior design.

In this year's 'Bars & Restaurants' category are the interior concepts for new restaurants by some of the world's most innovative chefs. Bjarke Ingels Group are behind the design of the second incarnation of renowned Copenhagen restaurant, Noma. Over in Manhattan's Meatpacking District, Buro Ole Scheeren's fast food concept for Dean & DeLuca's chef-led eatery, 'Stage', uses a sculpted high-tech white Corian and steel centre-piece, to celebrate the artistry of food, and to create a stage for those who make and those who consume it.

And in the City of London, Universal Design Studio are behind Fortnum & Mason's new 360-degree bar, shop and restaurant in the Grade I Listed Royal Exchange courtyard, complete with a bespoke curved metal canopy.

These big hitters go up against novel projects, such as the cat-themed café, Meow Restaurant in Guangzhou, China, that embraces cats' love of heights in its interior design.

And Karavanstop Café, a lifestyle café by One Bite Design Studio at Hong Kong International Airport, that puts social media at the heart of its design, with an iconic green ceiling, abstracting the city's topography, and an 'instagrammable' logo wall, both designed to capture the spirit of the area's outdoor leisure activities.

Meow Restaurant is joined by another pet-themed project in China, this time a private home interior in Shanghai, designed to accommodate a family's high pet ratio, giving freedom for both pet and owner to enjoy the living space freely.

In the Civic, Culture & Transport category, entries range from a cloud shaped, glass wedding chapel in Japan, to a library with an 'Alice's Adventures in Wonderland'-themed section in Singapore, and highlights from the Health & Education category include a multi-sensory room in Thailand for pre-school children with visual impairments.

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

# SECURE SECONDARY GLAZING HELPS PROTECT RETURNING ARTEFACTS IN C.18TH CASTLE

Nestling on the border of Dorset and Hampshire, sitting atop the cliffs at Highcliffe; is the Grade I Listed Highcliffe Castle. It was built between 1831 and 1835 by Charles Stuart, 1st Baron Stuart de Rothesay and is arguably the most important surviving house of the Romantic and Picturesque style of architecture.

Highcliffe Castle stayed a family home until the early 1950s when it was sold to become a children's convalescent home, but was closed in 1952. It was not until 1994, that the phased scheme to repair and conserve the building began. Funded by Christchurch Borough Council, English Heritage and the Lottery Heritage Fund, the goal of the current phase of work is to transform the East Wing into a dynamic Heritage Centre. Selectaglaze, was involved in thermal and security solutions for the castle's new exhibition spaces. This first required an overhaul of previously repaired windows as well as the conservation of existing exposed brickwork.

Working closely with Greendale and architects Rodney Melville and Partners; Selectaglaze provided the Castle with a bespoke solution to compliment the restoration of the rooms meeting acceptable museum standards and levels of; humidity, light and security. This will allow the return of most of the Marshal Ney furniture which is currently in the V&A Museum where Selectaglaze previously installed secondary glazing units in the Henry Cole Wing.

glass, which were certified to LPS 1175 SR2. Overall, the newly renovated rooms are far better equipped to house objects of high value.

By polymerising the wood's cell wall, the softwoods permanently take on the attributes of tropical hardwood including high durability, hardness and dimensional stability. Kebony's ability to withstand all weather conditions made it the ideal material for the exterior cladding of the island project.

Thomas Liu, Architect at Atelier Oslo commented: "We were blessed with this project brief which enabled us to create a property that we are immensely proud of. Kebony is the perfect choice for this project because it is suitable for the window frames as well as the sunscreen structure. We are incredibly pleased with the final result which we hope will continue to provide a serene setting for our artists."


