materials

yarn	 Premiere Parfait Chunky (Size 6) Yarn (in <u>White</u> + <u>Sunshine</u>) Black Tapestry Thread or thin yarn (for mouth) You can use any bulky yarn, or experiment with different sizes/brands!
other items required	I used a " <u>J-hook" (6mm)</u> for this pattern <u>Safety Eyes</u> (or you can sew on eyes) <u>Tapestry Needle</u> <u>Stitch Marker</u> <u>Filling/Stuffing</u> <u>Scissors</u>

abbreviations

MR	magic ring
SL ST	slip stitch
СН	chain
SC	single crochet
HDC	half double crochet
DC	double crochet

hooks

I used a 6mm (j) hook

other stitches

INC - Increase DEC - Decrease BLO - Back Loop Only FLO - Front Loop Only





instructions

Note: For the Yolk: You will be working in a continuous manner, without the slip stitch at the end of each round. Instead, you will move into the next round continuously. There is no chain at the beginning of the round either. For easy and smooth transition between rounds, I like to place a stitch marker in the first stitch of the round.

the pattern is written in US terms.

Reference Pics below.

Start with Yolk:

R1: MR, 6 SC R2: INC ×6 (12)

R3: (1 SC, INC) ×6 (18) R4: SC around (18)

ADD EYES now (pop on or sew on)

(I put my eyes either between 2nd-3rd round or 3-4th round, about 2-3 stitches apart...they are all unique!)

R5: BLO (1SC, DeC) ×6 (12)

R6: DEC ×6 (6)

FILL NOW with STUFFING Fasten Off and sew in tail.





instructions

Switch to White:

(I start on the white opposite side from eyes, and call it the "back")

RI: Go back to Row 4 (there will be a ridge that was created w/the BLO row) and work in the FLO now: Insert hook and pull through and chain one, then the pattern begins: (2SC, INC) ×6 (24), SL ST to end round and then CH I

R2: (3SC, INC) \times 6 (30), SL ST to end round and then CH I


R3: (SC, HDC, 3DC in same stitch, HDC, SC) \times 6 (42) SL ST to join, Fasten off and weave in tails.


You can add a smile if you want! use about 12 inches of black embroidery thread or thin black yarn.
