

construction of an elegant 6-bedroom home in Sevenoaks, Kent, Andrew Henry Interiors set out to create a home with distinct living spaces for relaxing, socialising, studying and playing. Incorporating their existing Asian influenced furniture and art and the philosophy of traditional Feng Shui, the client wanted to weave their cultural background and heritage into their home. The interior design, therefore, spotlights these existing pieces, whilst complimenting the arts and craft style of this brand new, lavish home. The property showcases LUXE, Andrew Henry Interiors' elegant, highend, bespoke service.





#### BAR/GAMES ROOM

The design team focused on creating an unforgettable social space in this room, choosing an alternative style that would stand out from the rest of the house.

Transporting the family and their guests from day-to-day life to a spectacular destination, a bespoke bar designed by the lead designer and pink and royal blue booth seating placed against a backdrop of floral wallpaper adding tones of green, ensure eccentric flair. Green velvet bar stools tie in with the wallpaper and a pink oversized neon light adorns this wall space, ensuring plenty of wow factor. Eight individual ceiling pendant lights on brass fittings drop down over the bar, creating evening light that replicates the ambience of a cosmopolitan venue.

#### ENTRANCE HALL

Designed to make a stunning first impression, the entrance hall features neutral colours and bespoke pieces to create a bold statement. White marble flooring with a striking black border, designed by Andrew Henry Interiors, frames the space and a multi pendant mesh steel feature light by designer Arturo Alvarez adds further interest and grandeur to the entrance. The stairs and balustrades were stained to match the wood flooring throughout the house and hand painted silk wallpaper was sourced from China, subtly introducing visitors to the oriental references that run through the home.





Jessica Robins Senior interior designer at Andrew Henry Interiors, comments "We've created a space that would make a lasting impression on visitors whilst providing a comfortable, practical home for everyday living. Surprise and dramatic contrast define each space and create a journey of discovery throughout the property and the richness of our designs are also influenced by the property's historic surroundings. Situated within the exclusive Wildernesse Estate, with a former stately home dating back to 1705 as its centrepiece, we wanted to ensure that this stunning new property also complimented the setting and surroundings.



Working with the artwork, coffee table and sideboard supplied by the client, the design team created a sophisticated space for entertaining in this formal living room. Classic style and opulence colour this space with beautiful textured Arte wallpaper used on all the walls and a neutral colour scheme that brings the bright artwork above the fireplace to life. Matching, symmetrical luxurious rugs create further comfor and statement lights have been placed above them, introducing textured glass and brushed gold to the area.




As an everyday space used regularly by the family, it was essential that this room was functional and hard-wearing, whilst remaining connected to the rest of the home. Creating a sense of calm and warmth in contrast to the grandness of the more formal spaces in the property, the design team sourced a high-end, mid-century light that ties in with the clients existing chairs and sideboard and an oversized mirror was placed for Feng Shui reasons, inviting energy into the space and reflecting light from the patio area outside.

#### FORMAL DINING ROOM

The ambitious design team focused on creating a formal dining space with an oriental twist. The beautiful walnut herringbone flooring, which was selected to run through the whole of the downstairs, is softened in this room by a luxurious light grey rug which rests under an inclusive oval dining table. A fluted antique brass chandelier creates a dramatic effect over this social space. Hand painted silk wallpaper sourced from China creates a stunning backdrop and feature wall and compliments the traditional floor lamp supplied by the family. A burst of colour in the luxury silk curtains adds further texture and ties the space together.







# The design team worked with high-end specialist kitchen company Stoneha to create a luxurious kitchen that is practical but also beautiful, with a stunning, harmonious result. Selecting a veined white marble work top and dark stoned hue kitchen cabinets, the kitchen was elevated to a space to make cooking and socialising a joy. Andrew Henry accessorised the room





Andrew Henry Interiors selected a soothing colour palette here, introducing a scattering of warm maroon in rich textures. Again, this room has a subtle oriental influence projected by existing furniture, which has been combined with modern pieces to work with the style of the house, creating a cohesive scheme that resonates with the rest of the property. Delicate Arte wall panels with a distinct oriental pattern add a feminine dimension to the space and a striking bespoke canopied bed is paired with beautiful Visual Comfort lamps. Bespoke apex shutters which can be controlled from the bed were installed to manage daylight and the bed canopy feature ensures Feng Shu rules have been considered, as well as adding sophisticated comfort to the space.

### GUEST BEDROOM (BEDROOM 4)

The aim in the guest bedroom was to create an impactful space with a rich, deep colourway. The walls and wardrobes are painted in Farrow and Ball Preference Red, adding dramatic contrast to the white walls and fabric curtains. A luxurious bespoke headboard with wenge border provides further opulence and a nod to the arts and crafts architecture of the house.

#### TEENAGE DAUGHTER'S BEDROOM

Andrew Henry Interiors created a playful room here using the occupant's favourite colour; blue. Using a mix of pattern, colour

and texture to form a more grown-up space to take her into her later teens, the room is a fun and eclectic space that will transition alongside her. The upholstered bed is from Loaf and bespoke shutters were supplied by Andrew Henry Interiors and can be controlled from the bed.

#### TEENAGE SON'S BEDROOM

The client's son chose the wall colour here, which is Farrow and Ball De Nimes, and the space was then styled around his preference. Again, the designers wanted to create a space that was fun and would age well with the client's needs. An oval rattan headboard, geometric fabrics and stylised bedside lamps were also introduced to make the space memorable.

#### **ADULT STUDY**

Situated on the ground floor, this study prioritises practical work space and neat storage. Bespoke his and hers desks and joinery maximise the area and the striking herringbone floor and brass accents elevate the space.

#### HOME CINEMA

Designed by home cinema experts Sevenoaks Sound and Vision, Andrew Henry Interiors specified and supplied the bespoke black-out curtains in matt maroon velvet made with acoustic cloth and selected the shade of the chairs to go with rest the home.

To ensure the home abided by Feng Shui rules, the Andrew Henry Interiors team familiarised themselves with the practice and applied these learnings to their designs. Integral to this approach, mirrors and headboards were thoughtfully placed to safeguard and support the owners.











Andrew Henry concludes: "It was important to us to not only design the interiors, but to design the living experience of this home, so our approach went beyond aesthetics to incorporate practical considerations. We've created the ultimate balance of luxury and functionality, whilst embracing owner's personal style and history. # O&A LONDON UNVEILS NEW PROJECT -

## MODERN CONSTRUCTIVISM


#### CLIENT & BRIEF

The clients are a large family who wanted to create a home that would be their main place of residence. The client's most important request was to create comfortable spaces suitable for the whole family to spend time together. The other requirements were the sports area, spa and wine cellar.

#### STYLE

It is impossible to assign it to any one specific style as it contains everything from art deco to urban style.

We experimented with colours playing with the dark floor in combination with a yellow sofa and a bright painting on the ground floor. We created a very unusual staircase with an amazing chandelier and designer banisters which can be classed as the centrepiece of this house. Our designers expressed themselves in various ways, especially with the use of dark coloured metals which were used as a base for this project. The first floor features a burgundy/ cherry coloured flooring leading to the granddaughter's room which is designed in green colours. Next to it is the youngest son's room which looks like a separate loft style apartment with concrete panels on the walls, an amazing photo of New Yok city and industrial wall lights made to exclusive designer drawings. Then there is a master bedroom where her dressing room and bathroom are silver and white with elements of blue and his dressing room and bathroom are brown and beige and resembles in style small houses along the seaside.






#### LIVING AREA

Every space is thoughtfully designed to every last detail and reflects the idea at the heart of the project that the bedrooms are not just different rooms but also reflect the personality, interests and tastes of each family member. All this may give the impression of total incompatibility but it is not the case as these completely different spaces together create one atmosphere united by specific elements.

#### **DESIGN TRICKS**

This can be identified as the main design technique – all the spaces are created with different moods, colours and styles but they all seamlessly join together. Dark metal is the main decorative element. It is used throughout the whole project and is the main feature.











#### WINE CELLAR

Confirming with the owner's preference to not build a basement in the house we organised a space on the ground level next to the kitchen. The interiors are divided with a transparent floor made of tempered glass.


The textured blued metal on the stairs highlights the graphic black floor and walls. The lack of direct light in the space creates a magical atmosphere of an ancient wine cellar. We were very attentive to the temperature and humidity controls as one of the most critical considerations in every wine-cellar design.





#### SPA & SPORT AREA


The second floor comprises the spa and a gym that features a large sports equipment area as well as table tennis and yoga spaces. Despite its separateness, it also had to be integrated with the house therefore we decided to finish it in Swiss style. We designed a bespoke hydro massage bath, hammam, spa zone and recreational area. All the spaces are quite cosy and family friendly.







# AN AFRICAN PENTHOUSE ANGOLA. AFRICA

In this penthouse one feels the luxury in the details, in the choice of raw materials, in the selection of textures. The color shades translate the toasted sun of the end of the day, has it descends upon the waters. That natural filter offers a feeling of living a dream. The entire house is confluence of natural richness. The colors offered by the earth, the fruits, the gold, the petroleum color that paints the doors and of course the jungle animals, that we can almost listen.







It is on the waving between tradition and modernity, that the whites mix with the earth's tones. The golds lean on the animal patterns or the lacquers allow themselves to be enveloped by the velvets. And, without us waiting, it is the artwork of artist Pedro Calapez, with twenty elements, that recalls a flow of memories.


The cheetah, out of scale, is a revisitation of the savannah, contrasting its speed with the calmness lived in this room. The areas of the house are true discoveries, surprises hidden in thought out details, as the 18th century chair dressed with the cloths of ancient indigenous garments. A journey through the natural wealth that inhabits all the continent and brings to mind that we are in Africa.

A compromise is felt with the local culture. The large dimension images of the indigenous necklaces are an example of that, recalling tribes and traditional communities.

But also, the collection of bone combs, made in Africa, that take their place on the wall of the restroom. Here, our eyes are drawn to the manufactured alpaca basin, finalized with elements in bone.

In the main suite, the whites are felt on the sheets but also on the coral pieces. The glasses overshadow the light, the silver tone enhances the energy and the bone pieces, and the earth tones remind us once more where we are. It is through this pathway dusted in white, the spaces interconnect. This feeling of divinity, of deliberate detachment. The idea of optimism, of transcendence.

And, as one least expects, the journey takes us outside. As if we were in deck, traveling in a ship. Here, once again, the richness is in the details. The unexpected gilded chairs, counterpointing the whites, the coconut bowls crowned with this toasted shade of gold. This luxury makes us dream of a warm sunset.



# THE BEAUTY OF BESPOKE INTRODUCING NEWFOUNDLAND WITH DAVID PHILLIPS

Newfoundland is the 'jewel in the crown' within Canary Wharf Group's Vertus Residential leasing portfolio. This 58-storey residential development required a detailed and highly considered design approach; with David Phillips providing a bespoke furniture solution throughout.

"What I found most interesting about Newfoundland is that architecturally it was the most fascinating but also the most challenging - it's a striking building and from an interior perspective, a project we couldn't wait to get involved with." -Nicholas Gill, CEO, David Phillips.







With a brief to create a prime development that could generate a 25% increase over existing rents in the area, David Phillips worked closely with Vertus and the Canary Wharf Group to design a bespoke furniture solution exclusively for Newfoundland over a four-year period. Taking an initial design concept through to installation via an extensive design development stage.

"With such a striking exterior and shape, the architecture played a huge part in influencing the interiors' unconventional typographies. Our design was based on Vertus' aspiration for the interiors to be light, sophisticated and most-importantly contemporary – with a colour palette of bold blues and rust tones that transitioned into a softer palette of powder blues, greens and neutrals as you went through the building. Dark wood finishes, marbles and metal-work helped ensure a refined, cohesive look was achieved that had depth and character." - Mark McDonnell, Head of Design, David Phillips

When developing the furnishing schemes, each piece needed to work within all the apartments to ensure a comfortable layout was achieved. By taking the time to develop bespoke furniture items, such as the use of an angled corner sofa, this helped achieve a nuanced response to this intricate building.

Equally the layout of the studio apartments required the development of a unique freestanding TV joinery unit with rotating screen component. David Phillips long-standing relations with their suppliers ensured they could design, manufacture and deliver a product that would have been a considerable cost saving to the client, compared to conventional fitted joinery.

In addition to providing the furniture for the apartments, David Phillips created furniture concepts for amenity and lobby spaces. The furniture for these areas was designed with a developed understanding of how these spaces are used by residents, with durable contract-grade fabric being used throughout.

The scheme required the development of bespoke furniture and joinery pieces, designed and then manufactured here in the UK. The scheme also incorporated high-end furniture pieces from brands such as Cassina, Lema and Cattelan Italia that were selected, procured and installed by David Phillips. Design details included custom silk rugs, hand-made pendant lighting, luxury games tables, fitted joinery in the gymnasium and luxury outdoor furniture.

The design team at David Phillips added the final finishes to the scheme by providing full dressing and staging of the amenity spaces as well an array of show apartments. Executing the initial design intent through the use of carefully selected accessories that speak to the Vertus' residents profile and aspirational urban lifestyle.

Newfoundland is a testament to David Phillips' ability to deliver on a client brief, from concept all the way to creation, across all elements of a premium BTR development.







An exciting interplay of luxurious materials and simple forms is the common thread running through the interior of this penthouse. The design is inspired by

many a hidden door have been invisibly built into the wall using laminated walnut. The earthy wood elements form a clear contrast to the floors: shiny bright and large-format porcelain stoneware (with a marble look) in the representation rooms, and high-pile velour in the private rooms. These materials offer subtle nods to the 70s, with backlit mirrors.

The spacious eat-in kitchen also has a shiplike appearance. Behind white high-gloss fronts, its dark walnut interior has been intricately designed, down to the smallest detail.

The central element of the living room is the bioethanol fireplace. Slightly elevated, set in a light marble base, it is backed by a large-format, dark porcelain stoneware wall with a marble look, which, in addition to the flames, also reflects the material aesthetics of classical modernism. The base is also the first step of the metal staircase to the upper floor, whose filigree strut railing takes on a supporting role and makes the structure appear weightless.

Once again, this project was about distilling a coherent whole from the clients' many ideas; focusing their vision and guiding them in their decision-making process.





# WHITE & NEUTRAL' APARTMENT

**LOCATION:** Moscow | **SIZE:** 380 sq m

#### **CLIENT & BRIEF**

Among the tasks in the client brief, the main one was to create a light space both in terms of colour and in terms of light. In order to better explain her vision for the apartment, the client took Oleg Klodt to her car. It was the latest model Mercedes S class with light leather seats and finished with nickel, chrome and expensive wood. "I looked at it and said "Understood"" – says Oleg Klodt. The interior turned out exactly like that – light space with a lot of detail, plenty of décor combined with complex textures and unusual decorative solutions.





O&A London Creative Director Anna Agapova described the interior style as "American Contemporary Miami Ocean Front". These associations are not accidental as the apartment resident spends most of her time in the United States and when choosing the design wanted to have the same feel in her Moscow apartment.

#### FLOOR PLAN

The specific nature of planning for this apartment is in the layout. On the one hand the apartment is very large but on the other hand the entrance is quite strongly shifted to the left. Because of this the overall dynamic of the space is quite horizontal withe windows along its length. However, this layout was beneficial as it added air and light to the space. The team decided to implement axial development of the space from the front door through the hall and into the main kitchen, which created a living area on the way to the bedrooms. Problems were caused by the bearing column but the solution was found by adding another fake column and incorporating them both into one composition with the fire place. This created a sort of gallery emphasised by the rotating lamellas, leading to the living area where the master bedroom, two dressing rooms and the children's bedrooms are located.

#### SPECIAL FEATURE - KITCHEN

This project also implements a very contemporary idea of creating two kitchens; one for presentation and another more practical. Usually, this sort of divide takes place in larger houses and is not often seen in apartments but the clients liked the concept and it turned out to be very convenient. The main (white) kitchen is created for family gatherings in the morning to have breakfast and drink coffee and the second (dark) kitchen is for cooking lunch and supper. This way the smell and any mess from cooking are not carried into the living space thus improving the apartment's aesthetics.

#### **DECOR**

One of the most prominent decorative techniques is the French glass positioned in three different places and in completely different styles. French glass art panels are associated with water and sea breeze and always look the part. Modern abstract art in bright colours was also used for placing emphasis and to stand out from almost entirely white interior.

#### **FURNITURE**

In this particular interior the designers used quite a few expensive accentuating objects. The most unusual and interesting objects are furniture and rugs by O&A London. A chandelier designed by Oleg Klodt and Anna Agapova is featuring raindrops falling on the table and creating the sensation of freshness and light.

Another important element is the kitchen with a designer island where the table top made from quartz agglomerate moves to the facades which are veined with vertical stone stripes.



The client required a gently sloping 1,330m2 feature ceiling based upon a 4.5m square grid comprising illuminated conical shaped panels interfacing with porthole glazing in the walkway above to provide a highly flexible use well-lit activity space below the newly built Olympic Steps. D&D were responsible for the entire design, engineering, manufacture and installation of the 268 panel ceiling and its support system. Each conical feature was a substantial 4.5m x 4.5m x 1.7m tall. GRP offered a modular off site lightweight yet robust solution capable of incorporating a 1.5m dia hole matching in with the precast concrete portholes and a band of 12 No premoulded spot lighting recesses. Large scale conical ceiling feature panels would have been difficult to economically construct in other materials. D&D's GRP product delivered a significant weight saving compared to concrete or other stone type solutions.
