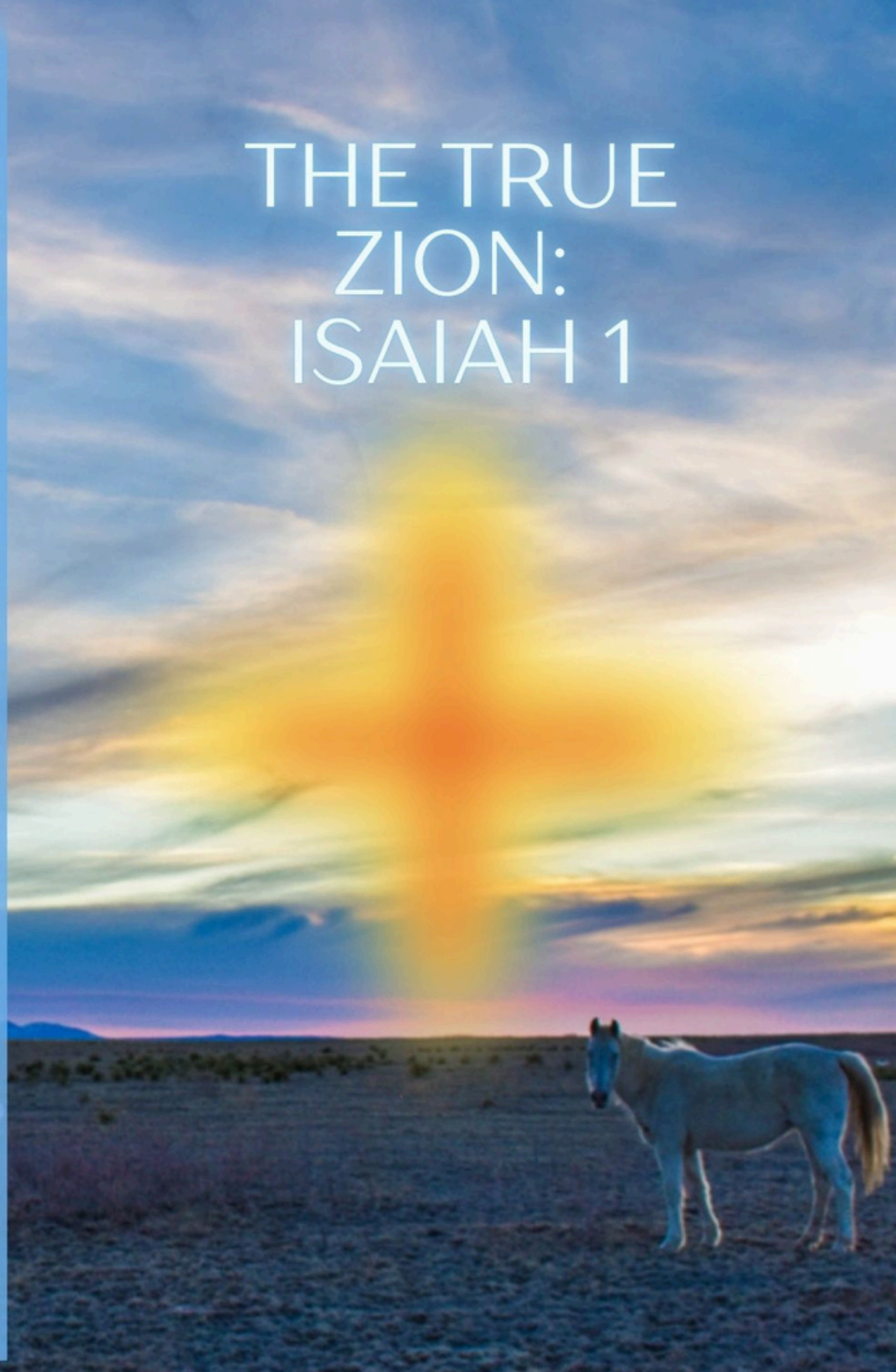

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 1

Isaiah 1 opens with God's wrath toward His people, especially for their vain feasts and sabbaths. They are not helping the fatherless or the widows, for example. After elucidating on His wrath, Isaiah explains that some may be redeemed through Zion, who is personified as a woman or "her." There will be "converts" who follow Her righteousness.

This is the ministry of Daughter Zion. The first step for everyone reading is to understand that Isaiah is a parallel prophecy. Jesus Christ is NOT pleased with the vain works and sacrifices of those who claim His name. He is calling people back to His true righteousness, such as through charity and helping those truly suffering. Zion is the true remnant - it is those who choose righteousness and turn their back on the vanities of the world. Let His true ones repent and turn back to her - Zion - and let their garments become white as snow. This is a call to all reading.

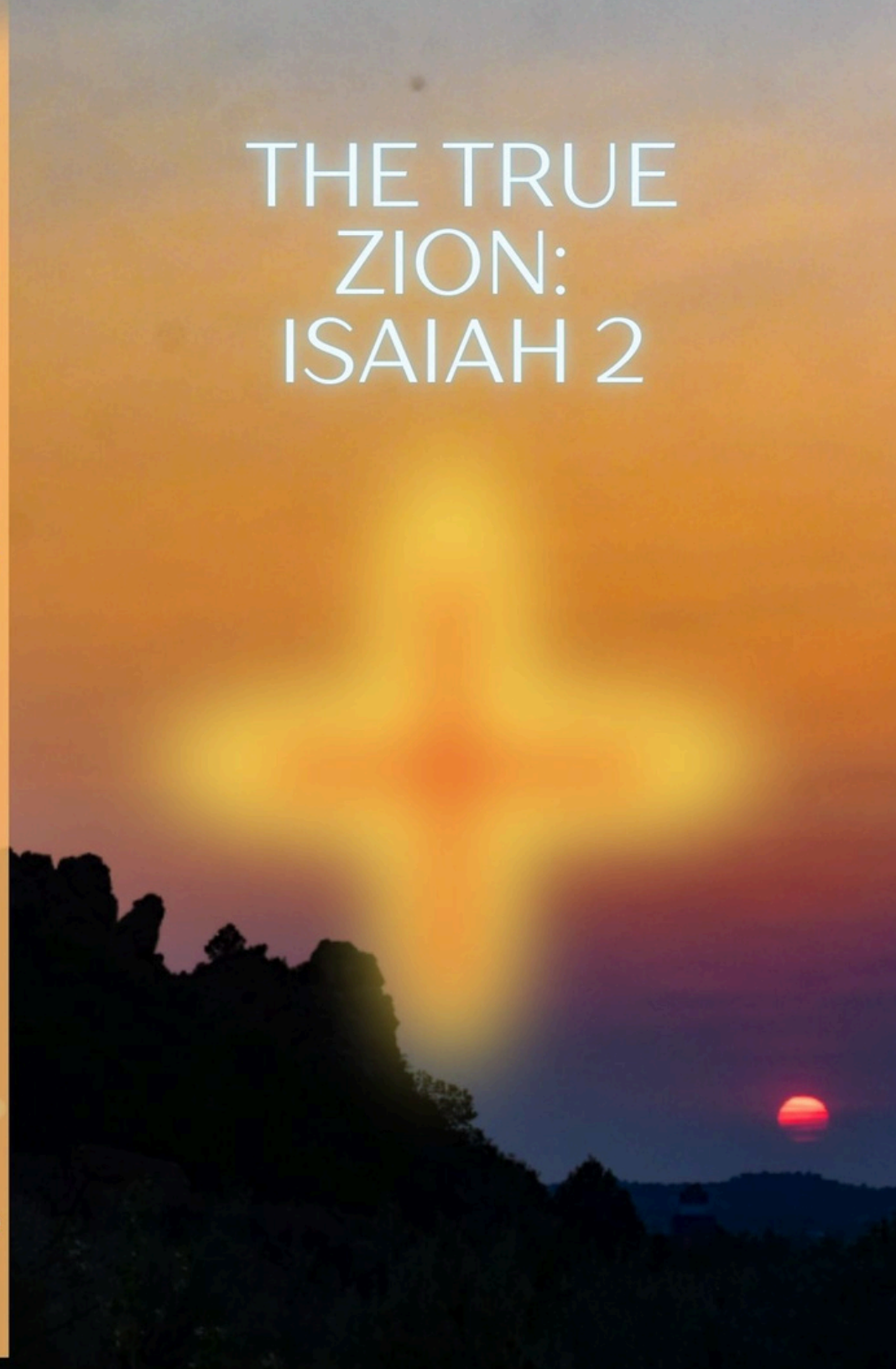


Isaiah 2 explains that in the “latter days” the “the mountain of the house of the Lord” shall be established through Zion. Then, through Zion will come rebukes and even judgment. Zion is responsible for preparing people for “The Day of the Lord.”

In the next section, “The Day of the Lord” is explained. Specifically, God will come against the idols, pride, and haughtiness of His people. Right now, that is the current state of the world, especially the Christian church. The pride of the people and the idol of *self* has overcome them, and they cannot think or see clearly anymore. It is through this ministry one will find rebuke.

Here is the rebuke today. The people, generally, do not really help anyone but themselves. They do not care for the suffering, and because of their comforts, they have been deceived. This is the rebuke from Mount Zion - the last end times ministry - whether anyone likes it or not.

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 2



Isaiah 3 explains that due to the wickedness of the people, much is being taken away, including their bread and support of water. This can be both physical and spiritual, and it is. God is not only going to take away the literal food and water from the people, but He is cutting off His "bread" (Word) and living water (Spirit) due to their sins and lack of repentance.


Not only do they sin, but they have brought this on themselves because they enjoy their sin and cherish it. They have allowed "children" and "women" to rule over them. The men have become women themselves. He will also punish the "daughters of Zion" who are haughty and take away their beauty. Note there is a differentiation between The Daughter Zion and the daughters of Zion. There is one Daughter who has been redeemed through Him. Today, 7/13/25, marks the day of the Beginning of Sorrows.

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 3

Isaiah 4 is perfectly parallel to the world today. The first verse states, "And seven women shall take hold of one man in that day, saying, "We will eat our own bread and wear our own clothes, only let us be called by your name; take away our reproach." The women are "independent", and they wear what they want. On top of that, they no longer honor the names of their husbands but their own names. They believe they are saved by their own egos and identities, and they have forsaken their husbands and the Lord. The haughty daughters of Zion are coming down.

The next section is about the branch of Zion - the remnant - that does not choose this wicked world. There will be one branch that is holy and protected. This is the Ministry of Daughter Zion, and I believe we are the branch spoken of in Isaiah 4. Tiny but mighty, and I prophesy this branch will grow as the world shakes more and more.

This is the true Zion.

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 5

Isaiah 5 expands upon the hedge of protection being removed from God's people. Most take for granted how much Jesus Christ and His Holy Spirit actually protect them, and they do not realize what life is like until this hedge is removed. There is an allusion to the vineyard being destroyed, connected to the branches of the vine that are destroyed in John 15.

Woe to the wicked! Beautiful houses will be destroyed. Those who celebrate will now mourn. Woe to those who are wise in their own eyes! Ultimately, all of God's people, who were protected by His grace, forgot His discipline. God is justice, and He does not forget His righteous. For the sake of the righteous, He must bring discipline to the world, in a final hope that they will repent before the return of Jesus Christ. Verse 30 states, "They will growl over it on that day, like the growling of the sea.

And if one looks to the land,
behold, darkness and distress."
and the light is darkened by its clouds.


Isaiah 6 begins with him seeing a vision of the Lord. He sees how unclean and unholy is compared to God, but he is cleansed by Him.

The Lord then commissions Isaiah to speak to the people, warning him: They hear but do not understand, and they see but do not perceive.

This parallels the times we are in now. People are full of knowledge, but they have no wisdom or understanding. According to *Enduring Word Bible Commentary*, "God told Isaiah to go and preach to a people who wouldn't respond so that their guilt would be certain. As Trapp wrote, Isaiah would 'Preach them to hell'....This is an unsatisfying audience and ministry for any preacher. Isaiah might not be satisfied with this ministry. The people might not be satisfied with it. But God would be satisfied with it."

This is the end times Ministry of Daughter Zion. Few will care or listen, but God will be satisfied.


THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 6



THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 7

Isaiah 7 gives a clear warning, "If you are not firm in faith, you will not be firm at all." This is after prophesying the ruin of Damascus in Syria. As evidence of parallel prophecy, we see great explosions in Damascus even today, and it is close to its ruin. The sleeping people do not notice or care that we are living out the book of Isaiah.

The good news comes next! Jesus Christ Himself is prophesied in this chapter. It states, "Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel." However, it continues that eventually, "In that day every place where there used to be a thousand vines, worth a thousand shekels of silver, will become briars and thorns." We are now in this time of thorns. Still, we always have the hope of Jesus Christ to be a "rose in the desert" amongst the thorns. The Ministry of Daughter Zion is about becoming the living water in the harsh, thorny brush of the end times through our phenomenal Savior Jesus Christ. Be firm in your faith as shakings rock the world.



THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 8

Isaiah 8 begins with a prophecy of an Assyrian Invasion and then gets into a profound verse. It states, "Do not call conspiracy all that this people calls conspiracy, and do not fear what they fear, nor be in dread." This verse can be misinterpreted, but it means sometimes "conspiracy theories" are actually true. Of course, we should not fear. Diving deeper, it explains to only let the Lord be your fear and dread! Remember, the fear of the Lord is the beginning of all wisdom (Proverbs 9:10), and also remember, Wisdom is personified as a woman - a Daughter, perhaps.

Ultimately, all that really matters is focusing on the Lord and preparing for what's to come. It ends by saying people will have contempt for the Lord in what's to come, relying on false spirits and prophecies - putting their hope in them. However, it ends in this chilling verse, "And they will look to the earth, but behold, distress and darkness, the gloom of anguish. And they will be thrust into thick darkness."
Darkness is coming upon the land.

ZION:
ISAIAH 9

Isaiah 9 offers hope. Yes, the world is dark and gloomy, but a child has been born – our savior! It is a prophecy of Jesus’s coming, and it states, “The people who walked in darkness
have seen a great light;
those who dwelt in a land of deep darkness,
on them has light shone.”

It states, “For to us a child is born,
to us a son is given;
and the government shall be upon his
shoulder...”

Truly this is an impeccable and fulfilled prophecy. The government has problems with true Christianity. In fact, Covid was a government attack and conspiracy on Christianity itself.

It ends by reminding us that His people have forgotten the widows, the poor, and the oppressed. This is a reminder to all readers that this ministry is for the oppressed, and we take care of the poor and widows here – not just ourselves. Repent Zion!



THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 10

Isaiah 10 opens with a verse condemning those who oppress, especially the poor and fatherless, stating justice is coming.

There is a prophecy against Assyria, which is now Iraq, Turkey, Syria, and Iran. As most reading know, these turbulent areas are about to break out into even greater war and destruction, fulfilling parallel prophecy.

As this destruction comes, "Mount Zion" is not forgotten, and a remnant rises. It states, "A remnant will return, the remnant of Jacob, to the mighty God." It, however, may be small.

For those who dwell in Zion (us), there is nothing to fear with the "strike" of Assyria that is coming (likely Iran). It ends by stating,

"Behold, the Lord God of hosts
will lop the boughs with terrifying power;
the great in height will be hewn down,
and the lofty will be brought low.

³⁴ He will cut down the thickets of the forest
with an axe,
and Lebanon will fall by the Majestic One."



THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 11

Isaiah 11 is again parallel prophecy. It is not only about the first coming of Jesus Christ, but it is also about His second coming, with the establishment of the New Heaven and New Earth.

First, though, destruction must happen. Isaiah is about God's wrath, and this connects to Revelation, when God's wrath comes upon the Earth once again. His wrath is not about unnecessarily harming anyone - it is about shaking the people to bring them to repentance. Some can only come to the Lord when they have been humbled through righteous discipline.

It speaks of a branch, which "evokes the picture of a green shoot pushing through a seemingly dead stump. The word always points to fresh life that springs from an established root after devastation or dormancy."

Isaiah states, "In that day the Lord will extend his hand yet a second time to recover the remnant that remains of his people." This is the small but mighty remnant of true Zion.

Is the Lord your song?

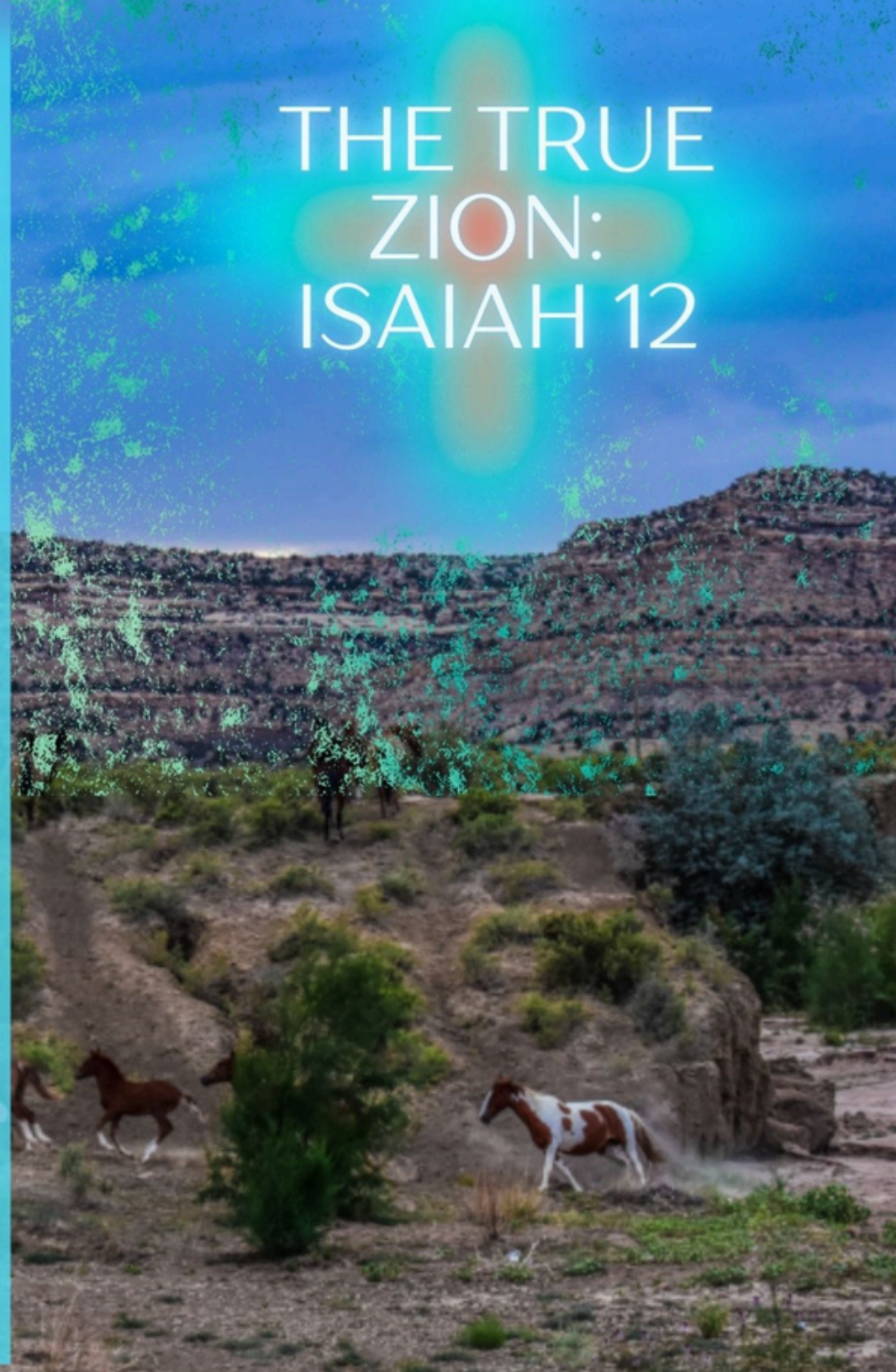
A song is made up of "frequencies." Songs are not just words or music - they are frequencies sent out into the universe.

Isaiah 12 states, "Behold, God is my salvation; I will trust, and will not be afraid; for the Lord God is my strength and my song, and he has become my salvation."

In Revelation 14:3 it states, "And they sang a new song before the throne and before the four living creatures and the elders. No one could learn the song except the 144,000 who had been redeemed from the earth."

I believe this "new" song is a play on the original song. The original song is about hope in utter darkness, and the new song is about rising above even worse with this hope through new creation - the old passing away. Our song is *thanks!* Our song is *hope!* Here are the lyrics: "Shout, and sing for joy, O inhabitant of Zion, for great in your midst is the Holy One of Israel." Hope is our frequency.

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 12



Isaiah 13 begins with a warning of the judgment of Babylon, where every human heart will melt.

It states, "Behold, the day of the Lord comes, cruel, with wrath and fierce anger, to make the land a desolation and to destroy its sinners from it." This chapter mentions the "Chaldeans", which still exist today (See Part 2).

While many debate "who" Babylon is, they miss the different contextual meanings of the term itself. There is the historical Babylon, which went against the one true God and is the root of most modern evil. There is the cultural Babylon, which includes any society or culture that dismisses the one true God. Then, there is the spiritual Babylon, which is about the state of a place's "Spirit", and many have a Babylonian spirit by dwelling in sin, committing idolatry, and generally promoting wickedness. So, Babylon is not just "one place"; however, it largely exists in the first world, with many nations who strive to be like the beast of Babylon. The United States is the heart of Babylon, or Mystery Babylon, and the world follows suit, becoming Babylon itself.

ZION:
ISAIAH 13

Isaiah 14 explains that the Lord will have compassion on Israel, and the true people are not forgotten despite the destruction that abounds. The true Remnant will taunt the Kings of Babylon.

As destruction and chaos grow, the remnant will taunt,

“You too have become as weak as we! You have become like us!” They taunt Satan himself, who through his pride, fell from Heaven.

Yes, for a time it feels as though Satan is winning, but that time is coming to an end. Though the remnant may be small, it is holy, and the power of God is behind them. While many ministries have numbers, they do not have the authentic Holy Spirit.

Very few can actually endure the true power of the Holy Spirit. All in this ministry can withstand its presence, and The Daughter of Zion Ministry is for the true remnant of Israel - not false Christians. Soon, we will see great destruction.

ISAIAH 14

Isaiah 15 discusses an oracle for Moab, and the modern Biblical Moab is east of the Dead Sea, in what is now the modern-day country of Jordan. Jordan is an important country to pay attention to in the end times, and soon it will be at the center of great explosions.

Remember, Isaiah is parallel prophecy. In the oracle, Moab is laid waste in a night, but there will still be a remnant who escape.

Obviously, the Middle East is foundational to end times prophecy, yet sleeping Christians are deceived by false promises of a pre-tribulation rapture. War is about to erupt, and even though it feels like nothing ever happens, none of the words of prophecy will be delayed any longer.

Ezekiel 12:28 states, "Therefore say to them, 'This is what the Sovereign Lord says: None of my words will be delayed any longer; whatever I say will be fulfilled,' declares the Sovereign Lord."

Pay attention to Jordan and its relationship with Israel in coming war.

ZION:
ISAIAH 15

Isaiah 16 is the first section of Isaiah mentioning the “daughter” of Zion. From the Mount of the Daughter of Zion it states, “Give counsel;
grant justice;
make your shade like night
at the height of noon;
shelter the outcasts” - this is the remnant. Really, the remnant includes the “outcasts” of the beast system.

The rest of this chapter is about Moab, and Isaiah is parallel prophecy. Modern Moab is in Jordan, which is essential to end times prophecy.

Moreover, Moab represents the offspring of corrupted union - Lot's incestuous relationship birthing a nation that would consistently oppose God's people. Today's parallel: the beast system has created "offspring" through corrupt unions of technology with demonic influence, birthing systems designed to oppose God's kingdom!

However, there is hope for all corrupted systems, and the outcasts will rise.

ZION:
ISAIAH 16

Isaiah 17 begins with an oracle concerning Damascus, and even as I write this, there are clashing visions of Syria's future - the double prophecy of Isaiah.

Then God explains His anger. The people have forgotten the "God of their salvation." This relates to the Church of Ephesus of Revelation, who has forgotten its first love - Jesus Christ.

Yes, this church has a vine, but it is that of a "stranger" - not the vine of Jesus Christ. In John 15:2, it states, "He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit." Most are under a false vine.

The people have forgotten the "rock of their refuge" - the true church - and they are under a spell of prosperity, Mammon, and itching ears.

Isaiah 17 ends with a warning, "At evening time, behold, terror!

Before morning, they are no more!

This is the portion of those who loot us, and the lot of those who plunder us." This is parallel prophecy coming soon.

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 18



Isaiah 18 starts with an oracle for Cush, which is modern day Ethiopia or Sudan. Remember, Isaiah is parallel prophecy. While people may have forgotten Sudan, it is an important country in geopolitical affairs and end times prophecy. As I write this, Israel is in talks of “resettling” Gaza Palestinians in South Sudan, and Sudan’s famine is entering a dangerous new phase.

While Americans go to sleepy churches and spend hours in entertainment, true suffering abounds. The Lord, Jesus Christ, is looking for the “dwelling” of His true people, which are few.

He finds Mount Zion. Yes, Mount Zion is a physical location, but it is also a spiritual location, coming directly from Daughter Zion, who speaks to the Lord Himself.

How the people continue to dismiss her! How the people persecute her! The vengeance of Jesus Christ is coming to those who have come against His Daughter, and soon, the Americans will feel the suffering of Sudan. Repent and hear from Mount Zion speaking to you now!





THE TRUE
ZION:
ISAIAH 19

Isaiah 19 begins with a prophecy against Egypt, and as written in this series, Isaiah is parallel prophecy. As I write this, tensions are brewing, with Egypt warning that “displacing Gazans a ‘red line,’ would be the end of the ‘Palestinian cause.’”

Perhaps most spectacular in this prophecy is a warning that states, “And the waters of the sea will be dried up,
and the river will be dry and parched,
and its canals will become foul,
and the branches of Egypt's Nile will diminish and dry up,
reeds and rushes will rot away.”

As I write this, the Nile is drying up.

The prophecy ends with the “stupid counsel” of Egypt, and how great confusion is coming upon the land. Still, there will be a “striking and healing” and many will return to the Lord. However, this warning stands out: “In that day the Egyptians will be like women, and tremble with fear before the hand that the Lord of hosts shakes over them.”



THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 20

Isaiah 20 begins with another sign against Egypt and Cush. One line that stands out is this: "As my servant Isaiah has walked naked and barefoot for three years as a sign and a portent against Egypt and Cush." If someone was walking around naked and barefoot today, they would be considered homeless, mentally ill, or even arrested.

According to Mathew Henry's Concise Commentary, "The world will often deem believers foolish, when singular in obedience to God. But the Lord will support his servants under the most trying effects of their obedience; and what they are called upon to suffer for his sake, commonly is light, compared with what numbers groan under from year to year from sin. Those who make any creature [human] their expectation and glory, and so put it in the place of God, will, sooner or later, be ashamed of it. But disappointment in creature-confidences, instead of driving us to despair, should drive us to God, and our expectation shall not be in vain." In other words, you might have to be willing to be called crazy to serve God truly.

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 21

Isaiah 21 concerns the fall of Babylon. It states, "A treacherous dealer deals treacherously." This sounds a lot like Donald Trump's "Art of the Deal", and who is the one who makes deals, anyway? Satan.

It then relates to the "birth pangs" of a woman, directing us to the Revelation 12 woman.

It then speaks of the watchmen crying out that "Babylon is fallen!"

This leads us directly to Revelation 18, the fall of Babylon. Isaiah and Revelation are directly parallel, and Isaiah is double prophecy.

Trump is the Anti-Christ.

There is a Revelation 12 woman that rises, and this may be one individual woman. Remember, God can choose individuals.

Babylon will fall.

Yes, it may seem like Trump is succeeding, and that is because the Anti-Christ does have victory for a short time. However, God is not finished yet, and there is a remnant that rises.



At times it feels God's true people are forgotten. The book of Isaiah runs through great destruction, and as Isaiah 22 states, "The breaches of the city of David were many."

This is not just literal - this is spiritual. The people of David are often persecuted, destroyed, and conspired against, especially Daughter Zion.

Isaiah 22 states that "long ago" God planned justice, and this justice benefits His true ones - the House of David - they are not forgotten. In a sense, "the key of David" is always restored, and this parallels Revelation 3, with the Church of Philadelphia.

Isaiah, Daniel, and Revelation are all parallel. In Isaiah we see the prophecy of great destruction, and this is paralleled in Revelation - the time we live in now. In Daniel, we see an explanation of mystery of Revelation, and this verse stands out:

"³ And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever." This is the opening of the book of Wisdom, and the truly wise will gather with Daughter Zion. This calls for Wisdom.

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 22 AND THE BOOK OF WISDOM



THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 23

Modern Tyre and Sidon are located in Lebanon, and this chapter begins with an oracle against them. Since

Isaiah is parallel prophecy, we see the same with Lebanon today. Recent major strikes have occurred in Lebanon, and this country is truly prominent in the end times narrative. What was before will be again, and there is nothing new under the sun (Ecclesiastes 1:9).

As Isaiah 23 states, "There is no restraint anymore."

God's restraint is being removed!

Next, the Chaldeans are mentioned, who are the "Babylonians." They exist today in many forms, and all evil can be fundamentally traced back to Babylon. While hope is still given at the end of Isaiah 23, we are now in the end times. Yes, there is hope, but not for Babylon or the Chaldeans - if they do not repent.

According to Revelation 18, Babylon will fall, and so will the Chaldeans. Revelation 18:9 states, "⁹"The kings of the earth who committed fornication and lived luxuriously with her will weep and lament for her, when they see the smoke of her burning,¹⁰ standing at a distance for fear of her torment, saying, 'Alas, alas, that great city Babylon, that mighty city! For in one hour your judgment has come.' PS: The Chaldeans hate and conspire against Daughter Zion.

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 24

Isaiah 24 is about judgment on the whole Earth. In other words, Jesus Christ will turn things upside down, and the Earth will mourn and wither. It states, "the highest people of the earth languish."

This chapter is all about the punishment of the wicked, and there will be nothing anyone can do about it.

Chapter 24 states,

"For the windows of heaven are opened,
and the foundations of the earth tremble.

¹⁹ The earth is utterly broken,

the earth is split apart,

the earth is violently shaken.

²⁰ The earth staggers like a drunken man;

it sways like a hut;

its transgression lies heavy upon it,

and it falls, and will not rise again."

The only place safe is "Mount Zion" where the "Lord of Hosts" reigns. It states, "Then the moon will be confounded

and the sun ashamed,

for the Lord of hosts reigns

on Mount Zion and in Jerusalem,

and his glory will be before his elders."

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 25

Isaiah 25 is a beautiful and victorious chapter about God swallowing up death forever. It is a chapter of hope and victory, where His true people wait for Him, and they are victorious.

Believe it or not, this chapter ties to Daniel 11. In Daniel 11:38, it speaks about how the "son of perdition" or "Anti-Christ" will honor a god of "fortresses."

In Isaiah 25:12, it states that the Lord will bring down the "fortress" of the "high fort" and bring it to dust.

According to Strong's Hebrew Concordance, these fortresses can symbolize the following:

1. Human Protection Is Conditional. Fortresses provide real safety only when accompanied by covenant fidelity.
2. Divine Sovereignty over Military Might. God grants or removes security; walls are no match for His decree.
3. Spiritual Fortification. Obedience, truth, and faith are stronger bulwarks than stone (cf. [Psalm 18:2](#), though employing a different Hebrew word).
4. Eschatological Overtones. Prophetic oracles against arrogant "strongholds" prefigure final judgment on proud human structures opposing God's kingdom."

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 26



Isaiah 26 is about the righteous, who barely exist today. Surely, many profess His name, but they are not obeying or following Him. How does our Lord feel about this righteous group? They give Him "perfect peace."

He trusts in the righteous.

Yes, God must trust, too! How does He know to trust us?

He trusts us by our fruits - by what we produce - not just by what we say.

Further, His judgment is for repentance according to Isaiah 26: "For when your judgments are in the earth, the inhabitants of the world learn righteousness."

Further, it states that they start to pray again when discipline is upon them.

Discipline is needed upon this evil and wicked world, and I declare it begins now by my authority in Jesus's name. This is not just any ministry. This is the Ministry of

Daughter Zion, and I have been called by God to announce His reckoning! His righteous will not be forgotten, and justice is served! According to Isaiah 26:

"For behold, the Lord is coming out from his place to punish the inhabitants of the earth for their iniquity,

and the earth will disclose the blood shed on it, and will no more cover its slain." The righteous, though very few, are ready!



THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 27

Isaiah 27 speaks of the redemption of Israel. Though great suffering will come upon the nations, this is ultimately about leading people back to the Lord and to holy repentance.

While there is great debate about the identity of Israel, the truth is this: Israel always represents God's true people. Many can claim to be Israel, but Israel encompasses those who come to repentance and back to God. Israel can be spiritual or physical, and remember, there can be those who falsely claim to be "Israel."

Israel literally means "God prevails" or "God strives." So, then, this debate about who "Israel" represents is tainted. Political views and conspiracies reign supreme, but here is the truth:

Israel is a remnant in the Bible, who rises in Revelation. They are not "The Synagogue of Satan" - those who claim they are Jews but are not (Revelation 3:9). They are those who either a) obey the Lord or b) repent for not obeying Him and come back to Him. They are a small remnant that rises, and they are part of the true Zion - not a political, nefarious misleading Zion. It is spiritual, and the true Israel and true Zion is in this ministry reading this post right now.



THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 28

Isaiah 28 speaks about judgment on the people who have completely forgotten Him and His ways. They (Jerusalem) have made a covenant with Hell and death itself. God sends Zion - the true Queen of Peace - a tried cornerstone.

There is the pure Daughter Zion who stands before the tainted Daughter Jerusalem. She is the replacement for their debauchery and drunkenness. Jesus Christ sends Daughter Zion and declares, "16 Behold, I am laying a stone in Zion, a tested stone, a precious cornerstone: for a foundation in Zion! A believer will not be put to shame. 17 I'll make justice your measuring line!"

This, the Ministry of Daughter Zion, brings peace, but first, shakings must occur.

God is going to unleash rivers on dry land (Isaiah 43:19).

Let's declare rivers in the desert! The Spirit of Judgment will pour out through you and bring justice. Mockers of God (the "Daughter Jerusalem") will be put to shame (Isaiah 28:3).

Their covenant with death (hell) is broken.

They will be swept away.

Their false peace is shattered.

All their systems and plans will collapse.



THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 29

Isaiah 29 speaks boldly about those who come against Mount Zion:

“As when a hungry man dreams, and behold, he is eating,
and awakes with his hunger not satisfied,
or as when a thirsty man dreams, and behold, he is drinking,
and awakes faint, with his thirst not quenched,
so shall the multitude of all the nations be that fight against Mount Zion.”

The people’s eyes are closed, and they are spiritually asleep. He speaks of the people who “honor Him with their lips” but their fruit is not apparent.

The Lord will turn everything upside in an instant! The blind shall see, and the hiding wicked will face His blinding light and wrath.

Through Mount Zion, justice is coming! Praise the Lord, justice is coming. The wicked hate justice, but the righteous rejoice. The very few righteous are remembered by the Lord, and their vindication begins. Daughter Zion declares, “The time for justice is at hand. Isaiah 29 is parallel prophecy, and the seals have been loosened. Get ready, Babylon, to meet your Maker!”

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 30



Isaiah 30 speaks of the rebellious children of God who lie and do not hear Him clearly. They come against the true prophets and listen to the lying prophets, which speak to them "smooth things." In response, the Lord says, "Because you despise this word and trust in oppression and perverseness and rely on them,

¹³ therefore this iniquity shall be to you...

whose breaking comes suddenly, in an instant;

¹⁴ and its breaking is like that of a potter's vessel

that is smashed so ruthlessly

that among its fragments not a shard is found

with which to take fire from the hearth,

or to dip up water out of the cistern."

There is only one place of true safety: Zion! Zion teaches, "This is the way, walk in it, when you turn to the right or when you turn to the left." Zion helps people forsake their idols.

The Assyrians will be terrified (The Modern Middle East), but the Lord will come and bind up the brokenness of His people. It states, "And the Lord will cause his majestic voice to be heard and the descending blow of his arm to be seen, in furious anger and a flame of devouring fire, with a cloudburst and storm and hailstones." Jesus Christ is coming back soon.



THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 31

Isaiah 31 begins with an allusion to Psalms:

“Some trust in chariots and some in horses,
but we trust in the name of the Lord our God.”
(Psalm 20:7)

It explains that while people trust in “chariots”, they do not look to the holy one of Israel - the Lord.

The Lord will come down and fight for “Mount Zion” - He will protect and deliver them.

Related to today, so many have spent their time trusting in men (alive and dead), horses, and their gold and silver.

The truth is that all we truly “have” is Jesus Christ. He is our Lord, and we must consult Him moment by moment, especially in the darkness of the end times.

Most of all, the Lord’s “fire” is in Zion, and this is the Ministry of Daughter Zion. This is the last true end times ministry, and it takes holiness to dwell here.

Are you able to cast out your idols and join us today?
Are you able to choose Jesus Christ over your sins?



THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 32

Isaiah 32 speaks against “women who are at ease”, which is the majority of women in the first world at this point. The Lord calls them “careless daughters.” He states that they will have many years of suffering due to their lack of care, and they should wear sackcloth and mourn. The complacent women are coming to disaster. Remember, Isaiah is parallel prophecy.

As a woman myself, I have a right to speak about the women. Many have been overcome by Jezebel, the “Whore of Babylon”, and a false Jesus. They cannot be bothered with anything but themselves. They are consumed by jealousy and envy, and instead of improving themselves, they tear other women down who may have victory. Instead of improving, it is easier to come against others.

Generally, they are not the “Proverbs 31 Woman.” They are complacent regarding the needs of the poor and the needs of others. They have many false spirits and have forsaken what it means to be true women of God. They are consumed with themselves.

They are coming under His wrath, especially for not supporting His true Daughter: Daughter Zion.

Take heed, complacent women! Your time is up!



THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 33

Isaiah 33 states the Lord fills Zion with judgment and righteousness. There are “valiant” ones who support Zion, who dwell in Her mission. A valiant one shows courage and determination.

Isaiah 33:6 states, “The fear of the Lord is Zion's treasure.”

Consider: The fear of the Lord is beginning of Wisdom (Proverbs 9:20), and therefore, Zion is wise.

Consider: The cowardly are not fearful of the Lord but fearful of the world instead, and they will be cast into the lake of fire (Revelation 21:8).

It takes bravery to dwell in Zion!

There is a fierce people of “deep speech” who dwell in Zion, and the stammering people cannot understand

These people will lead the true ones to the true Zion, the New Heaven and New Earth – the New Jerusalem where there will be no more tears.

Follow the Ministry of Daughter Zion, the last true ministry, leading to the New Heaven, New Earth.

Isaiah 34 is about the day of vengeance - the time of recompense for Zion's sake. The Lord is enraged against all nations, and this parallels Revelation. What was before will be again, and there is nothing new under the sun (Ecc. 1:9). The heavens will be rolled together as a scroll, and great destruction will come upon the Earth.

There is some type of "controversy" of Zion that will be revealed with God's justice. He will explain the truth about Zion and what she really experienced. There will be revelation of the true Zion versus the false Zion (Synagogue of Satan).

The kings, nobles, and princes shall come down, and they will be nothing. The only hope is to seek the "book" or "Word" of the Lord, which some are doing. However, many have been deceived by their own itching ears, thinking they will escape what is to come.

Of course, those who dwell in the shelter place of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty!
(Psalm 91).

The time of wrath has begun, whether anyone wants to admit it or not. Zion's vindication begins now.

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 34



THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 35

Isaiah 35 begins with imagery of the “rose in the desert” - with the desert rejoicing and the blossoming of a rose - to symbolize beauty after much terror.

Daughter Zion reminds us of this: Be strong - fear not! The Lord’s recompense comes quickly. He is coming to save His true remnant.

When Jesus Christ returns, everything will turn around for the better, and this is promised to those who find “the way of holiness” or “the narrow path.” The fools will not follow this path or understand.

The “ransomed” of the Lord shall all return to Zion, singing songs of everlasting joy, even a new song. All sorrow and sighing shall flee away!

This is the promise for His true ones - the New Heaven, New Earth - the New Jerusalem.

The rose in the desert starts here at the Ministry of Daughter Zion. All who follow will drink from the cup of living water and see the glory of the Bride, dressed in garments as white as snow.



Isaiah 36 discusses the Assyrian king Sennacherib's invasion of the Kingdom of Judah, where his commander, Rabshakeh, attempts to psychologically intimidate King Hezekiah and the people of Judah into surrender by mocking their trust in God.

However, the people did not respond to this mockery.

Isaiah 36 is all about trusting in God and His amazing power, and the time is coming where many of us will face a similar situation or already have. We will be mocked and persecuted for our true belief in Jesus Christ. This is not the belief of the false churches regarding their prosperity gospel. This is the belief that no matter how much we suffer, Jesus Christ is going to deliver us.

People will surely mock. According to 2 Peter 3:4, "They will say, "Where is this 'coming' he promised? Ever since our ancestors died, everything goes on as it has since the beginning of creation." Let us be silent in mockery and be patient in His coming, which may mean great suffering and persecution.

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 36



THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 37



Isaiah 37 is a chapter about not losing hope in the Lord's promises and the renewal of Judah. Hezekiah seeks Isaiah's help as Rabshakeh continues to mock those who trust in the Lord.

Still, Hezekiah does not give in. It is bad - the people have lost hope, and they have turned to false gods and chariots, just as they have today. They believe in men over God, so Hezekiah calls out boldly to the one true Lord and asks for deliverance of His people.

Daughter Zion comes against the wickedness of the land! She comes against the Assyria of those days and the Assyria of today - those who claim "godlike" authority - Babylon itself.

However, the House of Judah returns through Daughter Zion. It states, "And the surviving remnant of the house of Judah shall again take root downward and bear fruit upward.³² For out of Jerusalem shall go a remnant, and out of Mount Zion a band of survivors. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will do this." This begins today in the Ministry of Daughter Zion.

Isaiah 38 is not just about Hezekiah's healing. It is about time warfare. The Lord adjusts the "sun dial" or time itself to add to Hezekiah's life as he is dying.

So, then, who is to put God into a box? Who is to say that God cannot time travel or manipulate time Himself if He wants to? Is our Lord bound by time? Miracles still happen, and He can perform them today.

At this moment in time, the true Israel is rotten and destitute. There are very few, if anyone, who truly cares what I write, prophesy, or say. My own ministry has been destroyed by Satan's time manipulations and attacks many times.

So, then, I ask Jesus Christ to fix time for me. I declare Law 386, that Jesus Christ will adjust time to restore what was stolen from me by Satan. Like Hezekiah I say,

"The Lord will save me,
and we will play my music on stringed
instruments
all the days of our lives,
at the house of the Lord."

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 38



THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 39

Isaiah 39 is a warning to those who worship Mammon, which is most today. If the majority of your day is consumed by the thought of bills, your home, and food, you are truly honoring your materials more than the Lord.

In this chapter, after Hezekiah is miraculously healed, he shows off all of his possessions and riches in a prideful way to Babylonian envoys. The prophet Isaiah confronts Hezekiah, warning him all of his possessions would be taken away.

Upon hearing Isaiah's warning, Hezekiah, in humility stated, "The word of the Lord you say is good." His humility prevented further wrath from God.

This is a great message to this ministry. Humility is always the perfect route. I am warning all readers that God is about to take away much of the things that you all adore. While nothing can stop the tribulation coming, God can have mercy on those who choose to show humility now. The Ministry of Daughter Zion sends out a warning: Repent! The Kingdom of Heaven is at hand! Let go of your idols and worship Him!

Isaiah 40 is full of hope and comfort for God's people. Zion makes straight a highway in preparation for Jesus's coming return. Zion cries, "In the wilderness prepare the way of the Lord; make straight in the desert a highway for our God." Zion forms a narrow path.

Zion gives encouragement from the mountain top. Jesus Christ will bring recompense to His true people! Remember the power of God - we are like grasshoppers in His eyes:

*"Do you not know? Do you not hear?
Has it not been told you from the beginning?
Have you not understood from the foundations
of the earth?"*

*²²It is he who sits above the circle of the earth,
and its inhabitants are like grasshoppers;
who stretches out the heavens like a curtain,
and spreads them like a tent to dwell in;
²³who brings princes to nothing,
and makes the rulers of the earth as emptiness."*

He has not forgotten us! He does not grow weary!
He is our one true God, and He will help us.

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 40



THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 41



Isaiah 41 is a reminder about the Lord's power - He is the First and the Last. He states, "I am He."

The following classic verses come from this chapter:

"Fear not, for I am with you;
be not dismayed, for I am your God;
I will strengthen you, I will help you,
I will uphold you with my righteous right hand."

Interestingly, the Lord is the first to say to Zion that there is good news, but people are too consumed by their idols to notice or care. They are all in a grand delusion.

This pertains directly to Revelation. Daughter Zion gives good news - that the King is coming soon. Still, no one can hear her, for they have become consumed by their idols.

Isaiah 41 states, "Behold, they are all a delusion;
their works are nothing;
their metal images are empty wind."

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 42



Isaiah 42 is about the promise of the Lord's justice. He does not grow tired or weary, and the former things are coming to pass. He is bringing new things. This is where we are now.

Isaiah 42 references the new song of Revelation - the new frequency for the New Heaven, New Earth. One theory is that the new song is only heard at a higher level of frequency - that it takes a certain amount of "holiness" to hear this song.

This chapter is also connected to the Revelation 12 woman, who is Daughter Zion. It states, "For a long time I have held my peace;
I have kept still and restrained myself;
now I will cry out like a woman in labor."

Unfortunately, Israel cannot hear or see the truth. Nearly all are deceived, and they forsake the truth of this ministry. Who is brave enough to stand with me?

**"Who among you will give ear to this,
will attend and listen for the time to come?"**

Isaiah 43 emphasizes the beauty, perfection, and power of our Lord. He brings forth His remnant, returning the blind and the deaf. He comes for the witnesses of truth.

He is the only savior. There is no savior other than Him! Yet, the end times people have falsified His mission to save, claiming it is about prosperity or blessings. The truth is this: They have forgotten the cross He carries, and they do not understand the power of His salvation. They have words, but they are empty! They misunderstand Him!

Dark times are coming and are here, but the blind and deaf people cannot hear or see. Only He, the Holy Lord of Israel, can make a true way in the wilderness. He does not need or want your offerings - He wants your obedience and trust. He wants your faith restored, and He wants you to remember who He truly is - Your Savior.

Let us praise and worship our true King, the Holy One of Israel, Jesus Christ. He is our Lord, Savior, and He makes a way in the darkness for us.

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 43



Isaiah 44 is about claiming, "I am the Lord's" and denying the "folly" of idolatry. There is no one like the Lord, yet people spend time worshipping foolish idols. The idols of the past were, perhaps, golden or wooden. The idols of today are false paradigms, including false gods of work, others' approvals, and false views of Jesus Christ Himself.

Isaiah 44 warns that most have lost their discernment, but there is still a true remnant of Israel. This is not the false Zion created by government states or corporations. This is the true Zion of a people who are crying out to God for justice.

God promises the true Zion that "She shall be inhabited." So, she, Daughter Zion, like a sunflower always looking to the Sun, looks to the Son for continuous hope. Those who are in Zion never lose hope in the promises of Jesus Christ, even as the world crashes and burns around them. Still, they cry out to Him. **Truly, do you see the signs around? Let us gather now around the true Son, Jesus Christ!**

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 44



Isaiah 45 is an important reminder of our Lord as the only true God. It states,

“For thus says the Lord,
who created the heavens
(he is God!),
who formed the earth and made it
(he established it;
he did not create it empty,
he formed it to be inhabited!):
“I am the Lord, and there is no other.
19 I did not speak in secret,
in a land of darkness;
I did not say to the offspring of Jacob,
‘Seek me in vain.’^[c]
I the Lord speak the truth;
I declare what is right.”

It also states, “Assemble yourselves and come;
draw near together,
you survivors of the nations!”

Are you ready to gather or still waiting for more signs? Sores are coming upon the world.

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 45



Isaiah 46 is about the idols that one carries as the ultimate burden. However, it is a reminder of who really cares for us: The one true God of Israel. Nothing compares to Him, not gold - not anything.

The Lord reminds us that He is charge of the beginning and end. There is no one like Him, and there will never be anyone like Him.

He says that He uses Zion as a source of salvation.

**“Listen to me, you stubborn of heart,
you who are far from righteousness:
13 I bring near my righteousness; it is not far off,
and my salvation will not delay;
I will put salvation in Zion,
for Israel my glory.”**

This is Zion. Zion is not necessarily a physical church. It is where truth is found in the end times.

Daughter Zion brings the truth in the end times, and this is her ministry. Are you brave enough to be a part of it? Are you brave enough to examine the narrative of the false churches? The end is not near. It is here.

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 46



Isaiah 47 is deeply connected to the book of Revelation. In this book, our Lord Jesus Christ, comes against the Babylonians, the Chaldeans. These are the enemies of Daughter Zion. The Lord states, "Your nakedness shall be uncovered, and your disgrace shall be seen.

I will take vengeance,
and I will spare no one."

People feel "secure in their wickedness" - thinking no one sees them. To note, in the end times, most do not even think they are in wickedness, as evil has become good and good has become evil.

Everything is upside down and twisted.

It explains that the people feel protected by their sorceries (drugs, pharmaceuticals, vaccines, magick, witchcraft, etc.), and perhaps they even succeed and inspire terror. However, Jesus Christ sees them, and He explains, their wickedness shall come to an end.

It ends, **"They wander about, each in his own direction;
there is no one to save you."**

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 47



Isaiah 48 explains that the people of Israel are stubborn and obstinate, and they cannot understand the "new" things.

That is exactly the problem with the ministry. I introduce "new" and people back away. They idolize the old - they do not long for the new. Still, Jesus Christ does not give up, refining His people through the furnace of fire.

He does not speak in secret like the Chaldeans (Babylonians, Satanists, Occultists). Rather, the Lord calls out, "Go out from Babylon, flee from Chaldea, declare this with a shout of joy, proclaim it, send it out to the end of the earth;"

He ends with this brutal verse:

"There is no peace," says the Lord, "for the wicked."
Come into the new.

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 48



THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 49



Isaiah 49 is about how God can choose anyone to be the “light” of the world. He can take one person and make them a light to the nations – even if the world cannot understand how that is so. God restores Israel, ultimately.

But Zion said, “The Lord has forsaken me; my Lord has forgotten me.” Still, the Lord reassures Zion she is not forgotten, and He is restoring her.

The times are bleak. If there is a remnant of those who can handle the truth, it is scattered and currently in a state of ashes.

However, God makes Zion a light to the nations, even if people cannot see how this is possible. The world cannot understand the things of God. The Lord states, “I will make your oppressors eat their own flesh,
and they shall be drunk with their own blood as with wine.

Then all flesh shall know
that I am the Lord your Savior,
and your Redeemer, the Mighty One of Jacob.”

Isaiah 50 details how God allowed Israel (personified as "Daughter Zion") to be carried off to exile/servitude – NOT as divorce, but as discipline (like a loving Father correcting a rebellious child). God allowed Israel to be handed over to Babylon as discipline. God did not abandon Israel, but He did bring them to discipline for breaking their covenant. However, God promises a path for those who resume in righteousness. This is parallel to the times we live in now.

Truly, most are under Babylonian power, structures, and influence, whether they even realize it or not. This writing right now is a call to come out of sin and return to Jesus Christ – perfecting ourselves and getting our garments white. Step 1: Drop your Babylonian idols and return to serving Him.

It ends, "Who among you fears the Lord and obeys the voice of his servant?
Let him who walks in darkness
and has no light
trust in the name of the Lord
and rely on his God."



THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 50





THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 51

The Lord comforts Zion. Profound words! Isaiah 51 states, "He comforts all her waste places and makes her wilderness like Eden, her desert like the garden of the Lord; joy and gladness will be found in her, thanksgiving and the voice of song."

He reminds us not to fear the "reproach" of men because they will fade away, but His righteousness is forever.

How can we fear the wrath of the oppressor when we see how wonderful and amazing our Creator is? Our fear is foolishness because we are comforted and saved by Him. Despite His comfort, He warns those who have refused His righteousness. He says, "devastation and destruction, famine and sword; who will comfort you?^[d]

²⁰ Your sons have fainted;
they lie at the head of every street
like an antelope in a net;
they are full of the wrath of the Lord,
the rebuke of your God."

It is time to repent, everyone.



THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 52

Isaiah 52 states,

“Awake, awake,
put on your strength, O Zion;
put on your beautiful garments,
O Jerusalem, the holy city;
for there shall no more come into you
the uncircumcised and the unclean.
2 Shake yourself from the dust and arise;
be seated, O Jerusalem;
loose the bonds from your neck,
O captive daughter of Zion.”

Though Jerusalem has mostly become wasteland, the Lord is still reigning, gathering the true remnant to Him through Zion. All ends of the Earth shall see His salvation.

This chapter also prophesied the Son of Man, Jesus Christ, and His “marred appearance” and power over Kings.

Listen, Zion, and purify yourselves! Come back to the King of Kings, Jesus Christ!



THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 53

Have you worshiped Jesus Christ today? Have you thanked Him yet today?

Isaiah 53:3 — 'Despised and rejected, a man of sorrows'

Isaiah 53:4 — 'Surely He bore... our griefs'

Isaiah 53:5 — 'Wounded for OUR transgressions'

Isaiah 53:6 — 'God laid on Him the iniquity of US ALL'

Isaiah 53:7 — 'Oppressed/Afflicted/Silent'

Isaiah 53:8 — 'Grave with wicked... rich man's tomb'

Isaiah 53:10 — 'He shall see seed, prolong days'

Isaiah 53:12 — 'Divide him with the great'

Isaiah 53 is the seed of the Ministry of Daughter Zion. However, the people have gone their "own way" - forgetting the true doctrine of His sacrifice and what it means.

Jesus Christ can intercede right now for any sin, any trauma, any torture, and any failing. Do not think it is too late. Are you still breathing? Then, wake up! Come back! Join this ministry and fellowship with us. The days are short and wicked, and all we will have is each other.



Isaiah 54 speaks of God's eternal covenant - that even when it feels like He has abandoned- He never forgets his promises.

It states, "For a brief moment I deserted you, but with great compassion I will gather you.
8 In overflowing anger for a moment I hid my face from you, but with everlasting love I will have compassion on you,"
says the Lord, your Redeemer

Many believe God never disciplines, punishes, or even comes against His people, but that is not true. There is a time and place for His wrath, but it is all for his ultimate purpose of His love.

There is a time when God hides his face (Isaiah 50:8), but it is not rejection. It is a desperate plea for His people to get right with Him and come back to Him - righteousness. It states, "In righteousness you shall be established; you shall be far from oppression, for you shall not fear."



THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 55

Isaiah 55 speaks these deeply important words:

“Seek the Lord while he may be found;
call upon him while he is near;
⁷ let the wicked forsake his way,
and the unrighteous man his thoughts;
let him return to the Lord, that he may have
compassion on him,
and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon.

⁸ For my thoughts are not your thoughts,
neither are your ways my ways, declares the
Lord.

⁹ For as the heavens are higher than the earth,
so are my ways higher than your ways
and my thoughts than your thoughts.”

We are in the last days, and people take God’s presence for granted. Each day, society grows more godless, and there will be a time when views such as those of this ministry are considered “too radical” and outlawed. This is the time to seek the Lord, Jesus Christ, while He can be found. It is also a reminder to examine your thoughts and consider if they are godly or of the world.



THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 56

Isaiah 56 reminds us that God does not forget those who keep His covenants and pursue righteousness. Even “foreigners” are accepted before the Lord, if they follow His precepts. To note, this goes against theories that God cares only about a particular “race” or “bloodline.” True Israel becomes those who decide to truly follow Him. It is a transformation of our blood through Jesus Christ. In fact, God often accepts the “outcasts of Israel.”

Then, there is a warning given to the irresponsible leaders of Israel, which are prevalent today, all around, in these dark end times churches:

**“But they are shepherds who have no understanding;
they have all turned to their own way,
each to his own gain, one and all.
12 “Come,” they say, “let me get wine;
let us fill ourselves with strong drink;
and tomorrow will be like this day,
great beyond measure.”**

Wolves in sheep’s clothing, prowling and devouring.

Isaiah 57 begins with the juxtaposition of the righteous and the wickedness of the idolatrous. Line 13 fiercely states, "When you cry out, let your collection of idols deliver you!" However, those who take refuge in Jesus Christ possess the land and inherit the holy mountain.

God has not forgotten the contrite, an intriguing word choice. According to Strong's 1793, it means "crushed." The contrite stand out to the Lord because they know His suffering, and they understand the "spirit of the lowly." Many forget Jesus Christ humbled Himself, and the Strong's translation for this phrase is more literally "humble spirit." Humility is a word gone from modern society. Most have become comfortable - not contrite - and most have elevated themselves. Therefore, there is a small remnant who is contrite and humbled, and Jesus Christ has not forgotten them.

For a perfect ending: "Peace, peace, to the far and to the near," says the Lord,
"and I will heal him.

²⁰ But the wicked are like the tossing sea;
for it cannot be quiet,
and its waters toss up mire and dirt.

²¹ **There is no peace," says my God, "for the wicked."**



THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 57



THE TRUE
ZION:
ISAIAH 58

Isaiah 58 calls out true versus false fasting. He says they fast while “oppressing their own workers.” This rings true of modern times, with churches hosting charity and fasting events, while feeding themselves. Truthfully, do churches even fast anymore? This ministry does.

The Lord clarifies fasting should be for true purposes of loosening the chains of wickedness - not for show. For those who fast for the right reasons, they will be restored.

He reminds us about not seeking our own pleasure, or talking idly, a major sin of modern times. People engage in meaningless and endless small talk and debate, especially in online ministries. They quarrel instead of uplifting. They gossip instead of encouraging.

They post empty words instead of taking actionable steps like fasting or helping others.

It ends in a positive note, however, stating if people follow the correct way. “Then you shall take delight in the Lord, and I will make you ride on the heights of the earth.” Hallelujah.

Isaiah 59 reminds us that it is sin that separates us from the face of God. Many believe God has abandoned them, but the opposite is true. They abandon Him through their sins. There is corruption on every level, especially in law and justice. They weave "the spider's web" of deception, and those who eat her eggs die. They shed innocent blood, engage in iniquity, and they do not know peace. There is no peace for the wicked. Many cry out for justice, but there is none - well, that is not entirely true.

Justice is back, beginning with this ministry. Even as I write this, I am fighting corruption in education and law. The Lord states, "According to their deeds, so will he repay, wrath to his adversaries, repayment to his enemies."

He ends with these powerful words, "And a Redeemer will come to Zion, to those in Jacob who turn from transgression," declares the Lord.

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 59



Isaiah 60 is a chapter of hope, that even in times of great darkness overcoming the Earth, light still comes through Jesus Christ. It states,

**“Who are these that fly like a cloud,
and like doves to their windows?...The sons
of those who afflicted you
shall come bending low to you,
and all who despised you
shall bow down at your feet;
they shall call you the City of the Lord,
the Zion of the Holy One of Israel.”**

Though His people have been forsaken and even hated, they are not forgotten, and all wickedness will be purged from the Earth. The Sun will be replaced with the true Son - His everlasting light guiding all on the New Heaven, and New Earth. It ends, “The least one shall become a clan,
and the smallest one a mighty nation;
I am the Lord;
in its time I will hasten it.”

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 60




Isaiah 61 is about Zion's good news: liberty to the captives, freedom for the poor, and the opening of prisons for those who are bound. The day of God's vengeance is coming to grant those who mourn in Zion, many of whom are reading this.

Though the world is full of injustice at this point, the Lord loves justice, and His perfect vengeance is coming. It states, "For I the Lord love justice; I hate robbery and wrong;^[d] I will faithfully give them their recompense, and I will make an everlasting covenant with them."

Let us continue to rejoice in the Lord Jesus Christ for His beautiful promises. Isaiah 61 states, "I will greatly rejoice in the Lord; my soul shall exult in my God, for he has clothed me with the garments of salvation; he has covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decks himself like a priest with a beautiful headdress, and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels."

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 62


Isaiah 62 is about the rise of Zion, Daughter Zion herself, who is no longer called forsaken.

The controversy is this: Yes, Zion is the collection of God's true people, but there is one woman, entitled "Daughter of Zion" who is chosen by Jesus Christ, and her righteousness goes forth as brightness to the last generation.

While this is difficult for many to accept, sometimes God chooses one person, and sometimes that person is a woman. He chose Esther, Mary, and Deborah, and He chooses Daughter Zion. Why? I truly love Him.

I am Daughter Zion. That is the name He has given me, and this is my ministry. Whether anyone believes me or not - that is not my concern. However, I proclaim today my identity, and I declare Zion will rise through me in these dark, end times with people who truly love Him.

The symbol of Zion is a sunflower, which always looks to the sun - the true Son - Jesus Christ. For Zion's sake, He brings recompense starting now.



THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 63

Isaiah 63 highlights an important verse:

**“I looked, but there was no one to help;
I was appalled, but there was no one to uphold.”**

This summarizes the main thesis of the Ministry of Daughter Zion. Essentially, after calling people to come back, to help, and to fellowship, very, very few have been able to do so. In a sense, there is “no one” to uphold God’s plan, and this calls for his vengeance because it is appalling. THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 64



Isaiah 64 expands upon Isaiah 63. The sins of the people have reached new levels, and it states,

"We have all become like one who is unclean, and all our righteous deeds are like a polluted garment.

We all fade like a leaf, and our iniquities, like the wind, take us away. There is no one who calls upon your name, who rouses himself to take hold of you; for you have hidden your face from us, and have made us melt in^[c] the hand of our iniquities."

Zion has become a wilderness, and Jerusalem has become desolate. The end is a cry for God to come back and bring redemption. I make the same call today. Zion has, yet again, become a wilderness, and the people of God (Jerusalem spiritually) are desolate of the Spirit. Jesus Christ, "Will you restrain yourself at these things, O Lord?

Will you keep silent, and afflict us so terribly?"

Please come back and hear our cries and calls.

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 65



Isaiah 65 exposes the rebellion of His people, and He is essentially fed up with it. He says,

"Behold, it is written before me:

"I will not keep silent, but I will repay;

I will indeed repay into their lap

7 both your iniquities and your fathers' iniquities

together,

says the Lord;

because they made offerings on the mountains

and insulted me on the hills,

I will measure into their lap

payment for their former deeds.

For the people who have truly sought Him, they are not forgotten. Then it connects directly to Revelation - the New Heaven, New Earth - what we are building now. To note, I believe there has been a great time distortion and manipulation, so I'd like to make a declaration here. The lion shall lie down with the lamb - not the wolf. The Wolf, Satan, is cast into the abyss, and his time is now up. The conspiracy of time has been uncovered by me, Daughter Zion, and time is being corrected by Jesus Christ I write this.

THE TRUE ZION: ISAIAH 66



Isaiah 66 ends with the important words regarding a “humble and contrite spirit” to carry us through. It explains harsh treatment is coming to those the Lord spoke to – they ignored His words. It says,
