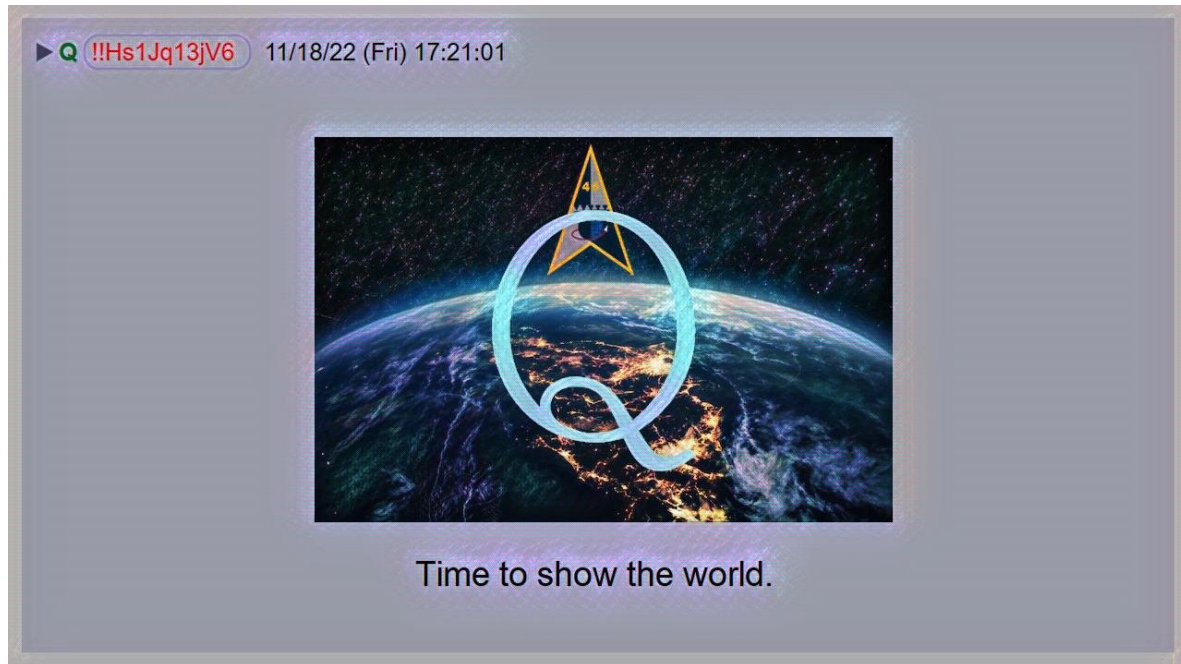





## Q November 21, 2022

All posts that contain the signature phrase “Iron Eagle” are related and they speak to a particular issue of interest to Q. Likewise, all posts with the signature Red October are related and speak to a particular issue. Posts containing both signatures address both issues. (The meaning of these two signatures will be discussed in my soon-to-be-released third Q book.)

Some signature phrases appear fully developed when we first see them. Others evolve over time. This post from November of 2017 contains several phrases known at the time to be signatures and two phrases that I would consider to be hints of future signatures that would develop later.

Q’s use of key phrases to tie together posts on a single subject is unique in all of literature (at least to my knowledge).

In recent posts, Q appears to be establishing another evolving signature phrase: “Put An End The Endless.” The word “endless” was repeated several times in a post on November 8<sup>th</sup> and used in a phrase near the end of the message three days later on the 11<sup>th</sup>. In the second post, it appears to be a signature. We’ll know with more certainty if it appears as a signature in future posts related to the theft by the cabal of our wealth.

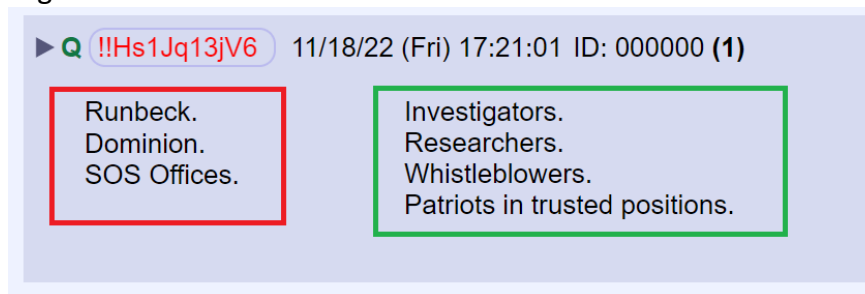
If the phrase evolves into a signature and if other signatures appear, I would consider it to be evidence (though not irrefutable proof) that we're reading messages from the same person who began posting in November of 2017.

On November 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022, Q posted the message below.

A list of election related companies and elected offices were named along with a list of people who could potentially bring sunlight to their activities.



Runbeck is a Phoenix based company that prints and scans ballots. Their Maricopa county operation came under scrutiny following the 2020 election.

Maricopa County is the only jurisdiction in the country that picks up completed ballots at USPS Processing Distribution Center, but doesn't bring them back to the election department or tabulation center.

Maricopa County picks up mail-in ballots and takes them directly to its print vendor Runbeck Election Services, which is headquartered in Phoenix.

Every single completed mail-in ballot, whether mailed or dropped off at a polling place, goes to Runbeck. All mail-in ballots collected on election day, and the previous few days, are sitting at Runbeck headquarters. Maricopa has no idea how many ballots are in their possession because the ballots are at their print vendor.

Maricopa allegedly uses Runbeck because they have "high-speed scanners." Runbeck scans the ballots in batches to create a digital image of each envelope signature area. This batch of images is given to the Maricopa tabulation center (MCTEC) for poll worker review. MCTEC notifies Runbeck if any of those signatures don't match. Runbeck separates out those bad envelopes, then delivers both sets of these envelopes by van to MCTEC, which is **6 miles away**. MCTEC then opens the envelopes and starts the tabulation process.

This "batch" process is repeated until all "mail-in" ballot envelopes are scanned at Runbeck. This takes 10-12 days after every general election, and ballots envelopes are delivered each day by Runbeck vans. Runbeck uses the **Bluecrest Vantage** mail processing machines to scan these ballot envelopes. This machine can process 40-50,000 ballots an hour. These machines can also automatically scan the ballot signatures using embedded commercial-grade check cashing signature software from **Parascript**. But Maricopa continues to use its slow manual "batch" process of reviewing signatures.

These Vantage machines cost \$1.06 million each, Detroit **just purchased one** in early 2022. Maricopa could purchase two of these machines and process roughly 90,000 ballots an hour in-house. But Maricopa continues to re-sign contracts with Runbeck, which prevents them from bringing all this in-house.

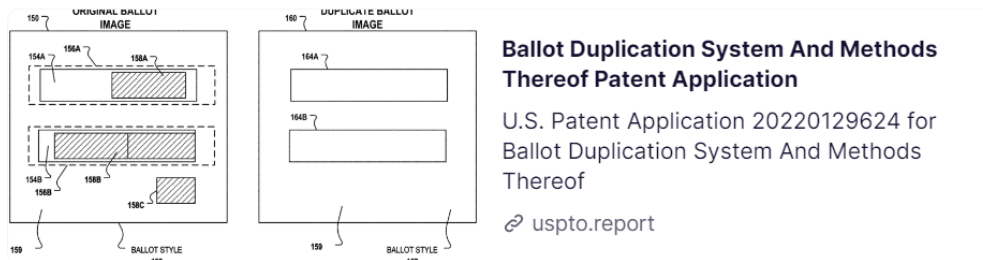

## Abstract

A computer-implemented system for on-screen ballot duplication is disclosed, that may be deployed for generating a revised ballot that satisfies predetermined rules or thresholds for further processing.

A computer-implemented method of ballot duplication, comprising: accessing by a computing device an original ballot image associated with an original ballot; mapping, by the computing device, areas of interest of the original ballot image based on a ballot style associated with the original ballot; generating a duplicate ballot image from the original ballot image, the duplicate ballot image defining the same areas of interest of the original ballot image and the ballot style; and generating a second set of marks along the areas of interest of the duplicate ballot image based on a first set of marks of the original ballot image.

2. The method of claim 1, further comprising: processing an area of interest of the original ballot image to identify a mark intersecting a predetermined minimum number of graphical indicators defined along the area of interest; and suggesting a mark application along the same area of interest as the duplicate ballot image.

3. The method of claim 1, further comprising: applying optical character recognition to identify a mark outside the areas of interest of the original ballot image; and removing the mark from the duplicate ballot image.

4. The method of claim 1, wherein the first set of marks of the original marked ballot is highlighted along the display.

5. The method of claim 1, further comprising rendering a common duplication identifier along the original ballot, the original ballot image, and the duplicate ballot image.

6. The method of claim 1, further comprising accessing the original ballot image from a ballot repository associated with an elections office.

While such a machine could be remove erroneously made marks that cause unintended attribution of a voter's intent, the same machine could be programmed to change the voter's intent altogether. In my mind, the risk of misuse outweighs any potential benefit.

Another company mentioned by Q is Dominion.

Dominion Voting Systems makes election management hardware and software. The company became embroiled in controversy following the 2020 general election when concerns were raised about the security of their systems. Dominion has been named in a number of lawsuits claiming that their products are designed to facilitate election fraud. Dominion has sued Sydney Powell, Mike Lindell and others who have criticized their products.

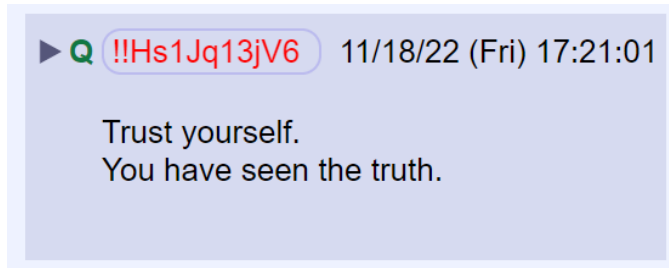

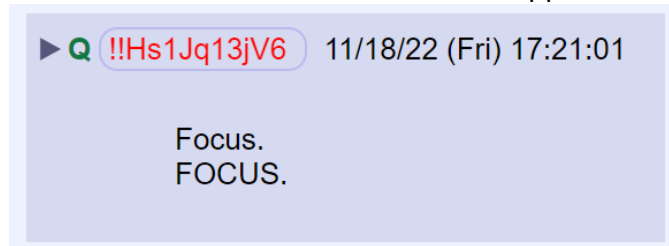
In the images below, I've isolated phrases from the most recent post. The admonition "trust yourself... you have seen the truth" counters the narrative that there is nothing illegal happening in our elections.



"Time to show the world" suggests that the truth about rigged elections is about to be definitively proven to the public.



Q wrote "focus" twice. Once in normal sentence case and once in uppercase.



An anon thought perhaps Q was highlighting a computer programming language named FOCUS.

## FOCUS

FOCUS is a fourth-generation programming language (4GL) computer programming language and development environment that is used to build database queries. Produced by Information Builders Inc., it was originally developed for data handling and analysis on the IBM mainframe. Subsequently versions for minicomputers and such as the VAX and other platforms were implemented. FOCUS was later extended to personal computers and (in 1997) to the World Wide Web: the WebFOCUS product.

Q could be reminding us to maintain focus on the elections and not be distracted by other subjects. For that reason, I've chosen to devote more time to researching events related to the election, particularly news out of Arizona.

For the sake of clarity, I'd like to briefly explain the post-election process for Arizona. (This information is taken from the Secretary of State's website.)

# Hand Count Audit

A limited precinct hand count and early ballot hand count audit may be conducted after countywide primary, special, general, and PPE elections. The purpose of the hand count audit is to compare the results of the original count to the hand count to assure that the tabulation equipment is working properly and accurately counting votes. The chair of each recognized party that appears on the ballot must designate participants for the hand count audit for it to proceed. If a hand count audit is being held, the hand count must begin within 24 hours after the polls close on Election Day and must be completed before the county canvass. [A.R.S. § 16-602\(I\)](#).

## Conducting Post-Election Logic & Accuracy Test

Another step to ensuring the election results are accurate is through post-election logic and accuracy (L&A) testing of tabulation equipment. This testing must be performed by the officer in charge of elections after the official count has been completed but before the county canvass.

## Canvassing the Election

The governing body conducting an election must meet and canvass the election results of each precinct or election district. The purpose of the canvass is to officially certify the election. The canvass includes vote totals for all races (including early ballots, regular ballots, and provisional ballots) and write-in votes.

### — County Board of Supervisors Canvassing Duties

A Board of Supervisors must canvass the official election results in a public meeting by the required deadline, which varies by type of election.

- For primary elections and PPEs, the Board of Supervisors must canvass the results within 10 business days after the election. [A.R.S. § 16-241\(C\)](#); [A.R.S. § 16-645](#).
- For all other elections held on a consolidated election date (including general elections), the Board of Supervisors must canvass between six and 20 days after the election. [A.R.S. § 16-645](#).
- For special elections, the Board of Supervisors must canvass the election according to the deadline established in the order calling the election.

### — Secretary of State's Canvassing Duties

The Arizona Secretary of State must canvass the results for any elections that include a federal, statewide, or legislative office, state appellate court and supreme court judges, and statewide ballot measures.

- For primary elections and PPEs, the Arizona Secretary of State must canvass the results on or before the third Monday after the election. [A.R.S. § 16-241\(C\)](#); [A.R.S. § 16-645\(B\)](#).
- For a general election, the Arizona Secretary of State must canvass the results on the fourth Monday following the election. The Secretary of State must conduct the general election canvass at a public meeting and in the presence of the Governor and Attorney General. If any statewide ballot measures appeared on the ballot, the Chief Justice of the Arizona Supreme Court will also attend. [A.R.S. § 16-648\(A\)-\(B\)](#).

This is the process for certification at the state level:

PHOENIX — The ballot count in Arizona from last week's midterm election is nearing the end but it could be weeks before the results are certified.

As of Wednesday evening, there were about 25,000 uncounted ballots statewide. All 15 counties must get their results approved by their board of supervisors and sent over to the secretary of state's office by Nov. 28.

"Our office then has until Dec. 5 to compile that into the statewide canvass, at which time the secretary [of state], along with the governor, the attorney general and the chief justice of the Arizona Supreme Court will certify those canvass results," Arizona Assistant Secretary of State Allie Bones told KTAR News 92.3 FM.

After the certification of the results, if any statewide races are separated by a margin less than or equal to 0.5%, the secretary of state will petition the court to order a recount.

The races for attorney general and state superintendent of public instruction currently remain close enough to trigger an automatic recount under Arizona election law.

The Elections Integrity Unit of the Arizona Attorney General's Office has demanded a response from Maricopa County "pertaining to issues related to the administration of the 2022 General Election in Maricopa County." The letter contains a detailed list of complaints received from citizens and election workers.

Dear Mr. Liddy:

The Elections Integrity Unit ("Unit") of the Arizona Attorney General's Office ("AGO") has received hundreds of complaints since Election Day pertaining to issues related to the administration of the 2022 General Election in Maricopa County. These complaints go beyond pure speculation, but include first-hand witness accounts that raise concerns regarding Maricopa's lawful compliance with Arizona election law. Furthermore, statements made by both Chairman Gates and Recorder Richer, along with information Maricopa County released through official modes of communication appear to confirm potential statutory violations of title 16.

Pursuant to the AGO's authority under A.R.S. § 16-1021, the Unit hereby requests Maricopa formally respond to and address the following concerns that have been raised.

**Election Day Ballot-on-Demand Printer Configuration Settings**

According to Maricopa County, at least 60 voting locations had issues related to some ballot-on-demand (BOD) printers having printer configuration settings that were non-uniform,<sup>1</sup>


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<sup>1</sup> State and federal law require "uniform" administration of elections. *See* Ariz. Const. art. 2 § 21; A.R.S. § 16-449(B), -452(A); 42 U.S.C.A. § 1983; U.S. Const. Amends. 1, 14. While this cannot always be perfectly achieved between counties that utilize different election equipment, within a county such uniformity is not only presumed, but mandatory.

As the canvass is looming, and these issues relate to Maricopa County's ability to lawfully certify election results – the Unit requests a response to the aforementioned issues **on or before Maricopa County submits its official canvass to the Secretary of State, which must occur on or before November 28, 2022.** See A.R.S. § 16-642(A).

# GOP Voter Fraud Hawk Hired For Arizona AG's New 'Elections Integrity' Unit

A Tea Party-linked voter fraud activist known for her vigilante approach to poll-monitoring is heading to the Arizona Attorney General's office.

Jennifer Wright — a former GOP mayoral candidate who once worked for the voter fraud alarmist group Verify the Vote — was hired as an assistant attorney general who will be focused on election integrity, KPNX, the NBC local news affiliate in Phoenix, reported Monday.

A spokesperson for Attorney General Mark Brnovich told TPM Wright approached the office about working for the unit, which will eventually employ four people total, after it was first announced. The spokesperson, Ryan Anderson, defended Wright's credentials, including her legal experience work for the voter fraud group and her experience as candidate herself.

Wright ran unsuccessfully for Phoenix mayor in 2011, where she had the support of local Tea Party groups. Through the 2012 election cycle, she played a prominent role in a multi-state push by conservative activists to place volunteer poll watchers at voting sites. The effort was criticized by Democrats and voting rights groups for allegedly targeting minority districts in its poll monitoring and trying to intimidate voters of color.

Wright, who co-chaired Verify the Vote Arizona, denied that the group's work amounted to voter suppression. She said that it was up to the local political parties to determine to which polling places the observers her group trained were assigned.

Verify the Vote worked with True the Vote to try to recruit and train 5,000 volunteers to be poll monitors across Arizona for the 2012 election. In a 20-minute video promoting the effort, Wright claimed that 80 percent of poll watchers will have an uneventful election day but that "upwards [of] twenty percent are going to find issues that absent their presence, could have resulted in a fraudulent vote being cast."

It's unclear where she derived those numbers.

I agree that no one should stand down on their efforts. But the tone of Wright's letter doesn't suggest that she's taking the matter lightly. She states in clear terms that it appears as if election laws were broken. Her statement puts her on the record publicly as having been informed of criminal behavior. If she intends to do nothing, it would be illogical to bring the issue to light at all. Doing so creates a public expectation that people will be held accountable.

Is it possible that Jennifer Wright acted as a sleeper inside the Attorney General's office? Did she go along with the status quo until Brnovich was on his way out? (He will be replaced in January.)

What if Wright went rogue? Did she take a calculated risk and launch an investigation without Brnovich's permission? Was she betting that after the letter was sent to Maricopa County, it would look like a political hit job if action were taken against her?

I don't know if the Attorney General has a participating role or if they merely act as a witness to the December 5<sup>th</sup> certification. But their notification to Maricopa County creates, at minimum, a problem of optics. Whether the AG is asked to witness or to recommend certification, how can they do so after having notified Maricopa County of their investigation into allegations that election laws were violated?

I'm cautiously optimistic. Notwithstanding, I think all avenues of recourse to correct the election should be explored and we need to amplify our efforts to hold elected leaders accountable.

There has been a development in Cochise County, Arizona regarding election certification. The county's board of supervisors initially wanted to do a 100% hand recount of votes cast on election day. They filed a lawsuit against the county's election director to force her to order the recount. After being informed that the lawsuit would interfere with a mandatory recount in the Attorney General's race, the board of supervisors withdrew their lawsuit.





PHOENIX - Two Republicans who control the board in a rural southeastern Arizona county on Wednesday told a judge they want to withdraw a lawsuit they had filed just two days prior that sought to force their own elections director to hand-count all the ballots cast in-person on Election Day.

The court filing and one of the GOP supervisors in Cochise County said they did not want to interfere with the likely recount in the race for Arizona attorney general. Democrat Kris Mayes was leading Republican Abraham Hamadeh by well under the recount margin as of late Wednesday afternoon.

The Legislature this year changed the state's election recount law to greatly increase the threshold for mandatory recounts. It now requires a recount when the candidates are within .5% of each other. In the attorney general race, the trigger is about 12,500 votes.

Supervisor Peggy Judd told The Associated Press that she agreed to withdraw the lawsuit against Elections Director Lisa Marra that she and Supervisor Tom Crosby filed on Monday because they did not want to disrupt the statewide recount. That will be triggered once the state accepts the election certifications from all 15 Arizona counties and the statewide vote-totals are accepted.

"We've had to step back from everything we were trying to do and say, OK, we've got to let this play out," Judd said. "Because it's the last thing we want to do to get in (Marra's) way."

The Pima County Superior Court judge hearing the case, Casey McGinley, dismissed the case on Thursday.

The push to hand-count ballots in the Republican-heavy county that is home to the iconic Old West town of Tombstone gained impetus from false claims by former President Donald Trump and his allies of widespread fraud and voting machine conspiracy theories in the last presidential contest. There has been no evidence of widespread fraud or manipulation of voting machines in 2020 or during this year's midterm elections.

After dropping their lawsuit, the Cochise County board of supervisors voted to delay certification of the election until November 28<sup>th</sup> because the lab responsible for certifying their equipment (SLI) has a lapsed certificate of accreditation.

The Cochise County Board of Supervisors voted on Friday evening to delay certifying the election results until Nov. 28, which is the last day to certify election results in Arizona.

After a two and a half-hour meeting with more than 30 speakers from the public, Republican Supervisors Tom Crosby and Peggy Judd said that they wanted to seek extra assurance from the Arizona Secretary of State's Office that the county voting machines have been certified for accuracy — thus proposing to postpone certifying the results until the last possible day to quell claims of fraud that have permeated meeting discussions this past week.

Democratic Supervisor Ann English voted against tabling the issue.

Election Services Director Kori Lorick said in the meeting on Friday that the voting machines have been tested and certified for accuracy.

“The equipment used in Cochise County is properly certified under both federal and state laws and requirements,” said Lorick. “The claims that the SLI testing labs were not properly accredited are false.”

She added that the claims of voting machine inaccuracy and fraud made by Daniel Wood, Brian Steiner, and Paul Rice were repetitive, as they were also the same arguments the trio brought to the Arizona Supreme Court; Lorick said that the court rejected their arguments. She said that an administrative error is what resulted in the SLI lab not receiving an updated certificate.

“This does not mean that the lab is out of compliance, nor does it mean that they had lost accreditation,” said Lorick.

However, some citizens of Cochise County — along with some who traveled from Maricopa County to Bisbee to attend in person — were not convinced and were persistent in their allegations of fraud and inaccuracy.

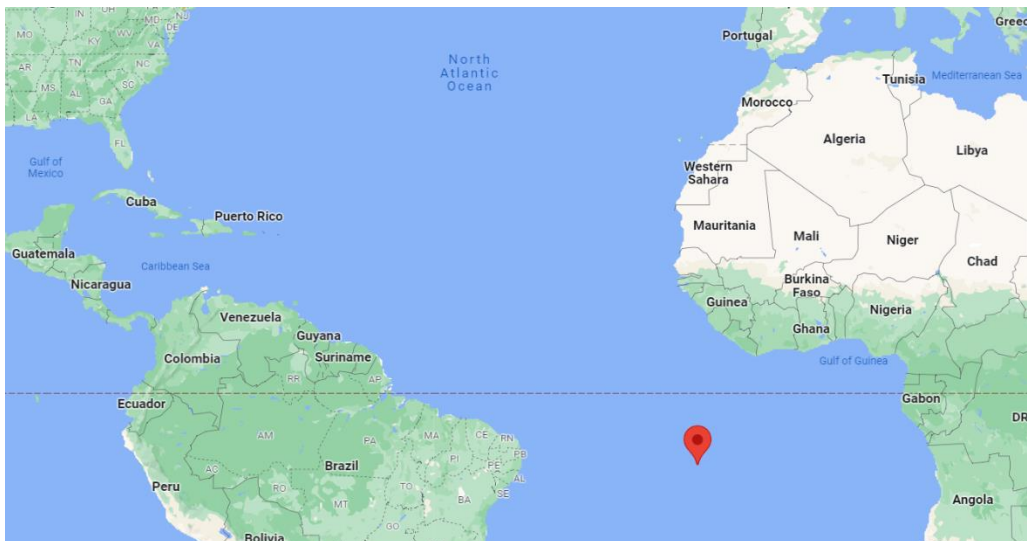

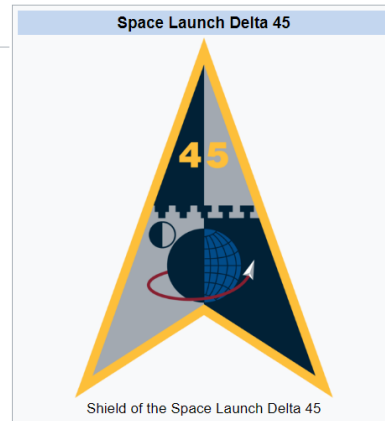

The 45th Space Delta is the host wing for **Patrick Space Force Base** and **Cape Canaveral Space Force Station**, providing base support for **NASA**, the Air Force's **Technical Applications Center** and **920th Rescue Wing**, and U.S. Navy's **Naval Ordnance Test Unit**.<sup>[5]</sup>

## Welcome to Remote U.S.-U.K. Spy Island

Just how does the U.S. conduct its high-tech espionage? As a result of the Edward Snowden whistle-blowing scandal, the public is developing a keener understanding of the super secret National Security Agency or N.S.A., an entity with truly global reach. Indeed, according to recent reporting, the N.S.A. has its hands in the far-flung South Atlantic no less and takes advantage of a covert island base to spy on Brazil, an up and coming player in the wider region. Details about the secret base, which is located on the remote island of Ascension, are contained in a recent report published by Brazilian magazine Istoé.

The magazine, which claims to have seen documents released by Snowden, reports that the Ascension base carries out a spying program called Echelon. Though the Americans employ Echelon, other Anglo powers such as Britain share such intelligence. According to Istoé, the Ascension base is highly sophisticated and can intercept up to 2 million communications per hour, including telephone conversations, e-mail and social media. After the N.S.A. gets its hands on sensitive information, the agency sends the intelligence from Ascension to another central facility located in Fort Meade, Maryland.

It's worth mentioning that an X-37B space vehicle just returned from a two-and-a-half year long mission.

X-37B orbital test vehicle concludes sixth successful mission

**KENNEDY SPACE CENTER, Fla. --** The X-37B Orbital Test Vehicle-6 (OTV-6), the U.S. Space Force's unmanned, reusable spaceplane, successfully deorbited and landed at NASA's Kennedy Space Center Shuttle Landing Facility on Nov. 12, 2022, at 05:22 a.m.

OTV -6 was the first mission to introduce a service module—a ring attached to the rear of the vehicle expanding the number of experiments that can be hosted during a mission. “This mission highlights the Space Force's focus on collaboration in space exploration and expanding low-cost access to space for our partners, within and outside of the Department of the Air Force (DAF),” said Gen. Chance Saltzman, Chief of Space Operations.

The service module successfully separated from the OTV before landing, which is a necessary activity due to the aerodynamic forces experienced by the X-37B vehicle upon re-entry. In the coming weeks, the service module will be disposed of in accordance with best practices. Secretary of the Air Force Frank Kendall said, “The deliberate manner in which we conduct onorbit operations—to include the service module disposal—speaks to the United States' commitment to safe and responsible space practices, particularly as the issue of growing orbital debris threatens to impact global space operations.”

The OTV-6 mission hosted the Naval Research Laboratory's Photovoltaic Radiofrequency Antenna Module. This experiment successfully harnessed solar rays outside of Earth's atmosphere and aimed to transmit power to the ground in the form of radio frequency microwave energy. Additionally, the U.S. Air Force Academy's FalconSat-8, developed in partnership with Air Force Research Laboratory, was successfully deployed in October 2021. FalconSat-8 remains in orbit, providing Academy cadets unique hands-on experience as space operators prior to entering active duty.

Multiple NASA experiments were deployed on OTV-6. The Materials Exposure and Technology Innovation in Space (METIS-2) included thermal control coatings, printed electronic materials, and candidate radiation shielding materials. METIS-1—which flew on OTV-5—consisted of similar sample plates mounted on the flight vehicle. NASA scientists will leverage data collected after the materials have spent 900+ days in orbit and compare observed effects to ground simulations, validating and improving the precision of space environment models.

Another NASA experiment aims to investigate the effect of long-duration space exposure on seeds. Scientists are interested in the seeds' resistance and susceptibility to space environment-unique stresses, notably radiation. The seeds experiment will inform space crop production for future interplanetary missions and the establishment of permanently inhabited bases in space.

“The X-37B continues to push the boundaries of experimentation, enabled by an elite government and industry team behind the scenes,” said Lt. Col. Joseph Fritschen, DAF Rapid Capabilities Office's X-37B Program Director. “The ability to conduct on-orbit experiments and bring them home safely for in-depth analysis on the ground has proven valuable for the Department of the Air Force and scientific community. The addition of the service module on OTV-6 allowed us to host more experiments than ever before.”

The sixth mission conducted on-orbit experiments for 908 days.

The article says the spacecraft was in orbit for 908 days. It reached orbit on May 18<sup>th</sup>, 2020, during the lead-up to the 2020 election and returned just after the 2022 election.
