- 1. OVERVIEW/ENTRY PERIODS: The Sweepstakes starts on October 1, 2023, at 7:00 A.M. ET, and ends on January 26, 2024, at 11:59 P.M. ET (the "Sweepstakes Period"). Fifteen (15) Second Prize winners will be selected during the Sweepstakes period (one winner per week, selected and notified Oct 1 to January 15) via a random drawing among the eligible entries received by 11:59 p.m. ET each Friday during the Sweepstakes period. One (1) Grand Prize winner will be selected at the end of the Sweepstakes Period via a random drawing from among the eligible entries received by 11:59 p.m. ET on January 26, 2024. The random drawing will be conducted within 48 hours of the closing of the Sweepstakes Period. Potential Winners will be notified within one day after the drawing. Winners will be announced on or before February 12, 2024.
- 2. ELIGIBILITY: This Sweepstakes is offered only to permanent, legal residents of the United States who are 18 years of age or older at the time of entry. Must be an educator to win. By properly completing the form, the entrant will receive one automatic entry into the prize drawing.
