## Arizona Roads Are Tough on Windshields

Gravel roads, construction zones, and dust storms all contribute to chips and cracks. Staying alert and keeping a distance from large vehicles helps reduce your risk.

## Heat and Temperature Swings Cause Stress Cracks

Hot days and cool nights cause your windshield to expand and contract. Over time, this pressure leads to cracks that can't be ignored.

## Repairs Work for Small Chips, Not Long Cracks

It may be fixable if the damage is smaller than a coin and not in the driver's view. For example, [windshield repair in Taylor](#) is a fast solution for minor rock chips.

## Edge Damage or Long Cracks Require Replacement

Cracks that reach the edge of the glass or are longer than six inches weaken the entire panel. In cases like that, auto glass replacement is the safer option.
