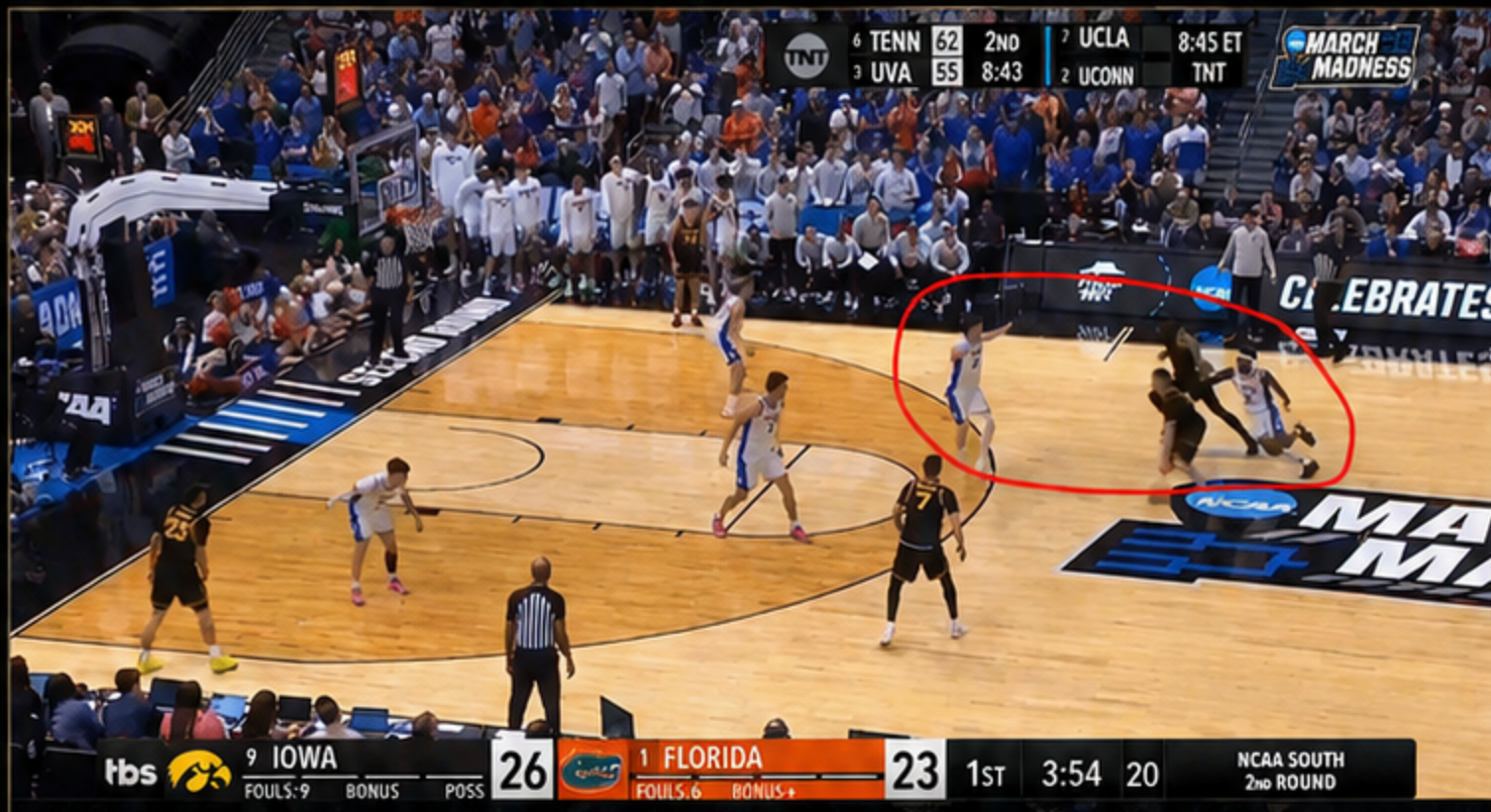




ADVANTAGE DNA™

- 1 5 sets the ball screen for 1
- 2 5 short rolls
- 3 Ball-side corner cuts through on 5's catch
- 4 Defense is occupied by the screen and roll action
- 5 5 attacks the opening
- 6 Advantage at the rim

ADVANTAGE FRAME — 3:54



Short roll catches as Florida is occupied by the ball-screen action, creating a driving window.



STARTING ALIGNMENT

5-out spacing.
5 sets a ball screen for 1.



WHAT HAPPENS

1 uses the ball screen, 5 short rolls, and the ball-side corner cuts through on the catch.



DEFENSIVE REACTION

Florida shifts toward the initial ball-screen action and is momentarily occupied by the roller and the cut.



OFFENSIVE READ

5 catches, attacks the seam, and finishes the advantage.



WHY IT WORKS

The short roll plus corner cut occupy help and create an immediate downhill lane for the screener.



MAIN COACHING POINT

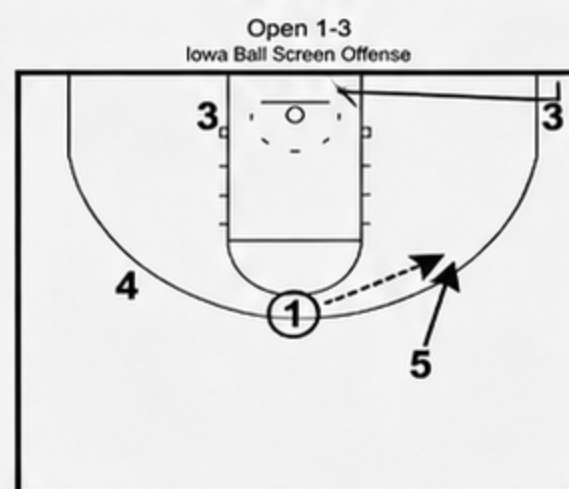
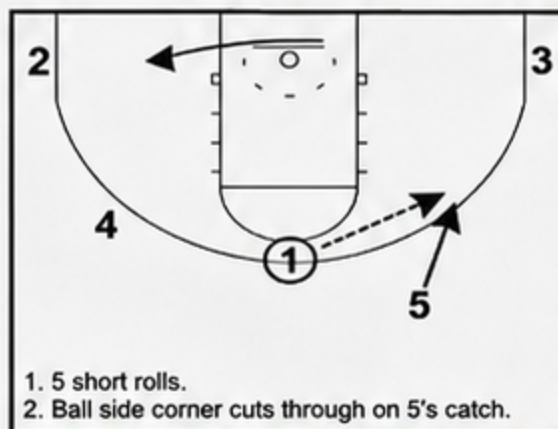
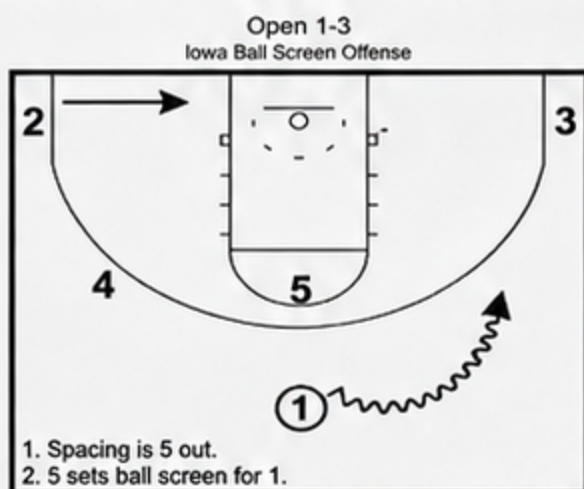
Short roll, occupy help, and attack the opening immediately.



FINAL RESULT

Paint touch / rim finish.

SEQUENCE BREAKDOWN



DNA TAKEAWAY

Open 1-3 turns a basic high ball screen into a second advantage by combining the short roll with a corner cut-through. The cut occupies help so the roller can attack space.
