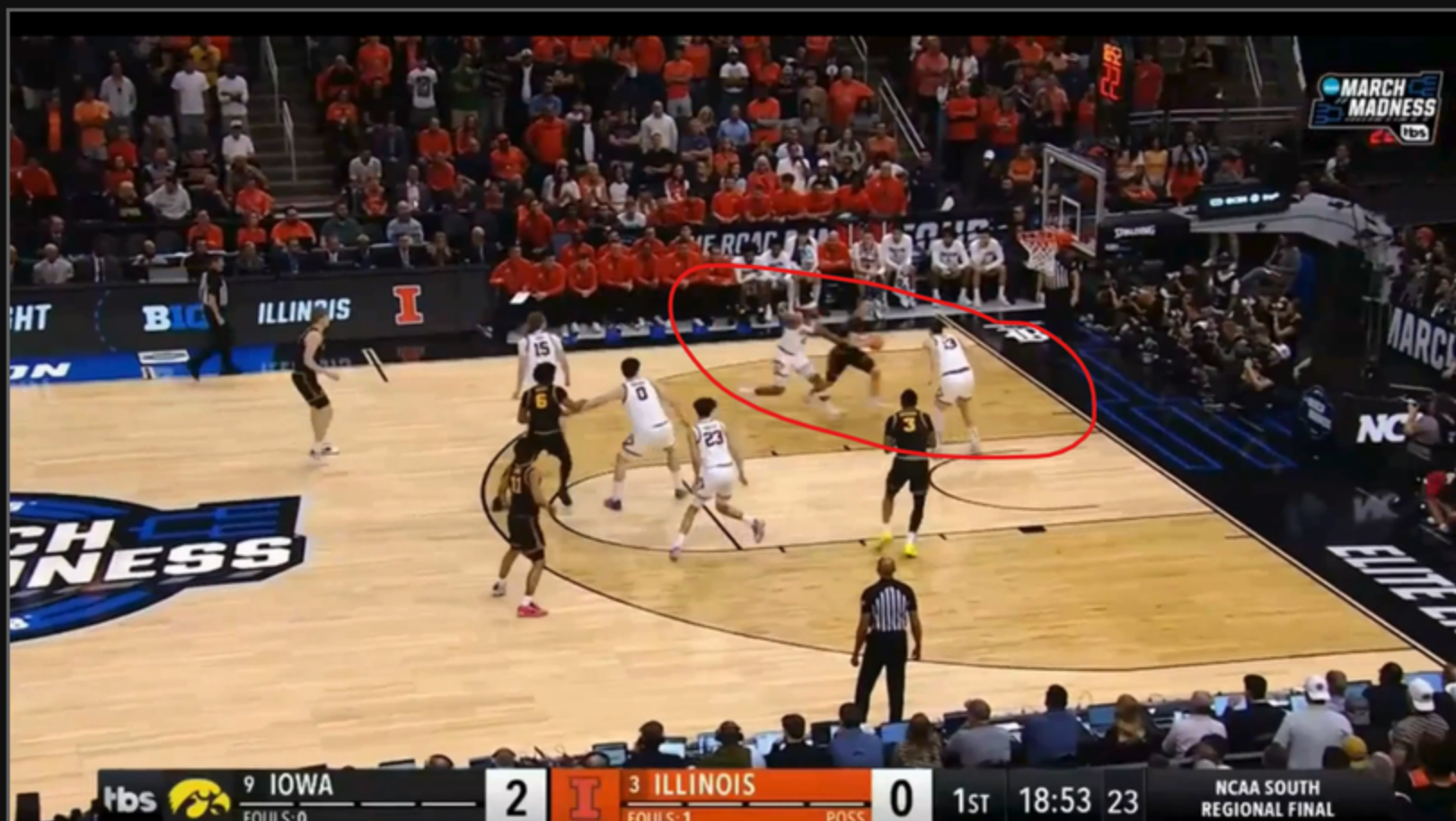


ADVANTAGE DNA™

- 1 Guard starts low on the wing.
- 2 2 steps up into the screening angle.
- 3 1 attacks immediately off the step-up.
- 4 Screen angle turns the corner toward the paint.
- 5 Illinois collapses two defenders to the ball.
- 6 Finish at the rim before the defense can reset.

ADVANTAGE FRAME — 18:53



#1 Step Ups

PAUSE HERE The step-up screen arrives from below the ball and changes the defender's angle. 1 turns the corner before Illinois can square the coverage, forcing two defenders to collapse at the rim.

ACTION BLUEPRINT — FASTDRAW BREAKDOWN



WHAT HAPPENS

2 steps up from the wing to set a guard-to-guard ball screen. 1 turns the corner immediately and gets downhill for the layup.

ADVANTAGE CREATED

The step-up changes the screen angle and keeps the defense from loading early. The ballhandler gets a direct runway into the paint.

DEFENSIVE REACTION

Illinois trails the screen and sends a second defender toward the drive. The circled frame shows two defenders converging near the rim.

OFFENSIVE READ

Turn the corner before the coverage can square up. Finish if the second defender stays back; hit the drop-off if he fully commits.

WHY IT WORKS

The screener comes to the ball instead of waiting at a fixed spot. That changes timing and angle without changing Iowa's spacing.

COACHING POINT / DNA TAKEAWAY

STEP UP TO THE DEFENDER → TURN THE CORNER → FORCE TWO → FINISH AT THE RIM

RESULT: LAYUP
