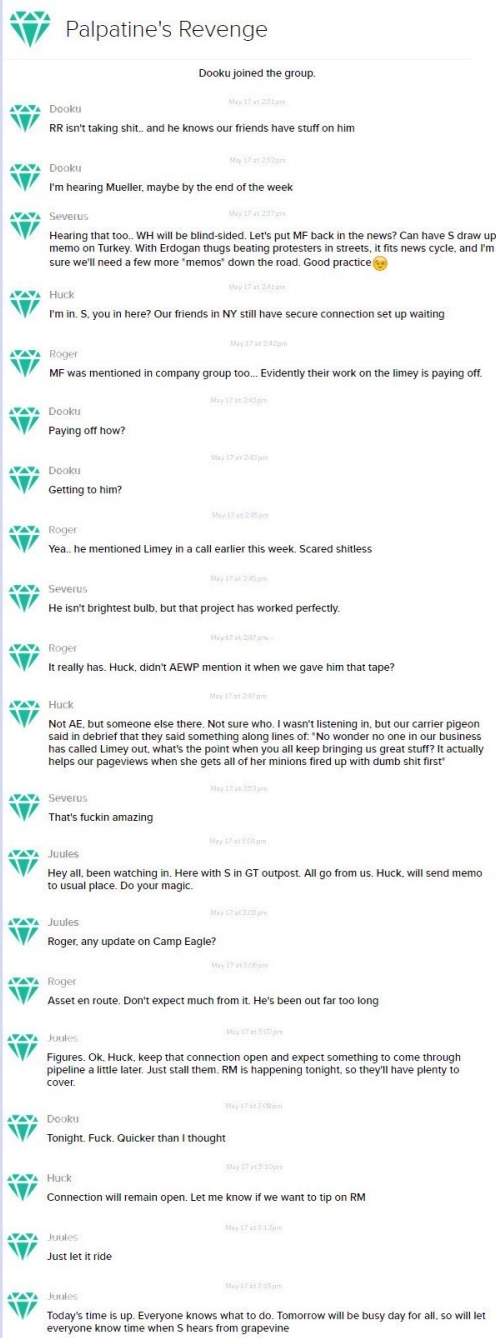

### DOJ Names Robert Mueller Special Counsel in Russia Investigation

The Department of Justice has tapped former FBI Director Robert Mueller as special counsel in an investigation into Russia's role in the 2016 U.S. election—including allegations Russia colluded with Donald Trump's campaign to sway the presidential race. The move by Deputy Attorney General Rod Rosenstein came one day after reports emerged that President Trump had personally asked former FBI Director James Comey to end the agency's investigation into Trump's former national security adviser, Michael Flynn, who was fired for lying both publicly and privately about his contacts with Russian officials.

## In Video, Turkish President Watches Bodyguards Attack D.C. Protesters

In Washington, D.C., newly published video shows Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan looking on as members of his security detail assaulted a group of peaceful protesters outside the Turkish ambassador's residence. Tuesday's violence left nine anti-Erdogan protesters hospitalized. It's not clear if Erdogan gave the order for the attack. Among those assaulted were American Diplomatic Security officers assigned to protect Erdogan's delegation. Police briefly detained the assailants but released them after learning they held diplomatic immunity. The assault came shortly after Erdogan was welcomed to the White House by President Trump. During the meeting, Trump did not mention Turkey's deteriorating human rights situation, which has seen nearly 50,000 people and 150 journalists arrested since a failed coup last summer.

## North Korea unveils 'monster' new intercontinental ballistic missile at parade

SEOUL (Reuters) - North Korea unveiled previously unseen intercontinental ballistic missiles at an unprecedented predawn military parade on Saturday that showcased the country's long-range weapons for the first time in two years.

Analysts said the missile, which was shown on a transporter vehicle with 11 axles, would be one of the largest road-mobile intercontinental ballistic missiles (ICBMs) in the world if it becomes operational.

"This missile is a monster," said Melissa Hanham, deputy director of the Open Nuclear Network.

Also displayed were the Hwasong-15, which is the longest-range missile ever tested by North Korea, and what appeared to be a new submarine-launched ballistic missile (SLBM).

Ahead of the parade, which was held to mark the 75th anniversary of the founding of its ruling Workers' Party, officials in South Korea and the United States said Kim Jong Un could use the event to unveil a new "strategic weapon" as promised earlier this year.

A senior U.S. administration official called the display of the ICBM "disappointing" and called on the government to negotiate to achieve a complete denuclearization.



The parade featured North Korea's ballistic missiles for the first time since Kim began meeting with international leaders, including U.S. President Donald Trump, in 2018.

The U.S. official said Washington was holding fast to four commitments made by Trump and Kim at their historic meeting in June of that year, including a pledge by Pyongyang to "work toward complete denuclearization of the Korean peninsula."

Kim made no direct mention of the United States or the now-stalled denuclearization talks.

"We will continue to build our national defence power and self-defensive war deterrence," Kim said, but vowed that the country's military power would not be used preemptively.

Kim blamed international sanctions, typhoons, and the coronavirus for preventing him from delivering on promises of economic progress.



## Security guard suspected in fatal protest shooting not licensed in Denver, city says

Son identifies Lee Keltner as shooting victim; suspect Matthew Dolloff was working as private security for 9News

Lee Keltner became at least the fourth person shot during protests in Colorado so far this year when he was killed Saturday after a conflict with a private security guard in downtown Denver.

Family members identified Keltner, 49, as the man fatally shot during dueling protests Saturday in downtown Denver. Police on Sunday identified a 30-year-old man as the suspect and confirmed he was working as a private security guard at the time and not participating in the protest.

But city officials don't believe shooting suspect Matthew Robert Dolloff was licensed to work as an armed private security guard in Denver.

Dolloff remained in jail Sunday without bond on suspicion of first-degree murder in the shooting, jail records show.

**GOVERNMENT'S RESPONSE TO GENERAL MICHAEL T. FLYNN'S  
MOTION TO RECUSE**

The United States of America, by and through its undersigned counsel, respectfully files this response to General Michael T. Flynn's Motion to Disqualify Judge Emmet Sullivan, *United States v. Flynn*, 17-cr-232 (Doc. 161), filed on October 7, 2020. As this Court is aware, during the mandamus proceedings before the *en banc* Court of Appeals for the D.C. Circuit, General Flynn asked that "any further proceedings be conducted by a different judge." *In re Flynn*, No. 20-2153, Doc. 1846621 at 24. While the government did not address that request in its written pleadings, when asked during oral argument, the government offered that it had "reluctantly come to the view that there is now at least a question about appearances of impartiality" because this Court's filing of a petition for *en banc* review suggested a "level of investment in the proceedings that is
