CREATING A SEAMLESS TRANSITION BETWEEN A GLAZED EXTENSION AND YOUR GARDEN

A new extension can completely transform your home, acting as the perfect medium between your indoor and outdoor spaces. Creating a bright open-plan space that will change the look and feel of a property; a glazed extension can be used for anything from kitchens and dining rooms to open-plan lounges but above all, they can bring the outside in. Whether you love the idea of opening up the doors and merging your kitchen and patio together for summer BBQs, or like the idea of sitting with a morning coffee as the sun comes up over the garden - a glazed extension helps you to feel more connected with the great outdoors.

In recent years the traditional conservatory has fallen out of favour, and now homeowners are choosing orangeries and garden rooms to harmoniously blend their home with their outdoor space. A well-designed structure will bring a sense of splendour and opulence, with elegant architectural lines and a timeless style, while seamlessly transitioning the living areas through to the garden.

What are the differences between an orangery, garden room and conservatory? This is purely down to the amount of glazing, timber and masonry materials in the structure. We all remember the popular conservatory from the 80's which

would typically have a fully glazed roof and walls sitting on a brick foundation - but these tended to overheat in the summer and feel chilly in the winter.

Consisting of semi-glazed walls, an orangery typically has a roof lantern built on top of a flat roof that lets the natural light stream in in the same way that a conservatory does. Yet instead of feeling cold or stuffy, they are comfortable and inviting throughout the seasons, feeling cool in the summer and warm in the winter. A garden room is similar to an orangery with semi-glazed walls, but with a roof made entirely from tiles instead of a roof lantern.



A garden room is more likely to look like a part of the main building rather than an additional add-on, with matching tiles, brickwork and other details. Ensuring a smooth transition between your garden room and your outside space certainly requires a specific approach, because with so much light and space it can be difficult to bring the room together and maintain an opulent aesthetic.

Perfect garden planting

An orangery or garden room needs to be functional, but it also has to have balance and flow. Nothing helps to create that flow quite like a beautiful planting scheme, which will help your extension to blend in with its natural surroundings. An orangery strengthens the relationship that your home has with your garden, offering expansive views of the surrounding greenery and bringing the outside in. Choosing the right plants in your garden can only

enhance your new space, providing that they work in harmony with the structure's scale and proportion.

When you first open the doors of your orangery and step out onto your patio, you're walking into an extended space that feels like another room.

To stay connected to the house, the area immediately outside the extension should look neat, manicured, and well-ordered. As most of a garden room's structure is glazed, you only need to include low-level

planting - perhaps knee height or thigh height so that the views are not interrupted. It's important for your flower beds to have good depth too, so your home looks like it's blended in with the surrounding foliage. Avoid thin, narrow strips of plants which won't have much impact next to an extension. Think about using eight or nine plants together in a large bed or planter, rather than using just a couple. Bring larger plants behind them to create some depth. Plant another bed with the same design for continuity, and you'll make a real statement in your garden.





It's all in the flooring

Flooring plays a big part in helping to create a seamless flow between a glazed extension, the garden and other areas of the house. Opt for flooring materials that will work both inside and out, and can be laid flush with the external patio in the garden. Natural stone or porcelain tiles are ideal, as they are strong and durable and incomparable in terms of quality.

Just like the planting, consider choosing paving and other hard landscaping products that are structured and straight to create a formal feel. This might seem like an overly contemporary, bold concept, but this style will keep your outdoor space connected to your home and encourage continuity between the different spaces.

The right interiors

When considering the orangery's interior design, keep in mind that with all that glazing, the expansive views into the garden should be the main factor to consider. Make sure that nothing obstructs the expansive views of the garden beyond when you walk into the room. Keep the furniture low, choosing deep sofas and shorter ornaments. Essentially, the interiors should not compete with the views of



the surrounding landscape, so use neutral, natural colour palettes with blues, slate greys, earthy browns, and greens to reflect the colours outside.

Outdoor living

Elegant planters, ambient lighting, fire pits, and striking outdoor furniture can make your garden a functional living space that's simply an extension of your own home. From loungers and daybeds to seating and dining



tables, furniture is considered to be an essential element of stylish outdoor living. With the right pieces, you can create breakfast bars, sunbathing spots and seating areas for entertaining. A great starting point might be to set up an alfresco dining area in a part of your garden where there is lots of space. Try

to leave plenty of room for people to push back their chairs and effortlessly walk to and from the table with plates of food. Use plants to provide a little screening if the larger space feels a little exposed, creating privacy and intimacy.







Clever garden lighting

The beauty of external lighting means that you can still take pleasure from your magical outdoor oasis whilst being cosy and warm inside, looking out from the comfort of your garden room extension or orangery. It also means that you can stay outside for longer during the summer, with the doors of your orangery opened up to encourage the flow between the different spaces. The key to good garden lighting is subtlety. Use it to draw attention to important features

like trees or water features, rather than go over the top to try and make the lighting the main factor in your garden. You need the darkness to create contrast and balance, allowing your lighting to effectively catch the eye in specific places.

Trees can turn into magnificent, eyecatching focal points with the use of a well-placed ground light based at the trunk and angled at the branches above. If you have a courtyard, use two or three lights to really emphasise the open space. Using lights around

decking and steps can beautifully highlight the different levels of your garden and any surrounding architecture.

2019 SEES IMPRESSIVE MEDAL HAUL FOR BALI MEMBERS AT RHS CHELSEA

The results are in from the world's most prestigious flower show, RHS Chelsea Flower Show, and members of the British Association of Landscape Industries (BALI) have been awarded top accolades.

Eight Gold, three Silver-Gilt, one Silver and one Bronze was this year's medal haul for some of BALI's most experienced members, with the association's Affiliate (supplier) members also achieving two coveted 5 Star, three 4 Star and one 3 Star awards for their trade stands.

Themes this year centred on female education in Africa, climate change and the reclamation of nature and the positive effects on well-being. Many members designing and/or building gardens opted to use large specimen trees, swathes of green foliage with bursts of colour and the movement of water to promote their global messages.

In the Show Garden category, Gold medals were bestowed upon Mark Gregory for his The Welcome to Yorkshire Garden, built by Landform Consultants (Registered Contractor) whilst Andy Sturgeon's MBALI (Registered Designer) The M&G Garden and Chris Beardshaw's MBALI (Associate Honorary) The Morgan Stanley Garden also picking up Gold. The M&G Garden was also awarded the Best Show Garden title.

Silver-Gilt medals were awarded to Kate Gould MBALI (Registered Designer) for The Greenfingers Charity Garden and Warner's Distillery Garden, built by Bowles & Wyer (Registered Contractor). The Dubai Majlis Garden built by Landform Consultants (Registered Contractor) also took home a Silver-Gilt.

Stewart Landscape Construction's (Registered Contractor) The Trailfinders 'Undiscovered Latin America' Garden was awarded a Silver and The Savills and David Harber Garden, the creation of Andrew Duff MBALI (Registered Designer), was awarded a Bronze.

In the Space to Grow Garden category, Jilayne Rickard's MBALI (Registered Designer) The CAMFED Garden: Giving Girls In Africa a Space to Grow was awarded a prestigious Gold

and The Outdoor Room (Registered Contractor) also took Gold for Facebook: Beyond the Screen as well as the Best Space to Grow Garden and Best Construction (Space to Grow/ Artisan) titles.

Rounding out the garden medals for BALI members was in the Artisan Garden category, where idverde (Registered Contractor) scooped a Gold for their Family Monsters Garden and the Best Artisan Garden prize.

Gold medals were also awarded to both Peter Beales Roses (Registered Affiliate) and Sparsholt College (Training Provider BALI), with the latter claiming Best Discovery Exhibit.



The Royal Horticultural Society (RHS) has revealed the winners of the prestigious RHS Chelsea Plant of the Year and RHS Chelsea Garden Product of the Year for 2019 at the world-famous show sponsored by M&G Investments.

RHS Chelsea Plant of the Year

Competing against 19 other shortlisted plants, Sedum takesimense ATLANTIS ('Nonsitnal') was selected by the judges for its exceptional variegation, innovation and appeal for today's gardeners.

ATLANTIS is a drought-tolerant, lowmaintenance and hardy stonecrop perfect for small gardens and balconies. Introduced by Suttons, the plant originally found on the volcanic Korean island of Ulleungdo will be on display in the Great Pavilion with winning exhibitor, the National Dahlia Collection.

In second place was Hardy's Cottage Garden Plants' Digitalis × valinii 'Firebird' while

Agapanthus FIREWORKS ('Mdb001'), entered by Sparsholt College, took third place.

All 20 of the shortlisted plants will be on display in the Plant of the Year section of the RHS Experience in the Great Pavilion (GP235).

The RHS Chelsea Plant of the Year is selected by an audience of over 100 plant experts, including members of trials forums and the seven RHS Plant Committees.

Celebrating its tenth anniversary next year, the competition aims to promote the continuing work of breeders and nurseries in producing improved and exciting new plants.



RHS Chelsea Garden Product of the Year

HOTBIN Composting was awarded the Garden Product of the Year for their HOTBIN Mini Composter. Selected by a team of experts including esteemed entrepreneur and Dragons' Den investor, Deborah Meaden, the product which makes use of everything from leaves to small bones was praised for its innovation in making composting cleaner, simpler and more accessible for modern households.

The Obelisk Composter by Wilstone also received special recognition in the line-up alongside other products promoting sustainability and preserving the natural environment

including the highly commended Bamboo Pots and Seed Trays by Haxnicks.

The judges added: "This year the standard was incredibly high and shows that the UK is leading in garden product innovation and sustainability."



Cambridge University Botanic Garden welcomes 300,000 visitors a year, making it the most visited university botanic garden in the UK. Situated in the centre of Cambridge, the Grade II listed Heritage Garden covers 40 acres and is home to a collection of

over 8,000 plant species to facilitate teaching and research. Equally, since its foundation it has provided a beautiful and tranquil place for everyone to enjoy. The Garden boasts four show lawns and the combination of foot traffic, marquee trucks and

ride-on mowers leads to compaction. The Garden has been using Terrain Aeration's decompaction services since as far back as 2013 and chose the deep aeration treatment for the high-profile area of the Main Lawn in front of the majestic glasshouses.



"We know Terrain Aeration's work from years ago when development had been done at the Station Road Entrance and the lawn at the back of Cory Lodge," says Adrian Holmes, Landscape and Machinery Supervisor at the Garden. "The lawns had been

re-built after the work but were found to be compacted and the soil was not good. We had a waterlogging issue for a couple of years. The Terrain Aeration treatment rectified the problem and we know from experience it's a longterm solution."

This year, the Garden's Main Lawn area was cordoned off, the machine operation creating considerable interest amongst students and visitors, and Terrain Aeration's Terralift set to work. The weather was very good and dry, and the ground was worked easily without the need to use the Terralift's JCB hammer drill. The machine's probe is driven down a metre deep and highly compressed air released up to a maximum of 20Bar (280psi) to fracture the soil, opening it up for aeration, drainage and to get oxygen to the roots of the plant. On the tail end of the air blast, dried seaweed is incorporated which sticks to the walls of the fractures and fissures created by the main air blast. As pressure drops, the seaweed is mixed in the hopper unit where it swirls around with the remaining air and is then released. The seaweed swells in wet weather and keeps the fissures

On the Main Lawn the same process was repeated in two-metre spacings, so the underground fracturing is thoroughly linked. In some extreme cases this is demonstrated by water fountains appearing from previous probe holes. In this instance the ground was found to be not as compacted as expected and the 2,500sq metre area was completed in two days, not the original three as had been expected.

"The Terrain Aeration guys were very good, prompt and efficient and quite knowledgeable," says Adrian, "they backfilled the probe holes with Lytag, lightweight aggregate and it was as if they had never been there. It was great to have everything back to normal so quickly."

The aeration treatment completed, the lawn area was immediately open for unrestricted access to the fountains, glasshouses and horticultural and National Plant Collections.

INDUSTRY RESPONDS TO LATEST ORNAMENTAL SECTOR SKILLS GAP SURVEY

A major survey investigating the future skills needs within UK ornamental horticulture is firmly underway, with over 300 businesses already providing insight about the potential training and resource gaps for the £24bn sector.

The British Association of Landscape Industries (BALI), a key stakeholder of the Ornamental Horticulture Sector group who commissioned the study, continues to promote the survey to its extensive membership network, providing some of the UK's leading landscape companies with a voice on the current skills crisis.

The Ornamental Horticulture Sector stakeholder group is seeking to investigate the future skills needs of the Ornamental Horticulture sector, in terms of key skills and the requirements and challenges facing the sector in the future (including scenarios and implications for future workforce change).

BALI's Chief Executive Wayne Grills said: "Results from this survey will help equip the sector with real-time knowledge of the issue, in turn, informing a skills strategy which will be tailored to the industry's needs which

will go a long way in securing vital funding and resource."

According to a recent report by Oxford Economics, the UK Ornamental sector supported 568,700 jobs in 2017, amounting to 1.6% of total UK employment.

Wayne continued "The Ornamental sector is a vital driver for the UK's economy, particularly the landscape services industry which generated £11.6bn, almost 50% of the total £24bn value, in 2017. This study will allow us to compare findings from the initial economic report to see just how underfunded and potentially underequipped we are as an industry. The results from this survey will also equip us with the necessary data to take to Government where BALI will be looking for action."

Pye Tait Consulting, who has been commissioned by the group to carry out the research, has been tasked with contacting a minimum of 1,000 UK-based businesses between now and June. The survey will build on an initial pilot project carried out in 2018. The 2019 survey is seeking the views of those working in and across the ornamental horticulture subsectors, including landscape design and maintenance services.

It will be conducted by telephone, giving businesses the opportunity to provide their view on skills developments in the foreseeable future, their workforce needs, the impact of automation, training needs and requirements, and other topics to inform a skills strategy tailored to the sector. In addition, interviews and dedicated workshops for business stakeholders are planned this month and further into June to better inform the research.

Results from the survey will help equip the sector in making the case for lobbying government, requests for funding, informing migratory advisory committee consultations and insight about the demand for, and gaps within, training in the horticulture sector.

A GUIDE TO ARTIFICIAL GRASS ADHESIVE SYSTEMS

Brian Spencer, Technical Director at Envirostik has over 25 years' experience advising on the correct use of adhesives when fitting synthetic turf. He is able to pass on some key installation knowledge.

In an age when people have less free time, but still wish to enjoy a beautiful landscaped area for relaxation, the requirement for low maintenance is paramount.

The rapid increase in the use of artificial grassed areas brings new challenges, not only to the landscaping contractor but also to the general public who are now encouraged to buy products on line and undertake their own installation.

Where joints are required to the rolls of carpet then an adhesive system will be required and the choice can appear complex, but are really quite straightforward when selected properly and used correctly.

A strong, invisible seam joint is essential to produce a continuous surface that will enhance the appearance of the artificial grassed area.





There are basically three adhesives systems in common use for jointing the carpet edges. Two component and single component adhesives also require a jointing tape, usually a geotextile strip, on which to apply the adhesive.

The third system is an adhesive coated tape that has a heavy coating of selfadhesive polymer. The choice of fixing will often depend on the size of the area and the expected foot traffic.

Two Component Adhesives

Generally, polyurethane polymer based adhesives require pre mixing of the components before application. The cured adhesive provides a very strong bonding medium that, when used correctly, will outlast the life of the carpet. Supplied in varied size containers, this system is often the first choice for landscapers and professional installers, and is also chosen for bonding carpets direct to other substrates, for example on balconies, decking or roof top gardens.

One Component Adhesives

Strong polymer based single component adhesives are available that are generally used on smaller installations. The systems generally rely on atmospheric moisture to cure and are most often supplied in cartridge form. No mixing is required and application is simple and clean. Provided the product is used correctly, resultant seam bonds are entirely satisfactory. The adhesives in cartridge packs allow for an easy application method and can also be used for fixing the edges of the carpet to the lawn surround.

Seam Jointing Tapes

Strong, durable strips are required that are compatible with the one and two component liquid adhesives. Tapes should be made of strong, geotextile, normally with a coating on one side to prevent ingress of moisture during installation. Adhesive should always be applied to the open textile surface. Various widths and lengths are available.

Self-Adhesive Fixing Tape

These tapes are most often used in smaller landscaped areas with relatively low traffic use. The adhesive is already fixed to the textile carrier and is ready for bonding after the removal of the protective film. This system requires a good fitting technique as once the carpet is pressed into place it bonds instantly and is not easy to reposition.

Best Practice Installation Advice

- 1. Protect adhesives from extremes of hot or cold by storing at between 5°C and 20°C.
- 2. When using a two-part adhesive, ensure the components are thoroughly mixed before use. Look for consistent colour and texture in the mix.
- 3. Use a notched trowel to apply sufficient adhesive according to the carpet backing type. The beading structure created by the adhesive

applicator should fill the stitch ribbing of the carpet to ensure total surface contact.

- 4. Apply the adhesive evenly down the tape strip to the non-shiny surface, leaving approximately 5cm uncoated at either edge. Position carpet joint down the centre of the tape.
- 5. Consolidate the adhesive bond by applying light: even pressure until curing is complete. If sand is used as an infill, do not apply until the adhesive bond has fully cured thus preventing sand penetrating into the joint.
- 6. If using a self adhesive tape, roll back the carpet edges, then simply roll out the tape and position the joint down the centre. After

ensuring the joint is positioned correctly, apply firm pressure to form the bond.

Provided the correct attention is given to the bonding process then strong seam joints, with minimum visibility should result and the artificial lawn would be expected to last for many years.





Knot to be Ignored

Case 1

In July 2018, Network Rail were successfully sued by two homeowners for encroachment of Japanese knotweed upon their properties (EWCA Civ 1514). The Court of Appeal awarded the claimants compensation for the "loss of amenity value". This case solidifies that fact that Japanese knotweed is an actionable nuisance for which damages can be claimed.

In December 2018, Bristol County Council prosecuted a local property owner under the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014. The prosecution was the result of complaints from adjoining properties that the landowner had failed to prevent the spread of Japanese knotweed originating from the landowners' property. They were fined £18,000 plus costs.

Case 3

In February 2019, in the case of Ryb v Conways Chartered Surveyors [2019], an experienced and RICS qualified surveyor was found guilty of professional negligence for failing to identify Japanese knotweed at a property in north London. Damages of \$50,000 for the loss in property value were awarded to the claimant, plus the cost of excavating the knotweed.

These cases serve a warning to all property owners and property professionals that failing to control knotweed on your property or failing to identify knotweed can result in claims being made. It is within landlords, groundsmen, landscapers, gardeners, surveyors and property owners' interests to know how to identify and manage knotweed.

Spring Identification

You might have noticed as the weather improves and the days become longer, that Japanese knotweed growing season is upon us. The emergence of knotweed depends on the weather, but as a guide, it starts to appear between April to May, with shoots that look like red/purple asparagus spears.

As it grows, the leaves unfurl, revealing lime-green shovel-shaped leaves. The stems have the indicative zig-zig growth pattern, which are green with visible purple speckles near the base of the stem.





Summer Identification

June to September. Japanese knotweed canes will grow to around 2-3 metres high. The plant has free standing upright stems (which resembles bamboo) and forms as a

semi-dense stand, with lush green heart or shovel-shaped leaves, up to 20cm long. In late summer, it flowers, producing panicles of small creamywhite flowers.



Autumn Identification

October to December. The flowers have died and just like other herbaceous perennial plants, Japanese knotweed goes into senescence as the above ground parts of the die off for winter. Leaves turn yellow and start to fall in the autumn.



Winter Identification

The underground crown and rhizome of the plant remains live but in a dormant state over winter. It will produce new growth again in the spring. The above ground canes die off and turn brown and brittle. The alternate (non-symmetrical) stem growth pattern (zig-zag) can still be seen for identification.



Japanese Knotweed Removal Options

Japanese knotweed can be treated in-situ with herbicide or dug out (excavated). Choosing and designing the correct remedial method requires understanding of the plant as well as consideration for the current and future planned use of the ground it occupies.

Herbicide Treatment

This option controls knotweed growth but may not eradicate or remove the plants' underground rhizome. It and is ideal for:

- Public Open Spaces (Parks)
- Residential property owners
- Where there is no proposed change of land use

Excavation

Excavation is recommended where long-term herbicide treatment is not desirable or if the affected area is to be disturbed, e.g.:

- Development/Construction
- Turfing
- · Paving/Driveway
- House extension
- Outbuilding (shed, garage, greenhouse)

Japanese Knotweed Ltd provide 10-year Knotweed Management Plans (herbicide treatment) which include a regime of treatment proven to be effective at controlling the growth of knotweed. Typically, within 3 years the herbicide has damaged the plant enough to stop it producing new above ground stem growth.

Excavation works undertaken by Japanese Knotweed Ltd provide instant eradication of Japanese knotweed and can be completed within a number of days depending on the amount of knotweed to be extracted. The resulting knotweed waste is either buried or relocated on site, or removed from site for disposal at landfill.

Duty of Care

Japanese knotweed plant material or soil and waste containing knotweed is classed as "Controlled Waste".

The Environmental Protection
(Duty of Care) Regulations 1991
incorporates a responsibility on
anyone who produces, imports,
carries, keeps, treats or disposes
of any controlled waste (such as
Japanese knotweed) to ensure it is
only ever transferred by someone who
is authorised to carry it, to someone
who is authorised to receive it, such as
a licenced landfill facility.

Action Plan - What to do and not to do

If you suspect you've found knotweed on a property, don't...

- Where possible allow works which can disturb the knotweed (i.e. development works) to commence without surveying a site for knotweed and drawing up a Knotweed Management Plan (KMP) if found to be present.
- Allow knotweed material to intentionally or unintentionally leave your site in a manner that will contravene the Environmental Protection Act and the Environmental Protection (Duty of Care) Regulations. If Japanese knotweed material is to leave site, it must do so via a registered waste carrier and must be disposed of by prior arrangement at a specially licensed landfill facility able to accept and dispose of Japanese knotweed.
- Allow Japanese knotweed to spread into adjacent properties, as this will leave you vulnerable to third party litigation from your neighbour(s).
- S Flail or strim knotweed, as this will cause the Japanese knotweed to spread.
- ★ Store materials on top of Japanese knotweed areas, or the materials themselves could become contaminated with knotweed and have to be disposed of accordingly.

- Add Japanese knotweed to compost, as this can lead to knotweed growing in your compost heap.
- ☼ Burn Japanese knotweed as a sole means of treatment as large rhizome and crowns can survive burning.

Ensure that you do....

- ✓ Isolate the Japanese knotweed by means of '7m rhizome spread zone' exclusion fence prior to the commencement of development works to prevent any disturbance of the plant by workers, vehicles or members of the public.
- ✓ Draw up a Knotweed Management Plan - especially if a number of contractors (i.e. demolition, ground workers, landscapers) are to be involved on the site and adhere to it throughout your project.
- ✓ Commence treatment/removal of Japanese knotweed as soon as possible after discovering its presence. Treatment of Japanese knotweed on land banks is highly recommended as they will prove easier to either sell or develop than if the knotweed has been allowed to thrive for several years.
- Adhere to recommendations in the PCA Knotweed Code of Practice (2018), when managing and treating Japanese knotweed.

Property Owners are Responsible

It is upon the property owner to ensure they manage and control knotweed on their property. Should knotweed be allowed to grow unfettered, you could face litigation for knotweed encroachment or failing to prevent the spread of knotweed.

Allett Mowers invited industry leaders to Twickenham Rugby Stadium on May 14th to showcase the new Allett C34E battery powered mower and hold informal talks on sustainability. Attendance at the venue represented football, rugby, cricket, Royal Households, Oxford and Cambridge University colleges and dealers. Austin Jarrett, Allett's Managing Director, gave a talk on the company's battery machine strategy and the technology behind battery electric power helping to drive the future for professionals. He emphasised the health and safety benefits of non-particulate power and sustainability with zero emissions at the point of use, low noise, low vibrations and minimum maintenance.

Delegates were shown that, just like its petrol counterparts, the C34E gives an impeccable cut and lays down Allett's hallmark stripes.

Austin Jarrett says:

"We'll be using the debate and feedback from the customers to form part of Allett decision making and future planning in our battery machine strategy. The industry is rapidly changing and while we aim to be at the forefront we will only be launching twenty C34E this year. When a customer buys one of the first 20 machines we will work with them and their dealer on any developments of the machine before we go into mass production next year. They will become an Allett Pioneer Programme member and attend focus groups and factory visits and will also get exclusive Pioneer merchandise."

The consensus after the meeting was general agreement the industry is quickly learning about sustainability and recognising the need to gain greater momentum in the face of climate change.

THE WORKER IS KING

Ross Woodley won't be turning over any new leaves when it comes to the trucks he relies upon to support his business - Romsey Tree Surgeons' latest 3.5-tonne FUSO Canter is its sixth in a row!

Mr Woodley established his business in the Hampshire market town of Romsey in 1998, and bought his first Canter six years later. He's been running them ever since.

The most recent arrival from south coast Dealer Marshall Truck & Van, which also represents Mercedes-Benz Trucks, is a Canter 3C13 model with Comfort day cab and economical 96 kW (130 hp) 3.0-litre turbo diesel engine.

Acquired with competitive funding support from Mercedes-Benz Finance, it has a high-sided tipping body by Solent Bodybuilders & Repairs, of Fareham, a roof-mounted flashing light bar, and bears the personalised registration plate, FEII ASH.

Mr Woodley explained: "I buy a new Canter every three years, and always have two at any one time - my other truck has been on the road since 2015. When they're due for change I sell them privately. We don't do a lot of miles but when I come to replace them I'm always impressed by their residual values."

Romsey Tree Surgeons serves domestic and commercial customers in Hampshire, Dorset and Wiltshire.

Members of its team are qualified to undertake a broad range of services, including pruning and thinning, but the firm specialises in the safe removal of trees, or parts of trees, which are large and dangerous, often as a result of storm damage.

Key to the Canter's appeal for Mr Woodley, are the strength and rugged durability which owe much to its ladder-frame chassis. "Most of its 3.5-tonne competitors are based on vans, which simply aren't robust enough for our operation," he observed.

"But the Canter is a proper little truck. It's very well built and, as we know from long experience, extremely reliable - I can honestly say that in the 15 years we've been running them we've never had a single breakdown."





He continued: "We always send at least two but often three men out in the trucks. The Canter's cab has three fullsized seats, so they travel in comfort and safety.

"The vehicle's handling when carrying a full load is also totally reassuring. It sits really well on the road and has a great turning circle, because you sit right over the front wheels. That's another important attribute when we're on and off residential driveways, and other sites at which access is restricted."

As it has done with Romsey Tree Surgeons' other FUSO trucks, Solent Bodybuilders and Repairs also fabricated and installed a toolbox with locking shutter doors on both sides immediately behind the new vehicle's cab, while a mesh-sided tray beneath the body on the nearside is used to carry signage and other equipment. The truck is also fitted with a hitch, and used to tow a wood chipper.

In addition to its two Canters, Romsey Tree Surgeons runs a Mercedes-Benz Citan van which was also supplied by Marshall Truck & Van, last year. "I can't fault the Dealer," reported Mr Woodley.

"They handle all of the liaison and movements with the bodybuilder, while we also utilise FUSO Service Contracts - we drop the vehicles off at the end of the day and the work's done overnight so we're ready to roll again next morning."

He added: "I like my trucks to look smart because they double as mobile advertisements for the business. We've picked up quite a few jobs over the years, from people who've seen us out and about, and followed up with a phone call."







Pollution from traffic fumes and particulate matter is reaching high and illegal levels on a regular basis across the country with one in three children growing up exposed to unsafe levels of air pollution.

The effects are highly detrimental leading to narrowing of airways. prevalence to lung diseases such as asthma and even affected brain development. But what is the solution? Lancashire based company Hedges Direct, specialist online suppliers of hedging and garden plants, with partner Green-tech Ltd, recently supplied Channel 4's Dispatches programme with Ivy Screens and



other garden plants in support of a ground-breaking experiment at Lordship Lane Primary School in London.

The Channel 4 programme which aired on Monday 10th June at 8pm, documented over a 2 week period, an experiment which saw the school undergo changes both externally and internally to attempt to combat the effects of pollution throughout. The levels of both Nitrogen Dioxide from exhaust fumes and other particulate matter from brakes and tyres produced by all vehicles (including



electric), were measured before and after for comparison. Prior to the experiment, the Nitrogen Dioxide levels and other particulates around the school were found to be over 50% higher than 'acceptable' levels.

For the external anti-pollution measures, the Hedera Helix Ivy Screens, 1.8m high x 1.2m wide supplied by Hedges Direct, were installed as a perimeter solution around the school exterior to attempt to absorb sooty particles from traffic pollution and provide cleaner air for the children when spending time outside. A garden was also created in the playground area featuring various evergreen hedging plants to help supplement this.

At the end of the 2 week period, levels were measured again and the results were nothing short of staggering. In the playground and external areas of the school, the addition of the Ivy Screens and garden plants had reduced the pollution levels by as much as 53% - a significant reduction within a very short timeframe.

The question is, how much is our children's health worth? In the programme, Anna Kettley the Director of Programmes for UNICEF called for a national strategy with ring-fenced funding so that action can be taken on what she deemed a 'major child health crisis', with 86% of children now breathing toxic air as a result of 'persistent and illegal breaches of the UK Air Pollution Limits'.

It's a frightening picture.

However, whilst measures are being taken by the motor industry to reduce pollutants from vehicles, substabtial reductions and new government legislation to tackle the problem will all take time.

What the Channel 4 Dispatches programme did highlight, was that these greener and simple antipollution measures, now have evidence to show significant contribution toward better air quality within the local environment, helping to reduce exposure to harmful pollutants and preserve the health and wellbeing of our children.

For schools and nurseries in heavily trafficked areas across the UK, of which there are over 2000 that fall into high / illegal levels of pollution areas, this information will no doubt be invaluable, and whilst funding is always an issue, ivy screens and other planting options can not only be cost-effective but more importantly can provide an immediate improvement in air quality, as evidenced in the programme.

It is widely acknowledged and accepted that green spaces are important to health and wellbeing. Numerous studies have shown that utilising green spaces boosts the wellbeing of urban dwellers; improving both physical and mental health.

With space being at a premium, planners and designers in towns and cities have been rising to the challenge of coming up with creative solutions. Installing a roof garden, green roof or roof garden terrace is not without its challenges. During the planning and design stage considerations need to be given to site access, health and safety features, over-looking neighbouring properties, accessibility for citizens, load-bearing capacity, drainage and ongoing maintenance and management.





UNIQUE & HARD WEARING RESIN BOUND SURFACES

The chances are, if you're reading this magazine, you have already heard of resin bound surfaces but in case you haven't, here's a brief explanation:

What is a resin bound surface?

Put simply, a resin bound surface is created by mixing a clear adhesive with a blend of decorative aggregate to form a screed, which is then trowelled out onto a pre-prepared substrate to create a highly aesthetic, hardwearing porous surface.

There are many different aggregates available and as a general rule installers tend to use either a 75/25% blend of 2-5mm and 1-3mm

respectively or a 50/50% blend, depending on how you want the finished surface to look. Only washed, dried and dust free aggregates approved for use in a bound surface, should be used as the dust and moisture contained in standard aggregates make them incompatible with a bound resin system.





It has been noted that different aggregates types produce different strengths of the finished surface, so if an installation is a driveway that will be taking turning 4x4's, the choice of aggregate blend could improve the lifespan of the surface.

Once a base is ready for laying the resin bound surface on, a skilled four man team of installers can lay up to 200 m2, in ideal conditions, per day. The surface can be ready to walk on after 10 hours and fully cured to take the specified vehicles after 24 hours.

Why use it?

· A resin bound surface looks more attractive than tarmacadam or concrete. There are many different applications where you can use it and a myriad of different aggregate blends to choose from to give you a unique finish to suit your taste

and compliment the surrounding landscape.

- A resin bound surface is easy to maintain. Unlike a loose gravel surface, it is resistant to weeds or plant growth, it won't trap leaves or litter and the aggregate doesn't migrate onto surrounding areas. The surface will only need light pressure washing to keep it clean.
- A resin bound surface is very hardwearing. As mentioned before, a driveway taking a heavy vehicle that will have to turn will need to be laid at a deeper depth than a footpath which will only ever be subjected to foot traffic.
- A resin bound surface should last in excess of 15 years depending on the make of the resin and the quality of the installation. Most are guaranteed for at least ten years.





Who uses it?

The endless number of colour combinations make a resin bound surface perfect for commercial and domestic applications such as driveways, pathways, conservatory surrounds, gardens, public areas and even tree pits. Specified by architects or local authorities and chosen by homeowners, a resin bound surface is ideal for anyone that wants a refined or eye-catching exterior surface.

What should you look out for?

- Find a reputable installer. A resin bound surface is not a DIY product.
- Damage to the current surface. The overall finish is dependent on the base. The base plays such an important part with any decorative surfacing system that it should be considered very carefully when planning an installation. If the surface shows any kind of lifting or cracking this should be investigated and repaired before installing the new resin bound surface.

- · Make sure it is laid at a depth suitable for the traffic it will be taking. A resin bound system should never be laid at less than 15mm and if it is taking vehicular traffic then the depth must increase accordingly.
- Confirm the resin is a UV stable system. Whilst there are a few different manufacturers and suppliers of resin, the chemistry of these products means there are fundamentally two key types of system produced. They are called aliphatic and aromatic. Aliphatic systems produce a long lasting, UV stable surface. Whilst Aromatic products are cheaper, they don't have the UV stability of the aliphatic system, will discolour and can degrade, becoming brittle over
- If you need the surface to comply with SuDS (Sustainable urban Drainage System), the installation as a whole needs to be taken in to consideration. The use of a resin bound surface does not necessarily imply SuDS compliance simply because it is permeable. It should be used in conjunction with permeable base courses or soakaways to achieve SuDS compliance. It is possible to create a SuDS compliant surface using any type of paving however a resin bound surface offers a very simple, cost effective decorative option.

So, now you know a little more about resin bound surfacing, bear it in mind for exterior surfaces that are unique, hard wearing, and eye-catching, low maintenance and can brighten up any outdoor area.

Victoria Education Centre is a nonmaintained, Ofsted-Outstanding special school in Poole, Dorset that offers specialised high-quality education, therapy and care for young people aged 3-19 from around the UK. The significant improvement in the condition of the multi-sport facilities at Dorset's Hamworthy Sports Club has largely been put down to a nutritional regime suggested by Headland Amenity. The facilities at Leicester Tigers Rugby Club play host to a packed schedule of training and matches, with the Oval Park training ground alone hosting over 200 games last year. 
