House Intelligence Committee to Hold Virtual Open Hearing on Misinformation and Conspiracy Theories Online

Washington, DC – On Thursday, October 15, 2020 at 1:30 pm ET, the House Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence (HPSCI) will convene a virtual unclassified hearing entitled, "Misinformation, Conspiracy Theories, and 'Infodemics': Stepping the Spread Online."

Conspiracy theories and misinformation narratives that prey on individuals' fears and uncertainties continue to mar the online landscape. Against the backdrop of a global pandemic, an economy in turmoil, and a tumultuous presidential campaign, there is ample terrain for malicious actors at home or malign foreign operatives and governments abroad to exploit such tensions by stoking chaos and dangerous, even life-threatening, untruths. Recent trends in the spread and reach of misleading or unfounded claims online have the unsettling potential to come to a head after Election Day – particularly if the certified outcome is unknown or contested in the ensuing days and weeks.

Although the seeds for many conspiracies and misinformation narratives – ranging from baseless QAnon posts, to dangerous coronavirus skepticism and denialism, to falsehoods about mail-in ballots – are often homegrown and amplified by American voices, the propaganda and covert influence machines of foreign adversaries have nonetheless repeated and amplified them in the service of strategic interests.

In the hearing, the Committee will examine:

- the intersection of and divergences between different online conspiracy and misinformation narratives;
- the role of social media platforms in the proliferation and deceleration of such content;
- how foreign actors are taking advantage of misinformation circulating U.S. online communities;
- steps that the US government and private sector need to take in response; and
- the implications for our social and political discourse beyond Election Day 2020.

A bombshell report by the *New York Post* contains emails revealing how Hunter Biden was used by a Ukrainian businessman to meet then-Vice-President Joe Biden. This contradicts public statements by Joe Biden that he had no involvement in his son's dealings with Ukraine.

- The story is based on files found on a computer that was left with a repair shop but the owner never picked it up.
- The computer hard drive contained personal photos of Hunter Biden.
- A copy of the hard drive was given to the FBI and the Senate Homeland Security Committee to investigate.

- Senate Homeland Security Committee confirmed to the *New York Post* they have an open investigation.

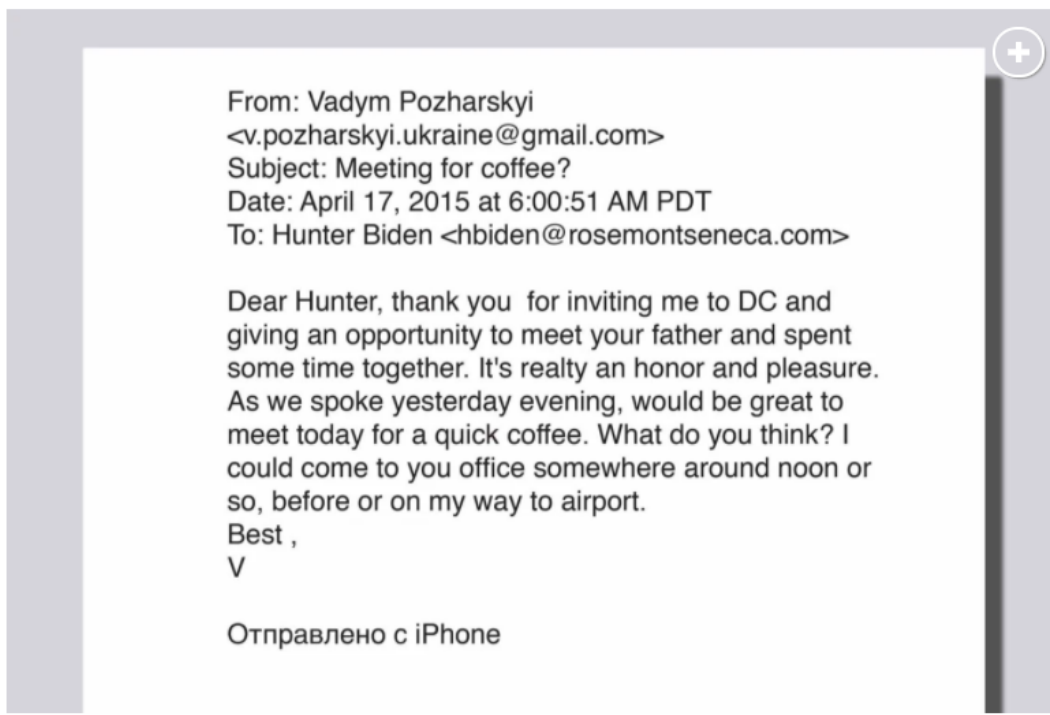

The never-before-revealed meeting is mentioned in a message of appreciation that Vadym Pozharskyi, an adviser to the board of Burisma, allegedly sent Hunter Biden on April 17, 2015, about a year after Hunter joined the Burisma board at a reported salary of up to \$50,000 a month.

“Dear Hunter, thank you for inviting me to DC and giving an opportunity to meet your father and spent [sic] some time together. It’s realty [sic] an honor and pleasure,” the email reads.

An earlier email from May 2014 also shows Pozharskyi, reportedly Burisma’s No. 3 exec, asking Hunter for “advice on how you could use your influence” on the company’s behalf.

The blockbuster correspondence — which flies in the face of Joe Biden’s claim that he’s “never spoken to my son about his overseas business dealings” — is contained in a massive trove of data recovered from a laptop computer.



The computer was dropped off at a repair shop in Biden’s home state of Delaware in April 2019, according to the store’s owner.

Other material extracted from the computer includes a raunchy, 12-minute video that appears to show Hunter, who’s admitted struggling with addiction problems, smoking crack while engaged in a sex act with an unidentified woman, as well as numerous other sexually explicit images.

Facebook tried to prevent the spread of the *New York Post* article, a move that caused outrage among conservatives.

Dear Mr. Zuckerberg:

Today, the *New York Post* released a story revealing that Hunter Biden facilitated a meeting with a Ukrainian energy executive and his father, who was then serving as Vice President. In it, the *Post* offers evidence that directly contradicts the claims of the Democratic nominee for president, who had previously stated that he has “never spoken to my son about his overseas business dealings.” Yet it has come to my attention that this news report—one clearly relevant to the public interest—has been censored on Facebook.

A representative from your company has publicly stated that Facebook will be “reducing [the story’s] distribution on our platform” while a third-party fact-check takes place.” The seemingly selective nature of this public intervention suggests partiality on the part of Facebook. And your efforts to suppress the distribution of content revealing potentially unethical activity by a candidate for president raises a number of additional questions, to which I expect responses immediately.

- 1) Is it your normal policy to reduce the distribution of stories on your platform *before* they have been fact-checked? If so, what is your specific policy and where is such policy stated?
- 2) If you have evidence that this news story contains “disinformation” or have otherwise determined that there are inaccuracies with the reporting, will you disclose them to the public so that they can assess your findings?
- 3) Why did you endeavor to publicly state that such a story was subject to a fact-check? Isn’t such a public intervention itself a reflection of Facebook’s assessment of a news report’s credibility?
- 4) Did any member of the Biden-Harris presidential campaign team or any person representing themselves as a representative of the campaign’s interests ask, encourage, or direct Facebook to suppress the *New York Post* story?
- 5) The *New York Post* previously reported that employees of the six largest Silicon Valley tech firms – including Facebook – have donated nearly \$5 million to the Biden-Harris campaign, compared to just \$239,000 to President Trump’s campaign. What steps has Facebook taken to ensure that your employees’ political preferences don’t influence decisions to suppress content?

Thank you for your attention to this matter important to fairness and impartiality in our presidential election process.

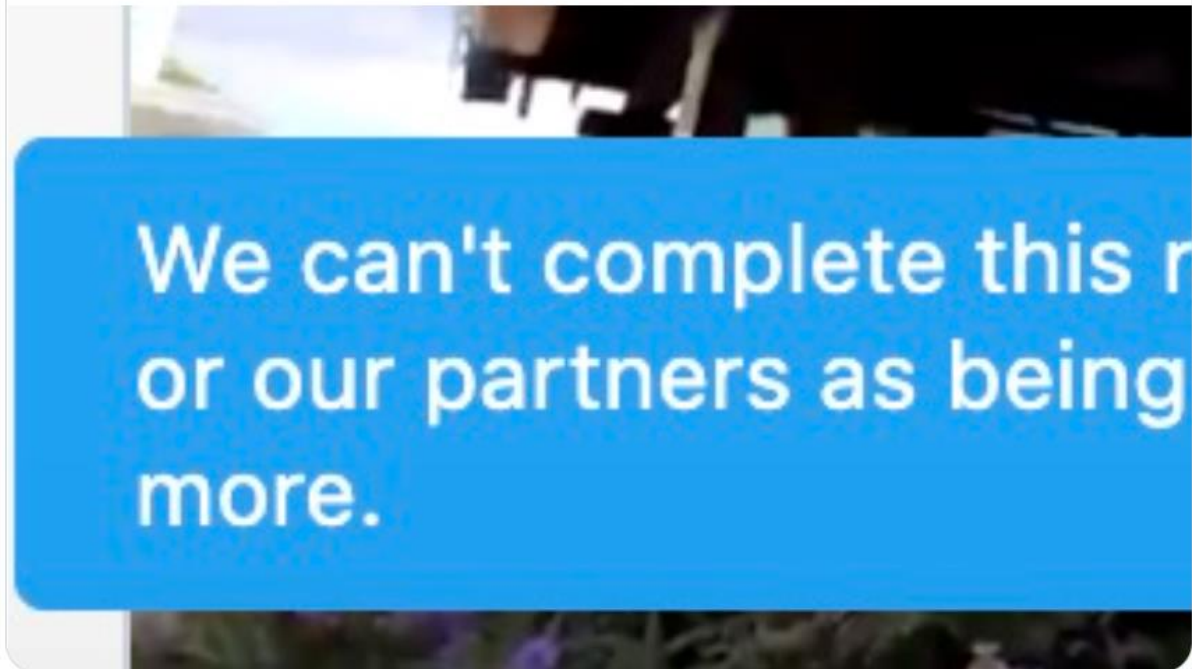

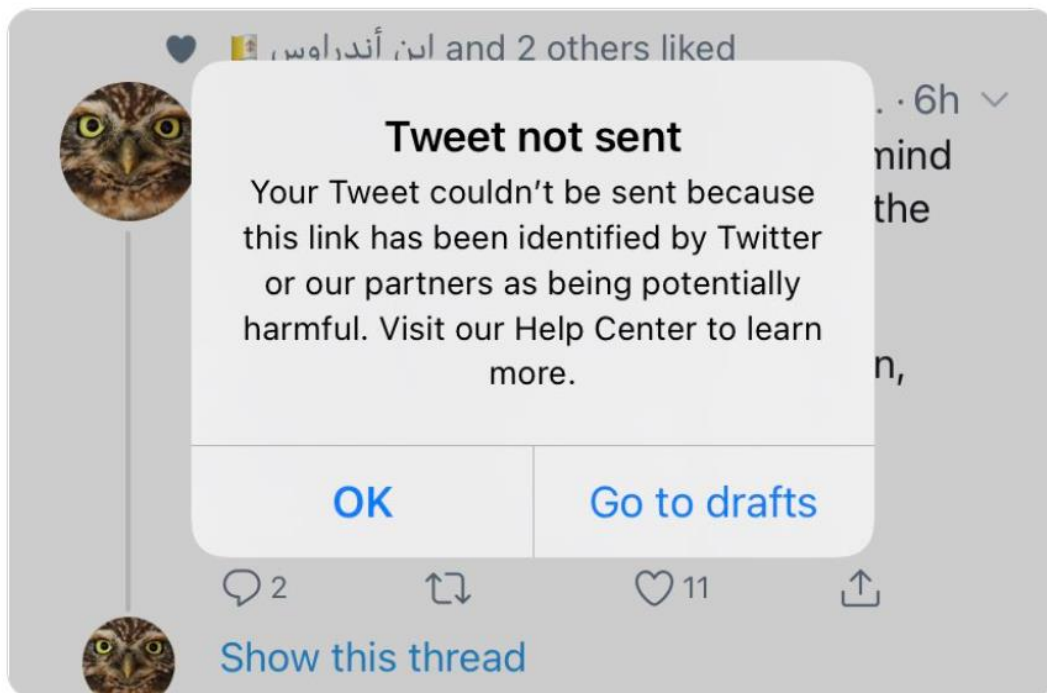

According to another article by the *New York Post*, The Obama administration let a Democratic PR firm Blue Star Strategies (that worked for Burisma Holdings) take part in a December 2015 conference call about an upcoming visit to Ukraine by then-Vice President Joe Biden.

A Blue Star associate then emailed a memo with minutes of the conference call to a top Burisma executive, Vadym Pozharskyi, as well as to Hunter Biden and Hunter's business partner, Devon Archer, both of whom sat on Burisma's board.

The trip, in December 2015, turned out to be the one where Joe Biden later bragged about forcing Ukrainian officials to fire a state prosecutor who was investigating Burisma by threatening to withhold a \$1 billion US loan guarantee.

The memo, sent shortly after the Dec. 2, 2015, call, also "outlined the trip's agenda and addressed several questions regarding US policy toward Ukraine."

Joe Biden has publicly denied any knowledge of his son's dealings with Burisma.

SUBJECT: Confirmation of Authorization of the Special Counsel to Investigate
Enumerated Matters
TIMETABLE: As soon as possible.

SUMMARY: The Special Counsel requests confirmation of his authority to investigate the matters identified below. The requested confirmation facilitates an efficient, full, and thorough investigation of the Russian government's efforts to interfere in the 2016 presidential election. As noted below, it may be appropriate to reassign certain matters identified below to a United States Attorney's Office or Department component at some point in the future. I recommend that you confirm the authority of the Special Counsel to investigate matters identified herein.

DISCUSSION:

On May 17, 2017, you appointed Robert S. Mueller III as Special Counsel "to ensure a full and thorough investigation of the Russian government's efforts to interfere in the 2016 presidential election," and specified his investigative and prosecutorial authority. Order No. 3915-2017. Thereafter, on August 2, 2017, you executed a classified memorandum that further identified specific matters included within the Special Counsel's investigative authority. During the course of his investigation of the authorized matters, the Special Counsel has identified additional individuals whose conduct he should investigate in order to fulfill his responsibilities as set forth in the appointment order. Those individuals and the basis for their inclusion within the Special Counsel's investigative purview are more fully described below.

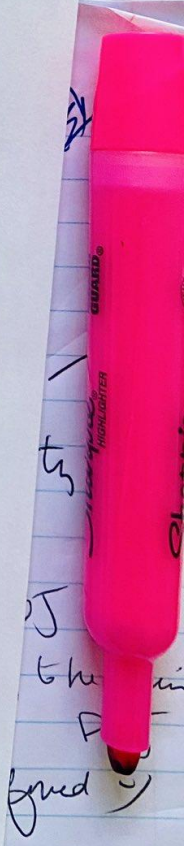
I. Individuals whose conduct is directly within the scope of the investigation.

The Special Counsel's Office (SCO) has been meeting with the Office of the Deputy Attorney General every other week to provide a briefing on the progress of the investigation. During those briefings, the SCO has provided sufficient information to establish that the conduct

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of additional individuals other than those named in the classified memorandum should be investigated as part of a full and thorough investigation of the Russian government's efforts to interfere in the 2016 presidential election, including any links and/or coordination between the Russian government and individuals associated with the campaign of President Donald Trump. Confirmation of the authorization to investigate such individuals does not suggest that the Special Counsel has made a determination that any of them has committed a crime. Rather, the Special Counsel has learned information such that further investigation of the pertinent activities of Michael Cohen, Richard Gates, [REDACTED], Roger Stone, and [REDACTED] is necessary for the Special Counsel to fulfill his responsibilities under the appointment order. I recommend that you confirm the authority of the Special Counsel to conduct that investigation.

II. Individuals who are possibly engaged in jointly undertaken activity pertaining to authorized matters.

The Special Counsel has also identified persons or entities who may have been engaged in jointly undertaken activity with individuals the investigation of whom you previously determined to be within the scope of your appointment order. Investigation by the Special Counsel of these additional persons or entities would be consistent with the ordinary course for a United States Attorney's Office or a Department component. In other words, any such office investigating potential criminal activity by one person would include within the same investigation individuals or entities who may have been jointly involved to determine whether they are targets, subjects, or witnesses, or are wholly uninvolved. This practice increases efficiency by avoiding multiple investigations of the same conduct. It also enables the prosecuting office to be aware of the full scope of the conduct to accurately assess the relative culpability of all involved and to identify and obtain the cooperation of co-defendants and witnesses. Assignment at this time of the investigation of persons or entities who may have engaged in jointly undertaken activity to a United States Attorney's Office or Department component would create the possibility that an individual with relevant information about the Special Counsel's investigation might come forward with that information after the Special Counsel concludes his investigation. This occurrence would raise questions about the completeness of the Special Counsel's investigation and the accuracy of his conclusions. Confirmation of the Special Counsel's authority to investigate these matters would not preclude reassignment of such matters to a United States Attorney's Office or Department component at a later time.

You previously confirmed the Special Counsel's authority to investigate allegations that Paul Manafort committed a crime or crimes arising out of payments he received from or on behalf of the Ukrainian government before and during the tenure of President Viktor Yanukovich. The Special Counsel has determined that the following individuals or entities may have been jointly involved in that conduct: Richard Gates; [REDACTED]

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Fun fact: The investigation of Cohen was based on incorrect intelligence claiming he had visited Prague but he never had. It was a different Michael Cohen.

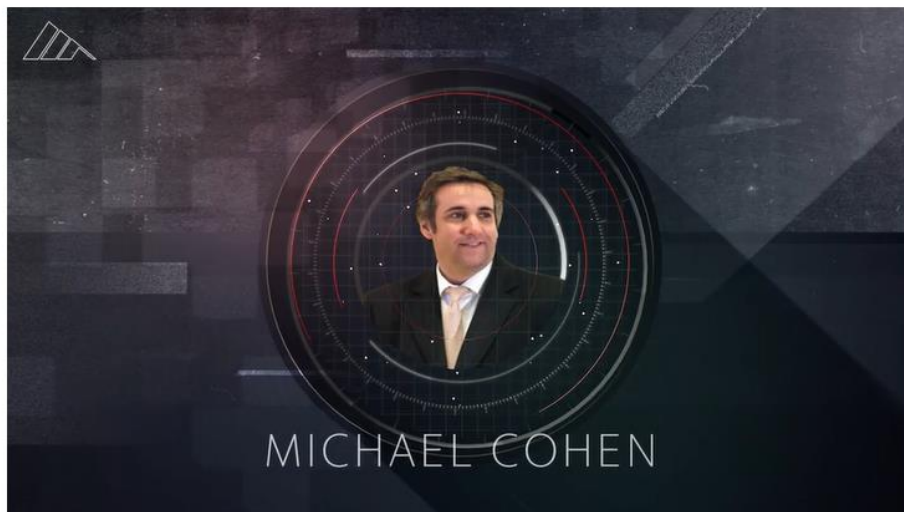

You also previously confirmed the Special Counsel's authority to investigate allegations that Michael Flynn committed a crime or crimes by acting as an unregistered agent of Turkey. The Special Counsel has determined that Bijan Rafikian and Ekim Alptekin may have been jointly involved in that conduct. I recommend that you confirm the Special Counsel's authority to investigate those individuals and entities in connection with their possible participation in that conduct.

III. Michael Cohen

In the course of the investigation, with respect to Michael Cohen, the Special Counsel has discovered investigative leads the pursuit of which may result in the discovery of criminal conduct not directly related to the Russian government's efforts to interfere in the 2016 presidential election. Those leads relate to Cohen's establishment and use of Essential Consultants LLC in order to, *inter alia*, receive funds from Russian-backed entities. Because the investigation has also revealed links between Cohen and Russian government officials, the Special Counsel would like to pursue those leads for at least two reasons: (1) there is some evidence that certain of Cohen's actions may relate to the Russian government's efforts to interfere in the 2016 presidential election; and (2) Cohen may have information relevant to the Special Counsel's investigation, and pursuit of the leads may help to secure Cohen's cooperation, thus furthering the Special Counsel's full and thorough investigation of the Russian government's efforts to interfere in the 2016 presidential election. I recommend you confirm the authority of the Special Counsel to pursue the referenced leads.

V. Summary recommendation

Based on the briefings the Special Counsel's Office has provided, I believe that the matters over which the Special Counsel seeks to confirm investigative authority are sufficiently predicated and appropriately within the scope of your appointment order. Further, centralizing the investigation of the identified matters with the Special Counsel for the time being will lead to a more timely and credible resolution of the investigation, which is squarely in the Department's and the nation's interests. For these reasons, I recommend you confirm the Special Counsel's authority to investigate the named individuals and matters in addition to those individuals and matters identified in the previously referenced classified memorandum.

With respect to any of the matters within the investigative authority of the Special Counsel, should the Special Counsel determine that: (1) the criminal conduct is unrelated to the

purpose of his appointment (and unrelated to matters addressed by 28 C.F.R. § 600.4(a)); and (2) charging the conduct is not likely to lead to discovery of relevant information, then that matter should be considered for reassignment to a United States Attorney's Office or Department component for prosecution.

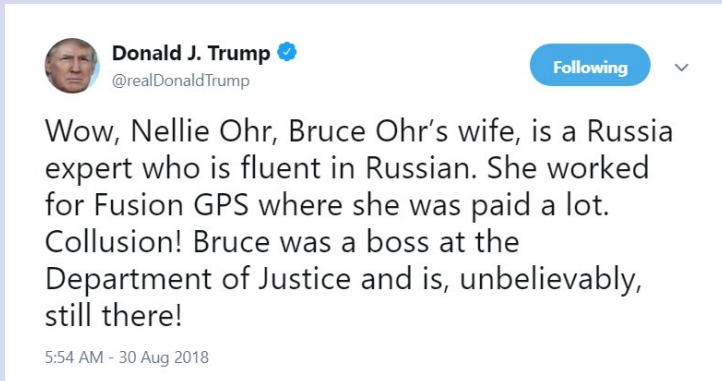

The FBI and CISA are issuing this PSA as a part of a series on threats to the 2020 election to enable the American public to be prepared, patient, and participating voters.

Cyber Threats to Voting Processes Could Slow But Not Prevent Voting

The Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA) are issuing this announcement to inform the public that attempts by cyber actors to compromise election infrastructure could slow but not prevent voting. The FBI and CISA have not identified any threats, to date, capable of preventing Americans from voting or changing vote tallies for the 2020 Elections. Any attempts tracked by FBI and CISA have remained localized and were blocked, minimal, or easily mitigated.

The FBI and CISA have **no** reporting to suggest cyber activity has prevented a registered voter from casting a ballot, compromised the integrity of any ballots cast, or affected the accuracy of voter registration information.

However, even if actors did achieve such an impact, the public should be aware that election officials have multiple safeguards and plans in place—such as provisional ballots to ensure registered voters can cast ballots, paper

because of their proximity to elections information, there may be some risk to elections information housed on government networks.

CISA is aware of some instances where this activity resulted in unauthorized access to elections support systems; however, CISA has no evidence to date that integrity of elections data has been compromised. There are steps that election officials, their supporting SLTT IT staff, and vendors can take to help defend against this malicious cyber activity.

Some common tactics, techniques, and procedures (TTPs) used by APT actors include leveraging legacy network access and virtual private network (VPN) vulnerabilities in association with the recent critical [CVE-2020-1472](#) Netlogon vulnerability. CISA is aware of multiple cases where the Fortinet FortiOS Secure Socket Layer (SSL) VPN vulnerability [CVE-2018-13379](#) has been exploited to gain access to networks. To a lesser extent, CISA has also observed threat actors exploiting the MobileIron vulnerability [CVE-2020-15505](#). While these exploits have been observed recently, this activity is ongoing and still unfolding.

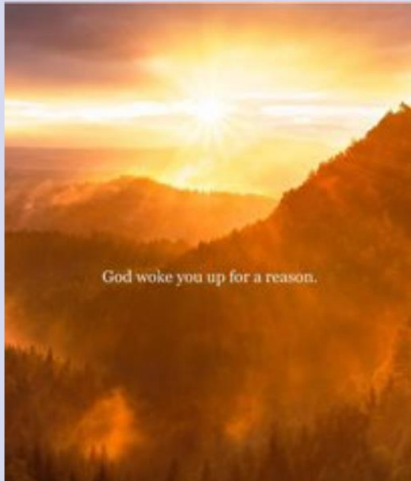

European intelligence agencies are deploying resources to track QAnon as the conspiracy theory spreads beyond the US, sources say

Europe's domestic intelligence and law-enforcement services have apprehensively watched the QAnon conspiracy theory migrate from the US and now consider it a significant security concern.

That assessment was given by two security officials contacted by Insider, both of whom spoke on the condition of anonymity given the nature of their work.

QAnon advocates claim that the US is secretly controlled by a cabal of politicians, celebrities, and media figures who engage in child abuse and pedophilia and that President Donald Trump will eventually move against these people. Its believers seek clues from an unknown government insider known as Q. There is no evidence to support the theory, and none of its foretold reckonings have taken place.

Nonetheless, its popularity has grown in recent years despite efforts from social-media companies to evict QAnon from their platforms. It has also gained followers in Europe.

A Belgian counterterrorism official told Insider that many European services like his were now rethinking a decision to ignore QAnon as a solely American phenomenon.

He drew parallels between QAnon and jihadist movements that have traditionally occupied intelligence agencies.

"I worked on jihadis and Al Qaeda, ISIS, for over 20 years, and now I am looking at the secular American version," said the official, who's part of Belgium's Federal Police.

"This Q thing is very similar to jihadism in several ways that are not obvious at first. For example, both are cults of magical thinking. Jihadis are drawn to the cause because they find comfort in a black-and-white morality in a complex world.
