FRAMING YOUR WORLD WITH YOUR WORDS

Hebrews 11:3 - Through faith we understand that the <u>worlds</u> were <u>framed</u> by the <u>word</u> of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

The word for "**worlds**," here is translated from the Greek word, "**aion**", which refers to the course of life, or the times you live in. This word can represent a period of time or dispensation. So then, we could go as far as to say ... **your** personal world and times can be framed.

Another key term here is "word," which is rendered "**rhema**" in Greek. Rhema refers to the Word that God speaks to your heart personally.

The last key word to consider as it relates to our article is the word "**frame**". Frame is from the Greek root word, "katartizo." It means to mend, to fix, to repair, to restore, to set in order, to arrange, to prepare, and to fashion.

One could literally receive a "Rhema" from God and use that word ... to repair, arrange, or fashion their lives or world to be in harmony with God's plan.

Words produce images! When we hear words from any source, those words produce images within us.

We can literally see the image within our minds eye. We will then live out the image we see on the inside.

What would happen if you'd hear and receive God's word?

The words which God would speak to us, would form the right image on the inside of us, which make up the frame.

Within the frame, is the image which was produced by the words which you heard and received. When we speak those words out of mouths we are also releasing into the physical realm ... what's already going on within ourselves.

We are already living within the framework of an inner image. Yet, when we speak those inner images, we are ... simply moving that inner frame that no one sees into the physical realm.

Your world isn't framed after you speak the words, your worlds are actually framed before you speak the words.

How is that? The framing takes place within the heart.

Once you speak words, you create an opportunity for the world around you to see the frame.


You are manifesting a pre-framed world.

The heart of a man has a frame and the boundaries of that frame can be expanded. As we expand the boundaries of our heart-frame, we can begin to see bigger pictures or images.

Some words you are exposed to ... keep your frame small and other words can cause your frame to expand.

What words are you exposed to and what words are you speaking?

Romans 10:9-10 - "That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.
Vs 10 - For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

CONFESSION

OF THE WORD OF GOD...

The word "CONFESS" comes from the Greek root word HOMO-LOGEO.

HOMO meaning "**SAME**' and LOGEO meaning "**to SAY**".

Combined, "confession" is defined as **to say the same thing** ...

More specifically, confession means to say the same thing as someone else has said.

The Bible teaches us to confess some things. Let's get more specific.

Our first introduction to the word "CONFESS", as Christians was likely at the time we received Jesus as our personal LORD and Savior.

Romans 10:9-10 – "That if thou shalt <u>confess</u> with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt <u>believe</u> in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. Vs 10 – For with the heart man <u>believeth</u> unto righteousness; and with the mouth <u>confession</u> is made unto salvation."

According to Romans chapter ten and verses nine and ten; ... **belief** precedes **confession**.

If you've heard, received and chose to believe the Word of God, the next thing which should happen is that you'll begin to speak in alignment with those beliefs.

If you believe the Word, you'll speak the Word.

Here's scripture for this:

2 Corinthians 4:13 – We having the same spirit of faith, according as it is <u>written</u>, I <u>believed</u>, and therefore have I <u>spoken</u>; we also <u>believe</u>, and therefore <u>speak</u>;

You can see, that believing precedes speaking.

If you believe what is written in the Word of God, you should be saying the same thing.

If one scripture wasn't enough for you, here's another:

Mark 11:23 – For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall <u>say</u> unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his <u>heart</u>, but shall <u>believe</u> that those things which he <u>saith</u> shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he <u>saith</u>.

Again, we find <u>belief</u> preceding <u>confession</u> of the word of God.

If you believe the word, you ought to be speaking or confessing the Word.

We are NOT talking about confessing sins to a

priest? Jesus has already made provision for our access to the father. We have a mediator in Christ.

<u>Why should I confess or speak the word of</u> <u>God?</u>

<u>What value is there to confessing or speaking</u> the word of God?

There are three specific reasons for confessing the Word of God.

(1) Confession of the Word of God is initially what brings us into **<u>relationship</u>** with God. Rom 10:9-10

(2) Confession of the Word of God also restores<u>fellowship</u> to the one who already has<u>relationship</u>. 1 John 1:9

(3) Confession of the Word of God is a way to lay hold of what rightfully belongs to you and I in Christ Jesus. Hebrews 3:1

Of the three basic reasons for confessions of the Word of God; the reason we are focusing on is the laying hold of what God has already given us in Christ.

The word meditation will be important to our study for a moment. Meditation is to ponder, think about and MUTTER out loud with the mouth.

Meditation provides opportunity to become one with what you are meditating. This time of meditation on the Word of God will also serve to flush out any potential doubts.

<u>Belief in God's Word is a choice even in the face</u> of opposing circumstances. Although you choose to believe the word, based on God's integrity, doubts might still present themselves. <u>What can I</u> <u>do in this instance</u>? Meditate the Word of God and allow your heart to become fully persuaded.

When you are fully persuaded on a heart level, you'll speak the Word on a higher level of conviction, producing results.

So then, you can see the value of meditation on the Word of God. Meditation includes confession by default.

<u>Confession</u> of the Word of God allows you to take <u>possession</u> of what God has <u>already given</u>.

Illustration: Power is currently flowing into my building from the electric company. Yet, this doesn't mean that the lights are on. In order for the lights to be on, I must flip the switch.

God has already provided power for provision, and has given us insight as to how to access that power.

We access God's power by faith, and then faith is to be released by words spoken.

So then, if we've not accessed God's power, we must speak the word of faith, thus flipping the switch.

Patience or consistency is also necessary when operating in faith. Although, you've spoken the word of faith, it will not necessarily equal immediate results. Yet, that's not a reason to avoid engaging in the process of speaking the Word of faith consistently.

Speaking or confessing right words will bless you, if you'll engage in this process of confessing God's Word consistently.

You could speak wrong words, and speak the problem.

However, speaking the problem will only make the problem worse. Instead speak the answers found in the Word of God.

For example; when you first hear that it's God's will for you to be healed; it may sound as if that's too good to be true. Yet, God's Word is true, and we should choose to believe and speak the Word based on His integrity.

Choose to say, in this instance; **I AM HEALED**.

Listen to these references from the book of Hebrews chapter three and verse one and then Hebrews chapter ten and verse twenty-three.

Hebrews 3:1 – Wherefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our **profession**, Christ Jesus;

Jesus is the one sent (APOSTLE) to carry into effect (PRIEST) our confession (PROFESSION) of the Word of God.

Profession is from the same word which renders confession in the Greek.

Now, listen to these words from the book of Hebrews chapter ten and verse twenty-three.

Hebrews 10:23 – Let us hold fast the <u>profession</u> of our <u>faith</u> without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;)

Hold fast your confession or profession of ... what you believe.



Our confessions of God's word will release power into this physical realm, from the spiritual realm of which you and I are citizens. When we confess God's Word with faith, we'll bring change where we need it.

Do you believe this?

Words are powerful generally speaking.

Words are designed for more than having a conversation or dialogue. Words are designed to create.

God's Word have creative power.

What would happen if you and I agreed with God's Word, believed God's Word and then speak them from faith?

You've been authorized to speak speak to problems. You've been authorized to exercise authority over demonic power and the effects of that power.

How can we have this kind of influence?

With words!!!

When we pray for the sick, we use words. When we release our authority, we use words.

When Adam initially exercised authority it was with words.

When Jesus exercised His authority over the winds, fevers, sickness, demons etc... He used words.

Your confession of the word of God is key to your victory.
