“If you believe, you will get anything you ask for in prayer.”

“What you say affects how you live. You will be rewarded by how you speak. What you say can mean life or death...”

Do you know how powerful you are with the words that you speak?

EXPERIMENT

Items needed: Whipped cream
One person can help to spray whipped cream into the bowl and see if we can fill it up.

Now, can you help me by putting the whipped cream back in the spray bottle or a can? See if your volunteer, or any other kids, suggests putting the cream back in the can. You can't put whipped cream back in the can. Once it's out, it's out. I can't use it again.

That's the same problem with our tongue. Once words dance off our tongues and out of our mouths, you can't take them back. It's the same for both good and bad words you speak. Therefore, we must train our tongues and only use good words. Our tongue is a powerful weapon. God created us to create things with the words that we speak.

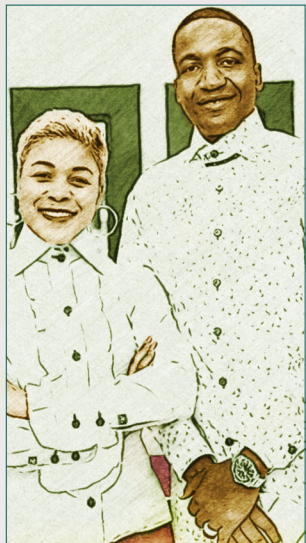

Hey kids, this week we have a love challenge and experiment.

Challenge: Tell five people who are not family members you love them.

EXPERIMENT

Materials Needed: Two eggs, vinegar, and one glass

Directions: Place the first egg in a glass and pour in the vinegar to submerge the egg. Allow the egg

to sit in the vinegar for 24hrs. After 24 hours, it should be soft and yellowish. Rinse it off and bring it to class with the second egg.

Show the students the hard egg and let them touch it. (You can boil the other egg to avoid it breaking and making a mess in your class.) Ask your friends if there is any way to make this hard eggshell soft.

Then, rinse off the softened egg, let the kids touch it, and even bounce it on the table. Explain that this egg spent 24 hours in vinegar, which "magically" made it soft!



When God's love surrounds us, like the vinegar covering the egg, we can't help but come out completely changed. His love softens even the hardest of hearts! Love is not a feeling. It is a choice. God choose to love us. There's absolutely nothing we can do to make God love us. Kids, if you choose to love people, they will show love to you. Imagine how beautiful the world can be if we choose to love one another.

The love of God is shed abroad in my heart. I do everything with love because Jesus loves me, and Jesus is on the inside of me. Hallelujah!

Ephesians 4:32 (ICB)

Be kind and loving to each other. Forgive each other just as God forgave you in Christ"

The Bible tells us to forgive people the way that God has forgiven us. God forgave us even though we continue to do wrong. If someone does wrong to you, hurt you or gossip about you, you have to forgive them. Forgiveness is a choice.

Jesus said if you forgive others for what they do wrong, then God will forgive you for what you do wrong. If you do not forgive those that do wrong to you, then God will not forgive the wrong things you do. Choose to forgive today, and you will see wonders in your life.

Our verse for today talks about Stephen, a man being used mightily by God. When the authorities arrested Stephen and brought him to court, everyone looked at him and his face was like an angel's face.

What had happened? Stephen was a man of prayer. He spoke to God about everything going on in his life and in the lives of others. He prayed for himself and others, including his neighbourhood, workplace, and town. When you do this often, your face, your voice, and everything about you change. You start speaking the word of God more boldly.

Today as you pray, pray for your family, neighbourhood, and even your country, and see how you shapeshift like Stephen!

“Then He spoke a parable to them, that men always ought to pray and not lose heart”.

When a baby penguin is born, the mother stays and guards the baby while the father goes out to sea to hunt for food. Penguins stay in large groups called colonies made up of hundreds of thousands of penguins that look alike. So when the father comes back, he is faced with finding his wife and his baby penguin in this large noisy colony! How does he do it?

He listens to the unique voice of his wife and baby penguin and follows it. He follows it until he finds them and feeds them. If the wife or the baby penguin stayed quiet, they would never get their food or see the father again.

There are many noises in the world from billions of people crying out like the colonies of penguins, but God only listens to the voice of prayer from His children. Never stop praying so your voice is always heard, and you will not lose heart.

Have you ever tried asking someone for something they do not have? For example, imagine asking a friend for a dog, but your friend doesn't have one. You can only ask if you know the person has the thing you are asking for, right?

With anything you find difficult, find the verse that talks about it and pray it.

The magician uses a lot of tricks to make people think the rabbit appeared from thin air. But you have something real and much better.

Our verse today says the words you speak are spirit and give life. Whatever you say becomes a real thing. If you speak badly about yourself saying, “I am not smart” or “I can’t do” this or that, it becomes real. But when you speak well and say, “I am smart”, “I can do all things through Christ”, “I am the best student in class”. Even if you don’t feel it, it becomes real. Do exactly as God does and speak things that are not there as though they are there!

Never listen to negative words spoken over your life; only speak good about yourself.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

As I speak, it becomes real because the words I speak are spirit and give life. Hallelujah!

“You are the light that gives light to the world. A city that is built on a hill cannot be hidden”.

Kids, our scripture for today says you are a city! How many cities can you name? There’s London, New York, Harare, Sydney, Mumbai, and so on. Cities supply people with everything they need to live. A city has banks, schools, hospitals, grocery stores, and police offices where they protect you from bad people.

Now God calls you a city too because, inside you, you have everything a city has! Think about it: you are your own hospital as you have God’s kind of health; you have the Holy Spirit that teaches you all things, and so you are your own school! No wonder Abraham was called the father of many nations.

This week we will learn more about building our city using God’s word.

Children, why did the doctor get so upset? Because he ran out of patients! We are talking about you being a city. A normal city has a hospital, right? Well, I'm going to show you that you have one better inside you.

What is worse than being sick? It's painful. But look at what our scripture says today, you have the same spirit that raised Jesus up from the dead! If you have that same spirit that raises Jesus from the dead, then that same spirit will make sure you stay healthy continuously! The Holy Spirit gives you the life that God has, the one that can never be sick. Encourage people you know who are sick to receive Christ and get healed just like they would go to a hospital.

Build your city with your hospital by speaking health to your body always.

Children, why were the teacher’s eyes crossed? She couldn’t control her pupils!

Did you know that you have your own school inside you? Our verse today tells us that the Holy Spirit is our teacher and will teach us everything. How many things is everything? It’s everything, all

things! So, if you need help with homework, chores or understanding the bible, He will teach you all things. All you have to do is ask Him. He is your Helper and loves to be involved in every little thing that you do. At school, you have teachers for different subjects, but in your school, your teacher the Holy Spirit knows every single subject. Glory!

Build your city’s school by declaring the Holy Spirit is your teacher and asking Him to help you with any subject.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

“and if children, then heirs also - heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, ...”

Children, help me with this one. Where do fish keep their money? In a riverbank! You'll get it when you get home. We are still building your city, and today I want to show you that you have your very own bank inside of you.

Maybe you have seen some people go to the bank. These people go to the bank or to a cash machine to take money out when they need it. But did you know as a child of God, your money is not in the bank? You

have way more money than you can imagine! Our verse tells us that we are the heirs of God. An heir is someone who gets to own everything their father or mother left them when they passed on. God owns all the money in the world, and it's all yours! So, when you or your family need money, all you have to do is build your city's bank, speak the word of God and say the "MONEY IS COMING!" every day and watch God provide. Glory!

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

I decree and declare the money is coming! I am not supplied by the bank but by God. Hallelujah!

2 Kings 6:17 (ICB)

“Then Elisha prayed, “Lord, open my servant’s eyes. Let him see.” The Lord opened the eyes of the young man. And he saw that the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha”.

Any city has an army or a police department to catch criminals. You too have your own police force inside you. In the verse above, Prophet Elisha was surrounded by enemies, but he has his own army the enemy could not see. The mountain was full of angels with chariots of fire surrounding and protecting Elisha!

surrounding and protecting Elisha!

You have an army of angels surrounding you right now, protecting you. Angels only act upon the word of God. Every day you must continue to build your city’s police by speaking, “I am surrounded by many angels right now!” When you do this, the angels continuously fight off any criminals, physical or spiritual. When you can’t sleep in the dark, always remember you have bigger and better chariots of fire surrounding you. Never be afraid of anything, your angels are ready to protect you when you speak the word.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

I decree and declare that I am heavenly protected, I am surrounded by countless angels right now. Nothing can happen to me or my family in Jesus’ name.

A city has to make sure there are cars, buses, trains, and airplanes for people to get to places. You have your own transport system in you.

Children, look at our verse above carefully. It says when Jesus rose from the dead, he appeared to 500 people who were all in different places at the same time! Imagine

you are speaking to one friend at school, and you are also speaking to your brother at home all at the same time! How can you be in 2 places at once? Well, Jesus was in 500 places at once! You can do all the things that Jesus did and even greater! It's possible for you if you only BELIEVE! You will never be late for school again! You don't need to be like other humans using trains and cars. Use the power in you.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

I decree and declare I can be in many places at once, just like Jesus. I can do all things through Christ! Hallelujah!

“But dear friends, use your most holy faith to build yourselves up strong. Pray with the Holy Spirit”.

What a busy week we have had to build our city by speaking the word of God. Now, we will look at how to build by praying in the Holy Spirit. You see now that you have the word of God concerning each area of your city, you can strengthen your city by praying in the Holy Spirit.

Do you remember the three little pigs? One built a house with straw and the wolf blew it away because it wasn't strong. Another built it with wood and still wasn't strong. So, all the pigs ran to the house built strong with bricks, and the wolf huffed and puffed but still couldn't blow it away.

You see children, when you pray in the Holy Ghost and use the words you have learned this week. The enemy will huff and puff and get so tired he'll run away because your city is strong. Amen!

Sometimes you may feel so much pain that you think God is not with you to heal you. You may even ask God why you are constantly feeling sick.

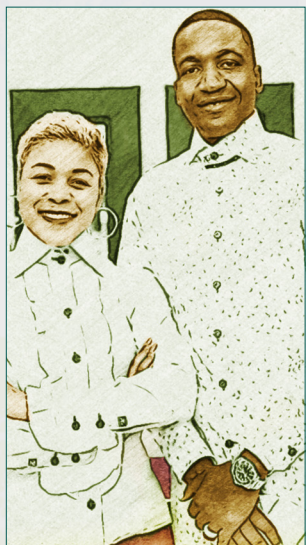
Well, I have good news for you children. Our verse for today tells us that God wants us to be healthy. God never wants to see you sick or in pain because He doesn't know sickness or pain. He gave you His life so that you wouldn't fall sick like other kids at school. You are different; you are very special and carry health in you. Not just any health but the God-Kind Health! If God wants you healthy, sickness or pain is not allowed in your body, so refuse the pain and command divine health to your body now.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

I decree and declare that I am special, I am not going to get sick. I am healthy, and I refuse any pain or sickness in my body in Jesus' name.

Jeremiah 33:6 ICB



Mark 2:9 (ICB)

“Which is easier: to tell this paralyzed man, ‘Your sins are forgiven,’ or to tell him, ‘Stand up. Take your mat and walk?’”

Have you ever been to a hospital where people or children are ill? For some people, it can be a scary place because of all the machines and doctors saying very big words you don't understand. Sometimes this can make you think that healing someone is very hard and is only for grown-ups. I have good news for you! It may be hard for doctors to heal the blind or to make those

in wheelchairs walk but not for God.

In our verse for today, Jesus gave us a clue that to Him, healing is easy. It's very simple. All you have to do is to:

A: Find the word concerning healing and accept it

B: Believe in that word

C: Confess that word A.B.C!

When you do this continuously, sickness will disappear. Remember, you must believe the word that talks about healing.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

I speak healing over my life and my family's life. Good health is my portion in Jesus' name.

FURTHER STUDY

Isaiah 53:4 ICB

**Romans 8:10 (ICB)**

“Your body will always be dead because of sin. But if Christ is in you, then the Spirit gives you life, because Christ made you right with God”.

Do you have a mobile phone or see a grown-up with one? Have you noticed that after some time, they have to plug it in somewhere for it to charge? You see, mobile phone batteries run out. If you don't charge them, they will automatically be turned off.

Your health is similar to this. Even though you are born again, sometimes your body is weak, you feel pain or ill, and you want to stay in bed. Our verse today says that if Christ is in you, then the Spirit gives your body life or energy to be well again because you are right with God. Praise Jesus!

You don't have to make the Spirit give you life, He's already doing it. You might still feel the pain but keep speaking that the Holy Spirit is giving you life continuously and the pain will disappear. Keep saying it and don't stop!

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

The Holy Spirit is giving life to my body because I am right with God. I refuse sickness and pain in Jesus' name.

FURTHER STUDY

Romans 8:10-11 ICB



John 10:10 (ICB)

“A thief comes to steal and kill and destroy. But I came to give life—life in all its fullness.”

What a wonderful verse for today! Jesus was saying that He came to give you life, life in all its fullness Glory to God! Children, your life is not like your friends at school or the people you see around you. Those people have to go to a doctor when they are sick; they have to go to a bank if they need money, and so on. But you are a different creature.

You see, the life Jesus gave you is not a human life. Superman has an alien life but you have the God kind of life. The same life as God. Hallelujah! God's life has fullness meaning there is no sickness or death in it. You must never accept sickness or pain in your body or in your family. The moment you see it, command it to get out in Jesus' name and declare healing to take over!

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

I have the fullness of life. I have the life of God in me; therefore, I command all sickness and pain to get out! Thank you, Jesus!

FURTHER STUDY

2 Corinthians 5:17 ICB



Hebrews 10:14 (ICB)

“With one sacrifice he made perfect forever those who are being made holy.”

Children, did you know that when you feel pain, or get sick it's not really you feeling pain or getting sick? Let me show you.

Our verse for today tells us that the spirit we have been given is perfect. It has no flaws, no weaknesses. It doesn't get tired or sick. As a matter of fact, your spirit doesn't go to sleep. It is your body that gets weak, tired, sick, and sleeps. Your body is the

one that feels pain, but you are not your body. You are a spirit. So, when you get a headache, you say my body has a headache, not me! Your body is your spirit's house.

So how do you get rid of the pain? Your body listens to your words. Speak health to your body, and your body will listen. Remember kids, the Holy Spirit in you gives you life.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

I speak life and good health to my body now in Jesus's name.

FURTHER STUDY

Romans 8:9 ICB



Mark 11:23 (ICB)

"I tell you the truth. You can say to this mountain, 'Go, mountain, fall into the sea.' And if you have no doubts in your mind and believe that the thing you say will happen, then God will do it for you."

Children, how are mountains able to see? Easy, they peak!

Our verse for today is of Jesus telling us that we can speak to mountains! The mountains He is talking about are problems in your life that look too big to sort out. You can speak to that mountain and tell it what to do. For

example, if there is a sickness or pain in your body or in your brothers and sister, you can speak to that mountain and tell it to get out or be thrown into the sea, and it will! You have to believe that what you say will happen.

Whatever mountain you are facing, whether it's health, sadness, or fear, speak to it like Jesus and tell it what you want it to do.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

I speak to every mountain in my life to be flattened. I speak to every sickness, sadness, and fear in my life to disappear in Jesus' name.

FURTHER STUDY

Mark 11:12-24 ICB



Proverbs 17:22 (ICB)

“A happy heart is like good medicine. But a broken spirit drains your strength.”

Doctors give medicine to sick people to help them heal. Sometimes the medicine tastes very bad, and some people take it every day or many times a day. Perhaps you have had some bad-tasting medicine too. But did you know that God actually has medicine for His children? Let's take a look at our verse for today more carefully.

A happy heart is like good medicine to you. You can never be sick

when you choose to be happy and joyful. Joy keeps sickness away. So, when you go about your day, be joyful even if everything around you seems sad. Being grumpy, angry, and sad will only drain your strength and cause you to feel sick. The joy of the Lord is your strength. Hallelujah. That is your medicine!

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

Today, I choose joy no matter what is happening around me. I refuse to be upset, angry, or rude. I choose joy in Jesus' name!

FURTHER STUDY

Nehemiah 8:10 ICB



John 17:16 (ICB)

“They don’t belong to the world, the same as I don’t belong to the world.”

The Lord Jesus was praying for us just before He was about to be crucified when He said our verse for today.

The truth is you are not a human being like the people around you. You may look like them, and hang out with them, but they cannot do the things that you can do. When you received Jesus as your Lord, you did not give your life to Jesus to change. Jesus threw

away your old life and gave you His own life! Hallelujah! The supernatural and extraordinary life of God!

You see, when you pray, things change. While humans mostly walk in anger, hurt, and sadness, you continuously walk in love and joy. That is the God-kind of life. Always remember, you are born of God and an overcomer.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

I decree and declare that I am not human. I am of God, a child of the Most High. I am a new creature in Christ! Hallelujah!

FURTHER STUDY

2 Corinthians 5:17 ICB



John 10:34 (ICB)

Jesus answered, "It is written in your law that God said, 'I have said you are gods!'"

If dogs give birth to dogs, humans give birth to humans, and goats give birth to goats, but who does God give birth to? You guessed it, gods! You are a child of God and that makes you a god, not human! It's all because of Jesus. Do you know why? Let me show you.

The Bible says the entrance of God's words gives light (Psalm 119:130 NKJV). This means each time you listen to the teachings

in church or read the bible or GoodNews Daily, light enters you. But remember, God is light, so you can say the entrance of God's word gives God. The more you read about or listen to the word of God, the more you become like God. You are a god!

only body the Holy Spirit can use is yours! You make up His body. So, you don't follow Jesus because His Spirit is inside you. It's like saying your stomach or your legs are following you, yet they are part of your body!

Likewise, you are part of Jesus' body. This means when you move your head, move your fingers, or speak, it is Jesus doing it.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

I am the body part of Christ. When I speak, Jesus is speaking. When I walk, Jesus is walking! When you pray, Jesus is praying! Christ in me the hope of glory. Hallelujah!

“James and John, the sons of Zebedee (Jesus gave them the name Boanerges, which means “Sons of Thunder”);”

Have you heard the loud, rumbling thunder when it is raining? For many people, including grown-ups, it’s very frightening, and kids hide under their blankets! Dark clouds gather and a flash of lightning comes before the sound of thunder. Did you know as a child of God, you should never be afraid of it?

You see, you have thunder in you that is way louder, and the whole world is waiting to see and hear what you will do with it. But before the world can hear your thunder, there needs to be lightning first. We have learned previously that the word of God gives light. The more you read and listen to the word of God, the more lightning in you and the louder your thunder shall sound. You may look small but when you pray, when you act on the word of God, you are louder than the thunder you hear in the sky.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

I am a son of thunder, and the whole world is waiting for me to show them the power of God in Jesus’ name. Hallelujah!

John 4:24 (ICB)

“God is spirit. Those who worship God must worship in spirit and truth”

Since you are God’s child, that makes you a spirit and not human. The only thing is your spirit has made your body its house. Did you know your spirit thinks very differently from your body? Your spirit thinks exactly the same way God does, but your body has its own mind. For example, sometimes you feel really sad about yourself and start saying things like “I can’t do this”, “I’m not clever”, “Nobody likes me”, “I’m feel-

ing sick”, and so on.

Your spirit is always joyful, like God. Your spirit wants to pray, go to church, be kind to others, and be healthy. When you do what your spirit wants, you are walking in the same vibration as God. Feed your spirit more by reading the word of God more often, and you will start walking in the spirit more and more. Before you know it, God will start showing you things concerning your life and you will be able to communicate with Him!

This means you are the headquarters of God. You are where God does His plans and preparing to change the world. Praise Jesus. Never speak negatively about yourself because you are God’s headquarters. Never think you are lower than someone else. Remind yourself always that you carry God who created the world.

fish Jesus multiplied to feed more than five thousand people until they were satisfied. What a wonder!

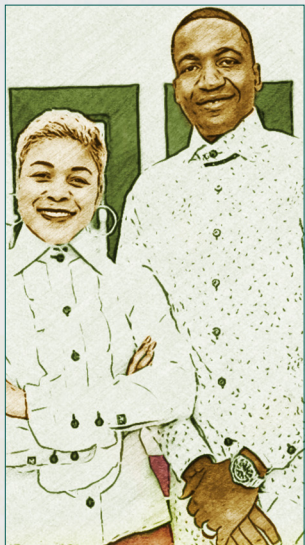
Kids, what do you have in your hand? What are your talents? What do you have in your possession? Give it to God today and see Him work as the God of multiplication in your life!

If saying thank you is expected when relating to other people, then how much more should we say thank you when communicating with God? In today's verse, we can clearly see that whenever you pray, you should always give

thanks. In the words of our spiritual mother, Prophetess Bebe Angel, no prayer is quite complete without giving thanks to God.
